## Mosquito Fire Weather Forecast

**WEATHER DISCUSSION:** An upper level trough over the Pacific Northwest will move into the Great Basin over the next few days while an upper level ridge will gradually build toward the area. This will lead to continued dry weather with temperatures a degree or two cooler than Wednesday, but still near normal. Winds on the ridges are expected to be light from the east to northeast this morning, shifting to the southwest near midday, before becoming more westerly in the afternoon. Gusts will be lower than the past couple of days. With the cooler temperatures, afternoon rh is not expected to bottom out as low this afternoon. However, temperatures moderate for Friday and remain a few degrees above normal into early next week with rh dropping into the 20s each afternoon as the ridge gradually builds into Northern California.

**Thursday Weather:** Mostly sunny.  
**TEMPERATURES:** 78-82 below 3000 feet and 73-78 3000-5000 feet...Down 1.

**MINIMUM HUMIDITY:** 25-32%....5% higher.

**20 FT WINDS:**

**RIDGETOP** - East 3 to 6 mph through 1100, becoming southwest to west 5 to 7 with gusts to 14 mph.

**SLOPE/VALLEY** – Down canyon 3 to 6 through 1000, then up canyon 5 to 7 mph with gusts to 9 mph through the afternoon.

**INVERSION:** Morning inversion lifting around 1300 hours. **MIXING HEIGHT:** 4200 feet **LAL:** 1

**Thursday Night:** Mostly clear. Moderate humidity recovery.

**TEMPERATURES:** 53-60... 1 degree higher

**MAXIMUM HUMIDITY:** 50-60%...5% higher.

**20 FT WINDS:**

**RIDGETOP** – Southwest 5 to 7 mph through 1900, then east to northeast 4 to 7 mph overnight.

**SLOPE/VALLEY** – up canyon 4 to 7 mph in the evening, becoming light and variable, then becoming down canyon 4 to 7 mph at 2200.

**STABILITY/INVERSION:** Moderate inversion setting up overnight. **LAL:** 1

**OUTLOOK FOR FRIDAY** Dry and sunny. Southwest ridgetop winds 5 to 7 mph with gusts up to 11 mph in the afternoon. High temperatures will warm to the upper 70s to mid-80s. Minimum humidity 3% lower, with afternoon humidity 21-28%, with night time recovery 40-50%.

**EXTENDED FORECAST:** Temperatures remain a few degrees above normal Saturday to Monday, with mostly sunny to sunny skies and high temperatures in the upper 70s to mid-80s, with minimum humidity 21-28%. Afternoon ridge winds will be out of the southwest to west, gusting up to 12 mph.

### INPUTS

**WEATHER SUMMARY:** WARM, DRY, RH slightly higher, Peak Wind Gusts Backing Off from yesterday

Warm and Dry. Mostly sunny.

Temp: 73-82 max; 53-60min

RH: 25-32% min; Night 50-60% max

Wind (20'): Normal diurnal flow expected, General daytime transport wind SW 5-7mph Gust 14 ridges; AM Ridgetop E 3-6 becoming SW 5-7 in the afternoon; 1900: E 4-7mph; 2200: Down-canyon 4-7mph

Fuel models: 10, TU5, TU1, SH2, TL6

### OUTPUTS

#### FIRE BEHAVIOR

**GENERAL:** Surface Fire activity continues. Sunny skies and lowering RH. 1-hr and 10- hour available to burn in the afternoon. Night fine dead fuel moistures forecasted to hit 11 except for most exposed drier ridge tops.

RH low enough to support fire spread in the fine dead fuels in the afternoon. Slow rates of spread 1-5ch/hr max overall. If fire gets established on an open S aspect aligned with wind and slope, spread rates of 8-15ch/hr max are possible. Isolated pockets of unburned fuel will have potential to support 2ft surface flame lengths and single tree torching where ladder fuels are present.

Single tree torching may occur.

Spotting distances will be short range less than 3/10 of a mile max. Spotting from roll out as heavy fuels burn down on steep slopes may occur.

Fire activity (increasing potential) will continue in areas of the fire that are inaccessible as heavy fuels and duff layers continue to hold heat.

Expect an increase in smoke production in the afternoon. Expect to see more hot spots show themselves as we continue to dry out.

**ERCs for Predictive Service Areas NC05: 47 >32<sup>nd</sup>%; NC07: 44 >32<sup>nd</sup>% Moderate**

**ERC for Bald Mtn RAWS: 51 >32<sup>nd</sup>% Overall Moderate (Approaching High)**

#### SPECIFIC:

**Branch 10:** Existing containment lines are expected to hold. Smoldering and creeping fire. Expect an increase in activity especially in unburned islands but should remain manageable.

**Branch 15/25:** Smoldering and creeping fire. Minimal fire spread/growth in the forecast. Potential for isolated single tree torching, especially around jackpots of heavy fuels. Heat exists in heavy fuels - this can get into timber stringers, jackpots, and isolated pockets of fuels.

