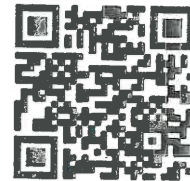





**WEATHER DISCUSSION:** The last measured rain for the fire area was now 20 days ago. Another night of very poor RH recovery will set the stage for another dry day. RH will once again fall into the upper teens. A weak system will move through the area today. This will once again bring slightly elevated instability, making for some gusts and a few cumulus clouds in the afternoon. Temperatures will be in the low to mid 80s. The pattern will remain very similar into next week with a slight cooling/moistening trend.

---

**Sunday Weather:** Partly cloudy and dry. Some gusts in the afternoon.  
**TEMPERATURES:** 84-87 below 3000 feet and 78-83 3000-5000 feet...little change.

**MINIMUM HUMIDITY:** 17-22%....up 2 percent.

**20 FT WINDS:**

**RIDGETOP** - North to northeast 8 to 12 mph through 1100, becoming west to northwest 8 to 12 with gusts 18- 20 mph.

**SLOPE/VALLEY** – Down canyon 3 to 6 through 1000, then up canyon 5 to 8 mph, with gusts 13-15 mph through the afternoon.

**INVERSION:** Morning inversion lifting around 1200 hours. **MIXING HEIGHT:** 8100 feet **LAL:** 1

**Sunday Night:** Clear. Poor humidity recovery again.

**TEMPERATURES:** 57-64...no change.

**MAXIMUM HUMIDITY:** 18-25%...no change.

**20 FT WINDS:**

**RIDGETOP** – Northwest 8 to 12 mph with gusts to 17 mph through 1900, then north-northeast 5 to 8 mph overnight.

**SLOPE/VALLEY** – Up canyon 4 to 7 mph early, becoming light and variable, then becoming down canyon 4 to 7 mph at 2200.

**STABILITY/INVERSION:** Moderate inversion setting up overnight. **LAL:** 1

---

**OUTLOOK FOR MONDAY:** Conditions will remain very dry to start the week. Recoveries will be very limited again on Monday morning. Temperatures should be a degree or 2 cooler, Winds will be lighter than the weekend and return to their typical slope/diurnal patterns.

---

**EXTENDED FORECAST:** A new ridge of high pressure starts to develop for next week. The weather system we were tracking for the middle of the week will be well off to the east. Other than helping to enhance some of the north winds on the ridges overnight, minimal impacts are expected. Expect very little change to temperatures and RH, with no sign of rain in the extended forecast.

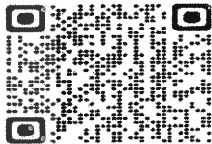

**GENERAL AREA: (In the event fire spots outside the line or we support a new IA) Surface Fire activity.**  
**Expect slow to moderate rates of spread unless fire lines up with slope and wind especially in areas with continuous grass and brush, if this occurs, torching is possible. Review pocket cards to track trends and thresholds for the area.**  
Fine dead fuel moistures support fire spread, break point is FDFM <5. Rates of spread generally 1-8ch/hr. If fire gets established in an open area aligned with wind and slope, spread rates increase to 8-22ch/hr.  
Torching possible. Spotting distances will be short range less than 3/10 of a mile max (wind speed dependent).  
Fire activity continues in areas of the fire that are inaccessible as heavy fuels and duff layers continue to hold heat. Expect hot spots to show themselves in the afternoon.

**Branch 25:** Smoldering and creeping fire. Containment lines expected to hold. Minimal fire spread/growth in the forecast. Isolated inaccessible areas still hold heat.

### **Hazards & Risks**

**Public Encounters:** HUNTING SEASON IS OPEN !! There may be an increase in public encounters between fire personnel, local residents and forest visitors this weekend within the fire area. Be aware of increased traffic flow on all the highways and forest roads. Area closures are in place but not everyone knows of them or chooses to abide by them. Be respectful of private property boundaries and make efforts to avoid confrontations. Remember that the local folks are dealing with us and this fire.

**Ash Pit Hazards:** Stump holes are abundant in the fire area. Use caution when using water to mop up and avoid straight streaming directly into the ash pit as scalding steam can suddenly erupt from the hole and burn you. Things to LOOK OUT for:

- Extensive root systems of trees and shrubs.
- Deep duff or peat, the organic layer covering mineral soil.
- Landscapes that have once been cultivated or manipulated by heavy equipment, old dozer piles, sawmills, timber sale yards, or decking areas.
- Small rodent holes that have become filled with decadent, combustible debris, beaver holes near dams and stream beds, badger and coyote dens.
- White ash is sometimes an indicator of ash pits as are swarms of hovering insects.
- With the sun behind the suspected ash pit, look for small nearly translucent smokes that dissipate quickly above the ground.
- Ash pits often give off the smell of incomplete combustion or of creosote burning.

**To:** Wildland Fire Community, Agency Administrators, Duty Officers, Fire Management Officers, Resource Advisors, Incident Management Teams

**Subject:** Hazard Tree Awareness for Strategic Decision Makers



**Issue:** Two fatalities caused by tree strikes occurred in August 2022 on the Big Swamp and Rum Creek fires in Southwest Oregon. Neither event was related to tree felling operations. Both involved fire weakened green trees.

**Action:** Agency Administrators, Incident Commanders, Incident Safety Officers, Strategic Planners, Operation Section Chiefs, Resource Advisors and Duty Officers should engage in regular and ongoing risk assessments before, during, and after deciding to commit to strategies that place personnel under tree canopy. It is recognized that a zero-risk strategy is not possible in the wildland fire environment.

- Consideration of forest health and observed tree failure should be incorporated into decisions on strategic courses of action.
- Review the Snag Hazard layer on the Risk Management Assistance (RMA) Dashboard, [https://www.fs.usda.gov/rm/pubs\\_journals/2022/rmrs\\_2022\\_riley\\_k001.pdf](https://www.fs.usda.gov/rm/pubs_journals/2022/rmrs_2022_riley_k001.pdf)
- Assure tactical decisions follow strategic direction and be prepared to resist allowing resources to commit to high hazard fireline assignments without deliberate discussion and developed mitigation plans.
- Assure risk management discussions are shared with supervisors.
- Medical response planning and resources, to include critical incident support (CISM), should continue to be developed by the fire service.

**Background:** A similar green tree failure event occurred in 2021 on the Middle Fork Complex resulting in the death of a firefighter. Other events of this type may warrant a shift in the way we assess risk in our changing environment. Recent fatalities indicate increased potential for tree strikes in drought stressed forests particularly from live trees which may have been impacted by historic fire events. Increased situational awareness and additional risk assessment may be necessary and needs to be factored into strategic decision making at all levels.

We do not have good data about the trend of green tree failure either fire weakened or otherwise. There is a feeling that failure of green trees may be increasing within the fire environment.
