**Strategic Framework**

- Implement a full suppression strategy on the Mosquito Fire. Values at risk include human safety, private timberlands, communities, critical infrastructure, and associated improvements. Apply tactics that offer the highest probability of firefighter safety and success.

**Leaders Intent**

Provide the highest level of customer service to all involved with or impacted by the Mosquito Fire. Ensure transparent, timely, and accurate communication at all levels of the incident; and strengthen relationships with stakeholders and cooperators. All assigned personnel shall be prepared to take appropriate action regarding:

- Personnel safety and the safety of others; including driving slowly and defensively.
- Fatigue management by maintaining work/rest cycles, taking breaks, and being fit for duty.
- Minimization of risk and exposure to infectious disease through implementation of Center of Disease Control, California Department of Public Health, and agency guidelines.
- Professional behavior, conduct, and timely/effective communication.

**Management Objectives**

- Provide for firefighter and public safety through hazard recognition and application of the risk management process.
- Coordinate suppression activities, suppression repair, and hazard tree abatement with assigned incident resource advisors to minimize impacts on natural and cultural resources.
- Provide initial attack assistance to both the Eldorado and Tahoe National Forests.

**Control Objectives**

- Keep the Mosquito Fire within the current perimeter.



# Mosquito Fire Weather Forecast

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**WEATHER DISCUSSION:** Conditions will remain warm and dry across the fire. Sunny skies will bring a quick warm up once again. Temperatures will climb a few degrees higher, climbing well into the 80s. This will drive minimum RH values down into the lower 20% range. Winds will remain generally light and slope/diurnally driven. A few high clouds will move in late and hamper RH recovery Thursday night into Friday morning. This will also set the stage for Friday to be the warmest day of the week.

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**Thursday Weather:** Sunny with a few high clouds late.  
**TEMPERATURES:** 84-87 below 3000 feet and 79-84 3000-5000 feet... 1 degree warmer.

**MINIMUM HUMIDITY:** 20-27%....down 2 percent.

**20 FT WINDS:**

**RIDGETOP** - East northeast 3 to 6 mph through 1100, becoming southwest to west 5 to 7 with gusts to 13 mph.

**SLOPE/VALLEY** – Down canyon 3 to 6 through 1000, then up canyon 5 to 7mph, with gusts to 8 mph through the afternoon.

**INVERSION:** Morning inversion lifting around 1200 hours. **MIXING HEIGHT:** 4300 feet **LAL:** 1

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**Thursday Night:** Partly cloudy. Limited humidity recovery.

**TEMPERATURES:** 57-64...no change.

**MAXIMUM HUMIDITY:** 35-45%...Down 7 percent.

**20 FT WINDS:**

**RIDGETOP** – Southwest 5 to 7 mph through 1900, then east 4 to 6 mph overnight.

**SLOPE/VALLEY** – Up canyon 3 to 6 mph early, becoming light and variable, then becoming down canyon 4 to 7 mph at 2200.

**STABILITY/INVERSION:** Moderate inversion setting up overnight. **LAL:** 1

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**OUTLOOK FOR FRIDAY** Friday is expected to be the warmest day of this stretch with high temperatures about 3-5 degrees above normal. The drying trend will continue with minimum RH values starting to dip down into the upper teens. Winds will remain generally light and diurnally-driven. Gusts from 10-15 mph are still expected along the ridges.

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**EXTENDED FORECAST:** Saturday will be the warmest day of the stretch with RHs values falling back to near 20%. Instability will increase a bit as some energy moves in from the north. Sunday will start the trend towards slightly cooler and moister conditions which will continue as we head into next week.

### FIRE BEHAVIOR

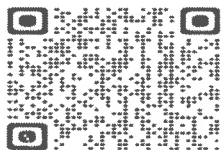
**GENERAL AREA:** (In the event fire spots outside the line or we support a new IA) **Surface Fire activity. Expect slow to moderate rates of spread unless fire lines up with slope and wind especially in areas with continuous grass and brush, if this occurs, torching is possible. Review pocket cards to track trends and thresholds for the area.**

Fine dead fuel moistures support fire spread, break point is FDFM <5. Rates of spread generally 1-8ch/hr. If fire gets established in an open area aligned with wind and slope, spread rates increase to 8-22ch/hr.

Torching possible. Spotting distances will be short range less than 3/10 of a mile max (wind speed dependent).

Fire activity continues in areas of the fire that are inaccessible as heavy fuels and duff layers continue to hold heat. Expect hot spots to show themselves in the afternoon.

#### SPECIFIC:

**Branch 10:** Existing containment lines are expected to hold. Smoldering and creeping fire. Minimal fire spread/growth in the forecast. Isolated inaccessible areas still hold heat.

**Branch 25:** Smoldering and creeping fire. Containment lines expected to hold. Minimal fire spread/growth in the forecast. Isolated inaccessible areas still hold heat.

#### AIR OPERATIONS:

Moderate inversion sets up overnight, light smoke settling in drainages in the AM. See daily weather forecast for specifics.

## SAFETY

On relatively small fires or deceptively quiet areas of large fires. (IRPG Common Denominators)

Fire weakened timber poses overhead hazards. Stump holes will continue to hold heat.

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#### **Hazards & Risks**

**Transfer of Command:** Today is transition day from Team 2 to Team 12. Please keep in mind challenges that come with transfer of command. Some things to think about on transition day: has the communication plan changed? Changes to the IAP in leadership? New Division or Branch you are reporting to? Ensure you are receiving and giving thorough briefings and establish good communication with the incoming resources. Sharing of information is key to the safety of all.

**Working around and with Heavy Equipment:** Remember the limited visibility of the operator. If you can't see his or her face, chances are they can't see you. When working directly with Heavy Equipment, maintain a safe distance and eye contact with the operator. Sometimes radio communications can be challenging with the noise levels in the area. Conduct a briefing with the operator before getting to work and have a plan. Reference the IRPG for specific guidance.

**Heat Related Illness:** With the temperatures being mild we need to remember heat related illness can still happen. Know the signs and symptoms of heat related stress. Staying well hydrated throughout your entire shift is essential. Good nutrition, fitness level and drinking plenty of electrolyte-replacing fluids along with frequent rest breaks will help reduce the chances of becoming sick.

- **Understand that heat stroke is a life-threatening condition!**
- Review the signs & symptoms and patient treatment guidelines found in the IRPG.

**Stay Hydrated and take frequent breaks!**