#### AIR OPERATIONS:

Mostly sunny with clear skies. Moderate inversion sets up overnight, light smoke settling in drainages in the AM. Mixing height: 4,200ft. AGL, Transport winds: SW 7mph gusting 14.

### SAFETY

Be alert for any heat still present on a slope below your work area. Unburned islands becoming more active.

Fire weakened timber poses overhead hazards. Stump holes will continue to hold heat.

***Firefighter and public safety is our number one priority. Relationship building and clear communications will assist with hazard mitigation.***

Leadership is more than just being able to work within your crew, group, or division. A good leader never stops learning and instills others to do the same. They encourage and support not only those below them but reach out to others outside their sphere of influence. The interactions with outside agencies working on this fire will increase substantially for the foreseeable future. Be a good leader, reach out to them and make first contact. Offer to assist them where appropriate and watch out for their safety as well as yours.

### MAJOR HAZARDS AND RISKS:

**Hazardous Trees:** Be alert of snags. Crews are working in very hazardous areas with numerous snags. Stay diligent, use lookouts, and flag hazardous areas. Damaged trees weaken every day and are a serious hazard that should not be taken lightly. Stay at least 1.5 to 2 lengths of the height of the tree away from any snag or hazard tree.

**Hazardous Roads:** These roads are narrow, steep, and unforgiving. Watch your speed and watch out for each other. The road is closed to the public between 0800-1800 hours. Fire, PGE, and Private Contractors working for the utility companies are allowed.

**Heavy Equipment, Specialized Equipment and Chippers:** When working around heavy equipment stay visible and above machinery. Do not approach heavy equipment unless the operator gives you the OK. Watch for rollout and falling debris. Only contractors will feed chippers. Crews may only bring material to the chipper not feed it. The specialized equipment is capable of reaching extended lengths with material which presents a different hazard. Stay alert for yourself and those around you.

**Aircraft:** If a helicopter is used, maintain good communication with the pilot and be clear of drop area. Always consider risk versus gain and pilot safety before a request for a ship is made. Read the IRPG section in the Blue Pages on directing bucket drops.

**Rolling Rock/Debris:** Utilize good spacing and post lookouts in hazardous areas. Never trust the stability of materials on the upslope and loudly shout out anything coming down the hill.

**Maintain Situational Awareness:** Be aware of what's going on around you, stay engaged, and have a contingency plan if changes occur on the incident.

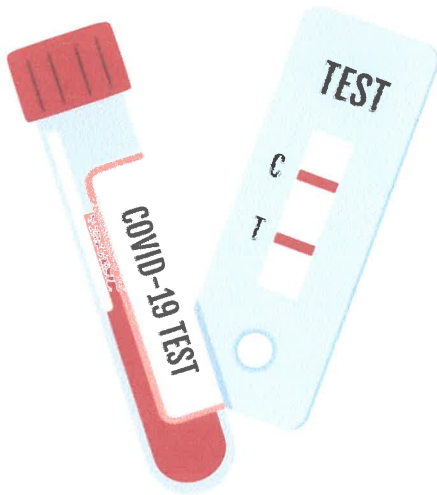
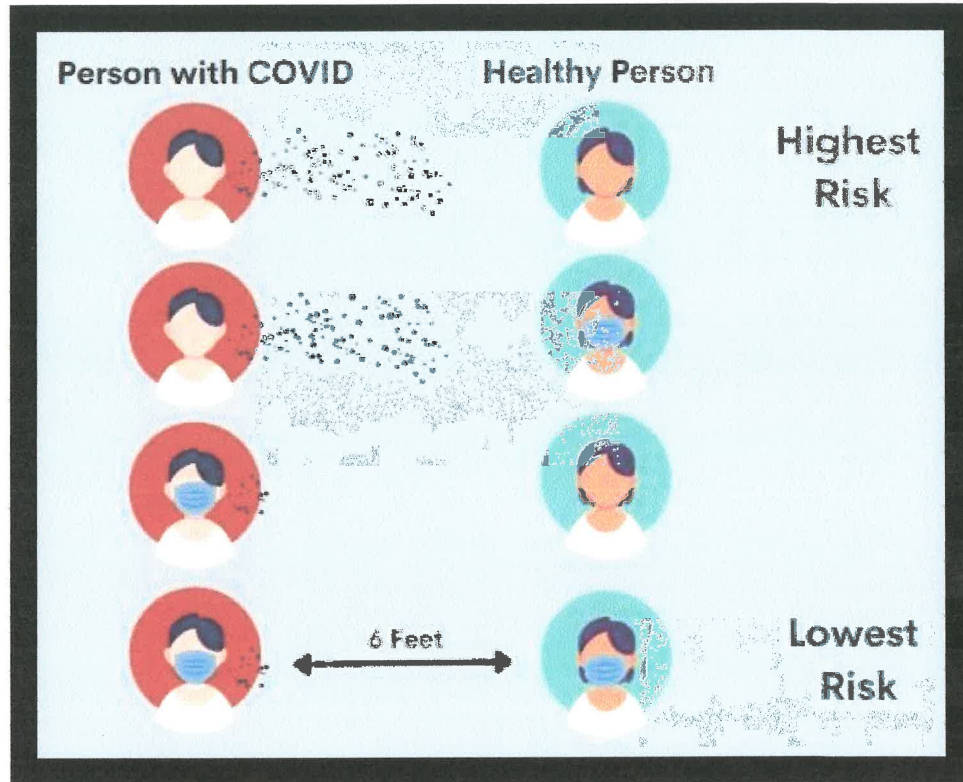

