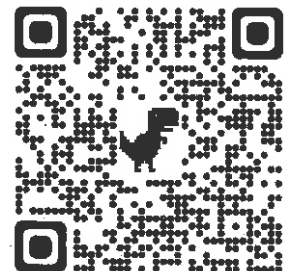

WEATHER DISCUSSION: Today will be a very similar set-up to Friday. It was another night of poor humidity recovery for the 3rd night in a row. This will allow RH to remain very low today. Temperatures will be slightly cooler today. Winds will follow their typical diurnal cycle starting out of the east-southeast and shifting around to the southwest. Expect some gusts 12-15 mph during peak heating. A cooling trend starts Sunday.

Saturday Weather: Sunny and very dry. Very poor recovery along the ridges in the morning.

TEMPERATURES: 79-82 below 3000 feet and 73-77 3000-5000 feet...down 3 degrees.

MINIMUM HUMIDITY: 12-17%...no change.

20 FT WINDS:

RIDGETOP - East northeast 6 to 12 mph with gusts 17 mph through 1100, becoming west to southwest 6 to 10 with gusts 15-18 mph.

SLOPE/VALLEY – Northeast to southeast 4 to 7 with gusts 11 mph through 1100, then switching to up canyon 4 to 7 mph. Near DIV J, gusts 10-12 mph through the afternoon.

INVERSION: Morning inversion lifting around 1100 hours. **MIXING HEIGHT:** 3500 feet **LAL:** 1

Saturday Night: Clear and cooler. Slightly better RH recovery.

TEMPERATURES: 51-58...5 degrees cooler.

MAXIMUM HUMIDITY: 25-35% in the evening, dropping to 20% in the early morning...up 5%.
Lower Elevations (Forest Hill), 40-45%.

20 FT WINDS:

RIDGETOP – West to southwest 6 to 9 mph through 1900, then northeast-east 6 to 9 mph.

SLOPE/VALLEY – Up canyon 3 to 6 mph early, becoming light and variable, then becoming down canyon 3 to 6 mph at 2200.

STABILITY/INVERSION: Moderate inversion setting up overnight. **LAL:** 1


OUTLOOK FOR SUNDAY: A definitive cooling trend will move into the area. Highs will be in the 70s. RH recovery will be about 5% better each night, leading to moister minimum RH values on Sunday afternoon as well. Winds will be slope/diurnally-driven.

EXTENDED FORECAST: There will be a break in the above normal temperatures as a cooler airmass and some clouds move in. The coolest day will be on Monday, before things start to moderate slowly.. RH recovery will be much better to start the week. Winds will be typical diurnal winds with maybe some gusts from the SW in the afternoons.

INPUTS

WEATHER SUMMARY: Clear, warm, and dry weather will continue to dominate for the coming days. A slight cooling trend with better overnight RH recoveries begins Sunday, though recoveries remain moderate to poor. Winds become light & diurnal both day and night with the overnight enhanced easterly breezes fading into typical downslope winds after early Saturday morning. ***See daily Weather Forecasts for details!***

OUTPUTS

FIRE BEHAVIOR

GENERAL:

Continued warm and dry weather has made all fuels more available than normal for the time of year, as evidenced by the high ERC values, which are above daily records and approaching fire season 90th percentile values. Recent interior flare-ups validate the potential for problematic fire behavior if fire establishes over containment lines, during interior island consumption, during needle cast re-burn, or when responding to an IA.

Problematic fire behavior could include isolated torching and flame lengths that challenge direct control efforts without water or air support. Max spotting distances between ¼ & ½ of a mile are likely and may increase if unpredicted winds or terrain channeling are present. Rates of spread will be greatest in areas of slope and wind alignment, but the lack of a strong wind pattern is likely to make initial actions successful. Rates of spread may also be limited in grass and herbaceous fuels greening-up from September precipitation, though this impact will wane in the next 1-2 weeks if no additional precipitation occurs.

SPECIFIC:

Branch 10 (Div. J): Existing containment lines expected to hold. Remaining Interior heat will result in slow to moderate spread in areas of unburned fuel or re-burn in areas with significant needle cast.

Branch 25 (Div. U): Low flame lengths with low to moderate spread in areas without containment. Isolated torching of brush and small trees is likely as fuels remain dry and available for consumption

AIR OPERATIONS:

Air operations may be needed if fire escapes containment or during initial attack support. Inversions will impact air operations until late morning or early afternoon.

SAFETY

The slight uptick in overnight recovery and longer, cooler nights may result in wide swings between fine fuel availability during the early morning hours and mid to late afternoon. Be aware that fine fuels change rapidly in response to changes in hour-to-hour temperature, humidity and sunlight.

Remember, light flash fuels are a common factor in blow-ups and tragedy fires.

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Hazards & Risks

Mine Shafts: Hazardous mine openings have been identified close to Michigan Bluff, Volcanoville, ATV staging areas, roads and trails. Both horizontal and vertical shafts. Be aware of ventilation holes in the ground that may be located some distance from mine shaft openings. Scout out your work areas prior to going to work. Flag areas off and make them known. There are also bat culverts in the area that provide for bat roosting sites. Avoid these sites and consider them a sensitive habitat.

Helicopter Extraction Operations: The intent of a helicopter extraction operation is to insert qualified personnel into inaccessible areas to extract a patient for transport to the nearest medical facility. These operations are not meant to be a medical transport resource but a way to move the patient off the fireline and bring to a waiting air or ground ambulance for direct transport to a medical facility.

Some considerations:

- Establish communications with aircrew. Provide information regarding known hazards (on approach path or in LZ), terrain, wind speed & direction and patient updates.
- Choose the extraction site away from the fireline or black edge.
- Ensure the area is clear of debris and nonessential equipment or personnel.
- Rotor wash may affect overhead hazards and blowing dust can create "brown out" conditions. Protect the patient from blowing dust.
- Aerial supervision is valuable for coordinating aviation medevac missions.
- The aircrew makes the final decision regarding the safety of the mission. **Always have a contingency plan in case the helicopter cannot be used.**
- Don't get caught up in the urgency of the situation and disregard basic fireline and aviation safety procedures.
