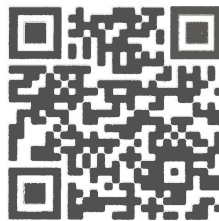

5. GENERAL CONTROL OBJECTIVES

Strategic Framework

Implement a full suppression strategy on the Mosquito Fire. Values at risk include human safety, private timberlands, communities, critical infrastructure and associated improvements. Apply tactics that offer the highest probability of firefighter safety and success.

Leaders Intent

Provide the highest level of customer service to all involved with or impacted by the Mosquito Fire. Ensure transparent timely and accurate communication at all levels of the incident and strengthen relationships with stakeholders and cooperators. All incident assigned personnel should be prepared to take appropriate actions regarding:

- Personnel safety and the safety of others, including driving slowly and defensively.
- Manage fatigue by taking breaks and maintaining work/rest cycles.
- Minimize risk and limit exposure to infectious disease by implementing Center of Disease Control, California Department of Public Health, and agency guidelines.
- Professional behavior, conduct, and timely/effective communications.

Management Objectives

- Provide for firefighter and public safety through hazard recognition and application of the risk management process.
- Coordinate suppression activities, suppression repair, and hazard tree abatement with assigned incident resource advisors to minimize impacts on natural and cultural resources.
- Provide initial attack assistance to both the Eldorado and Tahoe National Forest.

Control Objectives

Keep the Mosquito Fire:

- Keep the fire North of Wentworth Springs Road
- Keep the fire South of Foresthill Road
- Keep the fire East of Todd Valley Road
- Keep the fire West of Duncan Peak Lookout



WEATHER DISCUSSION: An upper level trough will move into the Rockies over the next few days while an upper level ridge will gradually build toward the area. This will lead to continued dry weather with temperatures moderating to a few degrees above normal today and remaining at those levels into early next week. With the warmer temperatures, afternoon relative humidity will trend lower today. Winds during the morning will be from the east to northeast with southwest to west afternoon wind gusts up to 11 mph. Ridgetop winds from the east and northeast are expected again tonight, with gusts up to 14 mph.

Friday Weather: Mostly sunny.

TEMPERATURES: 83-86 below 3000 feet and 77-83 3000-5000 feet... 3 Degrees warmer.

MINIMUM HUMIDITY: 20-27%....3% lower.

20 FT WINDS:

RIDGETOP - East northeast 3 to 6 mph through 1100, becoming southwest to west 5 to 7 with gusts to 11 mph.

SLOPE/VALLEY – Down canyon 3 to 6 through 1000, then up canyon 5 to 7 mph, with gusts to 8 mph through the afternoon.

INVERSION: Morning inversion lifting around 1300 hours. **MIXING HEIGHT:** 4400 feet **LAL:** 1

Friday Night: Mostly clear. Moderate humidity recovery.

TEMPERATURES: 54-61... 1 degree higher

MAXIMUM HUMIDITY: 42-52%...8% lower. Rh peaks by 2200, the falls toward dawn.

20 FT WINDS:

RIDGETOP – Southwest 5 to 7 mph through 1900, then east to northeast 4 to 7 mph overnight with gusts up to 14 mph.

SLOPE/VALLEY – Up canyon 3 to 6 mph in the evening, becoming light and variable, then becoming down canyon 4 to 7 mph at 2200.

STABILITY/INVERSION: Moderate inversion setting up overnight. **LAL:** 1

OUTLOOK FOR SATURDAY Dry and sunny. Southwest ridgetop winds 5 to 7 mph with gusts up to 11 mph in the afternoon. High temperatures will warm to the upper 70s to mid-80s. Minimum humidity similar, 21-28%, with night time recovery 45-55%.

EXTENDED FORECAST: Temperatures remain a few degrees above normal Sunday to Tuesday, with mostly sunny to sunny skies and high temperatures in the upper 70s to mid-80s, with minimum humidity 21-29% and moderate humidity recoveries. Afternoon ridge winds will be out of the southwest to west, gusting up to 12 mph.

WEATHER SUMMARY: WARM, DRY, Night ridgetop winds see gusts up to 14 out of the E.

Warm and Dry. Mostly sunny.

