WEATHER DISCUSSION: Clear, dry weather will persist through the week as high pressure remains in control. Temperatures today will be very similar to Tuesday, with highs climbing back into the mid 80s for lower elevations. RH values will also be very close to Tuesday, bottoming out in the low to mid 20% range. Winds will once again be slope and diurnally driven, favoring a SW to W direction in the afternoon. The warming and drying trend will hold through the week with the warmest day expected on Friday.

Wednesday Weather: Sunny.

TEMPERATURES: 83-86 below 3000 feet and 78-83 3000-5000 feet...1 degree warmer.

MINIMUM HUMIDITY: 22-29%....same.

20 FT WINDS:

RIDGETOP - East northeast 3 to 6 mph through 1100, becoming southwest to west 5 to 7 with gusts to 12 mph.

SLOPE/VALLEY – Down canyon 3 to 6 through 1000, then up canyon 5 to 7mph, with gusts to 8 mph through the afternoon.

INVERSION: Morning inversion lifting around 1200 hours. **MIXING HEIGHT:** 3200 feet **LAL:** 1

Wednesday Night: Mostly clear. Moderate humidity recovery.

TEMPERATURES: 57-64...1 degree warmer.

MAXIMUM HUMIDITY: 42-52%...Down 3 percent.

20 FT WINDS:

RIDGETOP – Southwest 5 to 7 mph through 1900, then east 4 to 6 mph overnight.

SLOPE/VALLEY – Up canyon 3 to 6 mph early, becoming light and variable, then becoming down canyon 4 to 7 mph at 2200.

STABILITY/INVERSION: Moderate inversion setting up overnight. **LAL:** 1

OUTLOOK FOR THURSDAY Dry with some passing high clouds. Southwest ridgetop winds 5 to 7 mph with gusts up to 12 mph in the afternoon. High temperatures in the upper 70s to mid-80s. Minimum 3 percent lower, 19-26%, with night time recovery 35-45%.

EXTENDED FORECAST: Temperatures will warm another degree or two for Friday through Saturday, with mostly sunny to sunny skies and high temperatures 78-86, minimum humidity 17-26%, and fair to moderate humidity recoveries. By Sunday, a new weather system will move through the area bringing a chance for some easterly winds.

OUTPUTS

FIRE BEHAVIOR

GENERAL: Surface Fire activity. Smoldering/Creeping. RH. 1-hr and 10- hour available to burn in the afternoon. Night FDFM around 11% except for most exposed drier ridge tops. 100hr fuels lower than avg.

Fine dead fuel moistures support fire spread. Slow rates of spread generally 1-8ch/hr. If fire gets established on an open S aspect aligned with wind and slope, spread rates of could increase to 8-22ch/hr. Isolated pockets of unburned fuel will have potential to support 2ft surface flame lengths and single tree torching where ladder fuels are present.

Single tree torching possible.

Spotting distances will be short range less than 3/10 of a mile max. Spotting from roll out as heavy fuels burn down on steep slopes may occur.

Fire activity continues in areas of the fire that are inaccessible as heavy fuels and duff layers continue to hold heat.

Expect an increase in smoke production in the afternoon. Expect hot spots to show themselves in the afternoon.

SPECIFIC:

Branch 10: Existing containment lines are expected to hold. Smoldering and creeping fire. Minimal fire spread/growth in the forecast.

Branch 25: Smoldering and creeping fire. Containment lines expected to hold. Minimal fire spread/growth in the forecast.

AIR OPERATIONS:

Mostly sunny with clear skies. Moderate inversion sets up overnight, light smoke settling in drainages in the AM. Mixing height: 3,200ft. AGL, Transport winds: SW 7mph gusting 12.

SAFETY

On relatively small fires or deceptively quiet areas of large fires. (IRPG Common Denominators)
 Fire weakened timber poses overhead hazards. Stump holes will continue to hold heat.

Team 12 Transition Tomorrow

Team 12 will transition into command of the Mosquito Fire tomorrow. Your safety is the most important aspect of this incident. The mantra is “Life First” and to ensure success we must all Stop, Think, Talk and then Act. Your family is counting on your safe return.

Firefighter and public safety is our number one priority. Relationship building and clear communications will assist with hazard mitigation.

MAJOR HAZARDS AND RISKS:

Hazardous Trees: Be alert of snags. Crews are working in very hazardous areas with numerous snags. Stay diligent, use lookouts and flag hazardous areas. Damaged trees weaken every day and are a serious hazard that should not be taken lightly. Stay at least 1.5 to 2 lengths of the height of the tree away from any snag or hazard tree. Fallers work within your qualification abilities. Don't take chances with you life. Use spotters, ensure you have a good escape route and keep unnecessary personnel back.

Extended Extraction Times: Know the medial plan and what it will take to extract a yellow or red tag patient. Discuss the plan before going on the line before you need to implement it. The incident has a hoist ship assigned to the incident. READ the Helicopter Extraction Operations section in the IRPG.

Hazardous Roads: These roads are narrow, steep and unforgiving. There are multiple agencies and cooperators using these roads with competing schedules and priorities. Use caution on any of the roads in and around the fire perimeter.

Heavy Equipment \ Chippers: When working around heavy equipment stay visible and above machinery. Do not approach heavy equipment unless the operator gives you the OK. Watch for rollout and falling debris. Only contractors will feed chippers. Feller Bunchers, Drum Chippers, Excavators and large logging machines are common on this incident.

Aircraft: If a helicopter is used maintain good communication with the pilot and be clear of drop area. Always consider risk verses gain and pilot safety before a request for a ship is made. Read the IRPG section in the Blue Pages on directing bucket drops.

Rolling Rock/Debris: Utilize good spacing and post lookouts in hazardous areas. Never trust the stability of materials on the upslope and loudly shout out anything coming down the hill.

Maintain Situational Awareness: Be aware of what's going on around you, stay engaged, and have a contingency plan if changes occur on the incident.

HARASSMENT FREE WORKPLACE POLICY

The Forest Service strives for a harassment-free work environment where people treat one another with respect. Managers, supervisors, and all employees, as well as our contractors, cooperators and volunteers have the primary responsibility for creating and sustaining this harassment-free environment.

All employees, contractor personnel, and visitors must take personal responsibility for maintaining conduct that is professional and supportive. There is a zero tolerance for harassment based on race, national origin, religion, age, mental or physical disability, color, sex, or any other nonmerit factors.

Managers and supervisors must take immediate action to stop harassment (or any other inappropriate behavior), to protect the people targeted and to take all reasonable steps to ensure that no further harassment or retaliation occurs. Employees who witness harassment should report it to the proper authority.

WHAT HARASSMENT IS: Harassment is coercive or repeated, unsolicited, and unwelcome verbal comments, gestures or physical contacts and includes retaliation for confronting or reporting harassment. Some examples include but are not limited to the following: unwelcome touching, inappropriate references to body parts, derogatory or demeaning comments, jokes, or personal question, sexual innuendoes, inappropriate comments, or other verbal abuse.

Individuals who believe they are being harassed or retaliated against should exercise any one or more of the following options as soon as possible: Tell the harasser to stop the offensive conduct; and/or Tell a manager or supervisor about the conduct; and/or any other individual you trust who would act. In addition, you may seek help from the Human Resource Specialist on the incident.

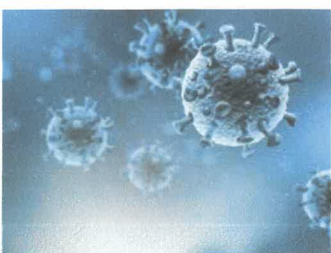