# Reporting Harassment

## Route to ICP for Fire Personnel



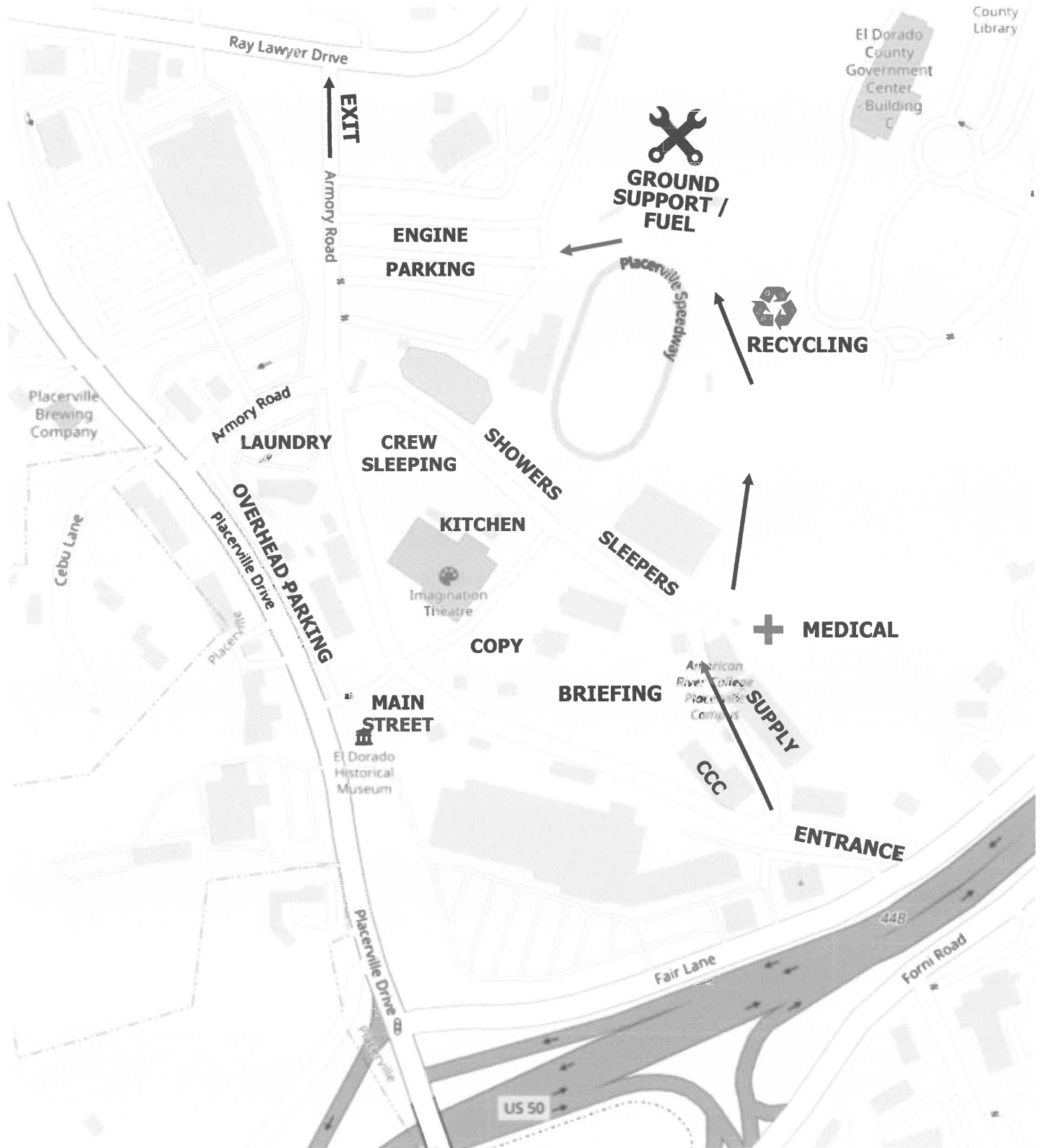