Temp: 77-86 max; 53-60min

RH: 20-27% min; Night 42-52% max

Wind (20'): Normal diurnal flow expected, General daytime transport wind SW 5-7mph Gust 11 ridges; AM

Ridgetop E 3-6 becoming SW 5-7 in the afternoon; 1900: E 5-7mph gusts to 14; 2200: Down-canyon 4-7mph

OUTPUTS

FIRE BEHAVIOR

GENERAL: Surface Fire activity continues. Sunny skies and lowering RH. 1-hr and 10- hour available to burn in the afternoon. Night fine dead fuel moistures forecasted to hit 11 except for most exposed drier ridge tops. 100hr fuels drying out.

RH low enough to support fire spread in the fine dead fuels in the afternoon. Slow rates of spread 1-5ch/hr max overall. If fire gets established on an open S aspect aligned with wind and slope, spread rates of 8-15ch/hr max are possible. Isolated pockets of unburned fuel will have potential to support 2ft surface flame lengths and single tree torching where ladder fuels are present.

Single tree torching may occur.

Spotting distances will be short range less than 3/10 of a mile max. Spotting from roll out as heavy fuels burn down on steep slopes may occur.

Fire activity (increasing potential) will continue in areas of the fire that are inaccessible as heavy fuels and duff layers continue to hold heat.

Expect an increase in smoke production in the afternoon. Expect to see more hot spots show themselves as we continue to dry out.

ERCs FM:Y for Predictive Service Areas NC05: 47 >32nd%; NC07: 47 >32nd% Moderate

ERC FM:Y for Bald Mtn RAWs: 52 >32nd% Overall Moderate (Approaching High)

SPECIFIC:

Branch 10: Existing containment lines are expected to hold. Smoldering and creeping fire. Expect an increase in activity especially in unburned islands but should remain manageable.

Branch 15/25: Smoldering and creeping fire. Minimal fire spread/growth in the forecast. Potential for isolated single tree torching, especially around jackpots of heavy fuels. Heat exists in heavy fuels - this can get into timber stringers, jackpots, and isolated pockets of fuels.

AIR OPERATIONS:

Mostly sunny with clear skies. Moderate inversion sets up overnight, light smoke settling in drainages in the AM. Mixing height: 4,400ft. AGL, Transport winds: SW 7mph gusting 14.


SAFETY

Be alert for any heat still present on a slope below your work area. Unburned islands becoming more active.

Fire weakened timber poses overhead hazards. Stump holes will continue to hold heat.

<p><u>Major Hazard and Risk:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Hazard Tree Safety: Hazard trees, both dead snags and live green trees, are one of the most common risks encountered on the fireline. All firefighters should frequently survey their work area for potential hazards trees. This includes your sleeping areas in camp! ➤ Specialized Equipment: This incident not only has the familiar heavy equipment working it also has some very specialized heavy equipment not usually seen. These pieces of equipment are dangerous and must be treated with the upmost respect. Do not approach any moving heavy equipment and never approach until the operator signals you it is ok. ➤ Hazardous Roads: Narrow roads, steep drop offs and operator fatigue are all prevalent. If road condition is an issue, contact your Division Supervisor to report. ➤ Heat Related Injuries: Stay hydrated, eat properly, drink fluids in a 3:1 ratio of water to sports drink, take frequent breaks, and pay attention to your body. This applies to personnel working in ICP/camp as well. 	
<p><u>Narrative:</u> This fire started about three weeks ago. For some of you, you are on your second assignment here or you may have come from another incident. It is also just about the beginning of October and some of you have been to many fires already this season. Fatigue is cumulative and starts to pile up about now. Resist the impulse to argue with your teammates or crew members. Try and keep a positive attitude even when it's hard to do. Treat others like you would want to be treated and above all watch out for your safety and others around you.</p>	
<p style="text-align: center;">Fatigue and it's Effects</p> <p>#1 – A lack of sleep reduces the capacity of our brains' neurons to communicate effectively.</p> <p>Studies have shown that performance and vigilance after being awake for 17-19 hours tend to be equal or worse to the performance of individuals with an alcohol concentration of 0.05% in their blood, manage work rest to 2:1.</p> <p>#2 – A lack of quality sleep reduces the effectiveness of the “process safety part of the brain.”</p> <p>When being in a state of high fatigue, the brain tends to switch to a more energy efficient way of processing information. As a result, it switches from a conscious, analytical, rational, reflective and thoughtful – prefrontal cortex mode – of reasoning, to a more energy efficient way of processing information that produces automatic, pre-conscious, reactive, habitual and emotion-based actions.</p>	<div style="text-align: center;">  </div> <p>#3 – Fatigue and lack of sleep may lead to risk-taking.</p> <p>The prefrontal cortex, as explained above, also plays a crucial role in inhibiting certain behavioral impulsive acts and regions of the brain. Most sleep and fatigue research supports the hypothesis that sleep deprivation increases many aspects of risk-taking, including simple impairments in attention and judgment, greater willingness to accept risk, and a tendency to focus on short-term rather than long-term consequences.</p>



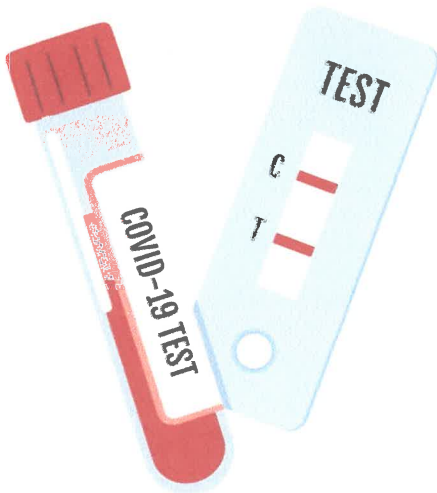
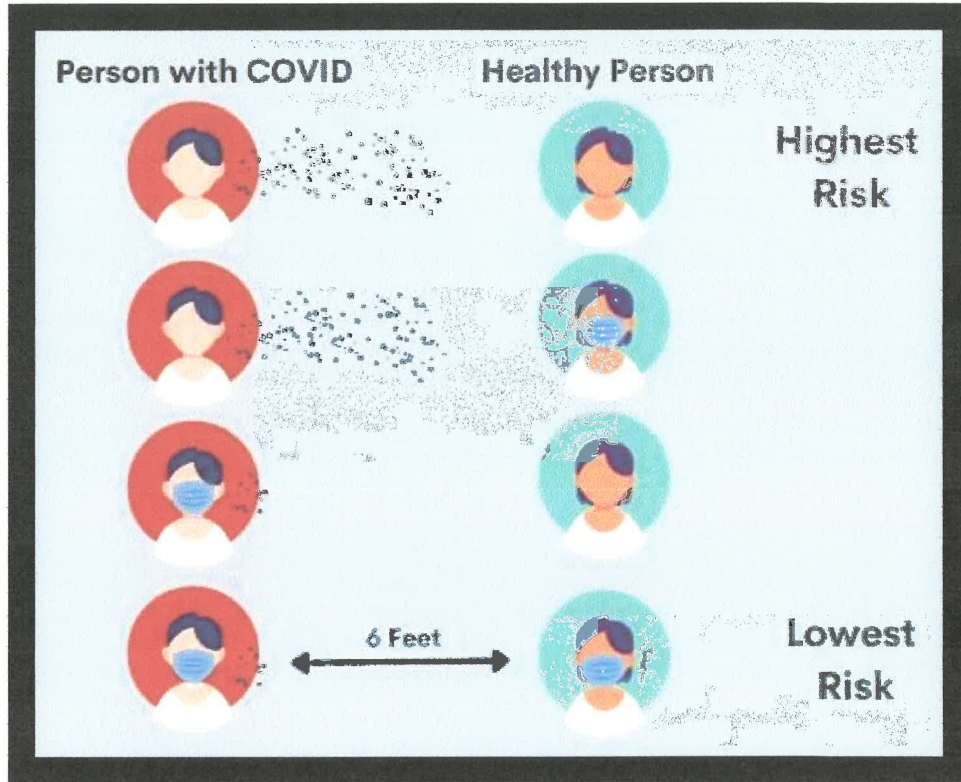

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT WORKPLACE HARASSMENT

Federal Law does not permit harassing conduct by anyone in the workplace, whether you're a Federal, State or Private employee, including contractors.

Two basic types of harassment - "Quid Pro Quo - This for That"
"Hostile Work Environment Harassment"

Quid Pro Quo harassment generally results in a tangible employment decision based upon the employee's acceptance or rejection of unwelcome sexual advances or requests for sexual favors. **Example of quid pro quo harassment** situations involve a manager promising an employee a job, a raise, or a promotion in exchange for a sexual favor. Managers may also promise the employee that he or she will not be fired, reprimanded, or demoted, provided the employee comply with his or her sexual demand.

A **hostile work environment** is a workplace in which unwelcome comments or conduct based on gender, race, nationality, religion, disability, sexual orientation, gender identity, age, or other legally protected characteristics unreasonably interfere with an employee's work performance or create an intimidating or offensive work environment for the employee who is being harassed. This conduct can severely diminish an employee's productivity and self-esteem both in and out of the workplace. **Example of hostile work environment** are; commenting on physical attributes, telling off-color jokes concerning race, sex, disability, or other protected bases; displaying sexually suggestive or racially insensitive pictures; discussing sexual activities;

Workplace harassment is never okay. If this is something you or somebody you know is experiencing, the way to get to stop is by reporting it.

Route to ICP for Fire Personnel



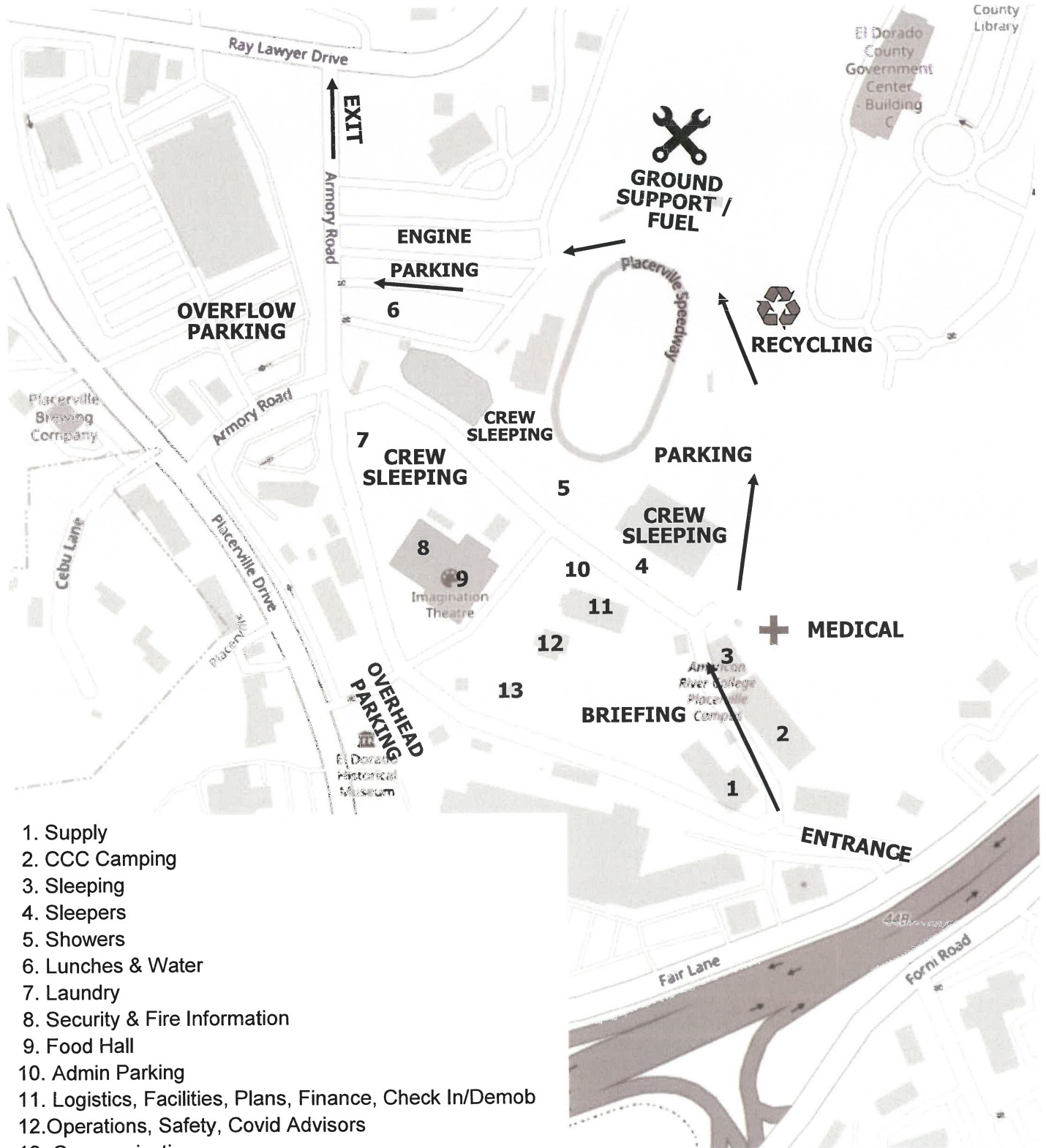
