Strategic Framework

- Implement a full suppression strategy on the Mosquito Fire. Values at risk include human safety, private timberlands, communities, critical infrastructure, and associated improvements. Apply tactics that offer the highest probability of firefighter safety and success.

Leaders Intent

Provide the highest level of customer service to all involved with or impacted by the Mosquito Fire. Ensure transparent, timely, and accurate communication at all levels of the incident; and strengthen relationships with stakeholders and cooperators. All assigned personnel shall be prepared to take appropriate action regarding:

- Personnel safety and the safety of others; including driving slowly and defensively.
- Fatigue management by maintaining work/rest cycles, taking breaks, and being fit for duty.
- Minimization of risk and exposure to infectious disease through implementation of Center of Disease Control, California Department of Public Health, and agency guidelines.
- Professional behavior, conduct, and timely/effective communication.

Management Objectives

- Provide for firefighter and public safety through hazard recognition and application of the risk management process.
- Coordinate suppression activities, suppression repair, and hazard tree abatement with assigned incident resource advisors to minimize impacts on natural and cultural resources.
- Provide initial attack assistance to both the Eldorado and Tahoe National Forests.

Control Objectives

- Keep the Mosquito Fire within the current perimeter.



WEATHER DISCUSSION: High pressure will continue to keep things warm and quite dry. There will be enough instability today to allow for some clouds to develop along the Sierra Crest. There will be an outside chance of a shower or thunderstorm near the Crest, but it will just be clouds for the most part. Winds will be a bit lower than Sunday with gusts to 18 mph along the ridges.

Monday Weather: Partly cloudy and dry. Cumulus clouds forming over the Sierra Crest. 5% chance of showers over DIV J, M, R. Outside chance for thunderstorms on the eastern side of the Crest.

TEMPERATURES: 83-86 below 3000 feet and 77-82 3000-5000 feet...little change.

MINIMUM HUMIDITY: 17-22%...little change.

20 FT WINDS:

RIDGETOP - North to northeast 4 to 8 mph through 1100, becoming west to southwest 7 to 10 with gusts 15-18 mph.

SLOPE/VALLEY – Down canyon 3 to 6 through 1000, then up canyon 4 to 7 mph, with gusts 12-15 mph through the afternoon.

INVERSION: Morning inversion lifting around 1100 hours. **MIXING HEIGHT:** 7700 feet **LAL:** 2

Monday Night: Clear. Poor humidity recovery again.

TEMPERATURES: 57-64...no change.

MAXIMUM HUMIDITY: 20-30%...up 5 percent.

20 FT WINDS:

RIDGETOP – West to southwest 6 to 9 mph through 1900, then north-northeast 6 to 9 mph with gusts to 15 mph overnight.

SLOPE/VALLEY – Up canyon 3 to 6 mph early, becoming light and variable, then becoming down canyon 4 to 7 mph at 2200.

STABILITY/INVERSION: Moderate inversion setting up overnight. **LAL:** 1

OUTLOOK FOR TUESDAY: The stagnant weather pattern will resume on Tuesday. High temperatures will be in the lows 80s. RH recovery overnight will start to improve slowly Monday night, but it will still drop into the lower 20% range for Tuesday afternoon. Winds will be slope and diurnally-driven.

EXTENDED FORECAST: A new ridge of high pressure starts to develop for next week. Expect very little change to temperatures and RH, with no sign of rain in the extended forecast. Winds will generally be light and terrain-driven.

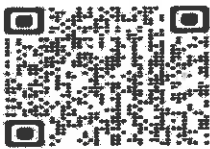

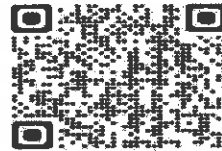
FIRE BEHAVIOR

GENERAL AREA: (In the event fire spots outside the line or we support a new IA) Surface Fire activity. Expect slow to moderate rates of spread unless fire lines up with slope and wind especially in areas with continuous grass and brush, if this occurs, torching is possible. Review pocket cards to track trends and thresholds for the area.
Fine dead fuel moistures support fire spread, break point is FDFM <5. Rates of spread generally 1-8ch/hr. If fire gets established in an open area aligned with wind and slope, spread rates increase to 8-22ch/hr.
Torching possible. Spotting distances will be short range less than 3/10 of a mile max (wind speed dependent).
Fire activity continues in areas of the fire that are inaccessible as heavy fuels and duff layers continue to hold heat. Expect hot spots to show themselves in the afternoon.

ERC Forecast from WIMS: South area of fire, ENF FDRA 335: 55-63 Moderate-High; (Energy Release Component does not include wind)

BI Forecast from WIMS: North area of fire, TNF FDRA 350/354: 45-72 Moderate-High; (Burning Index includes Wind)

SPECIFIC:

Branch 10: Existing containment lines are expected to hold. Smoldering and creeping fire. Minimal fire spread/growth in the forecast. Isolated inaccessible areas still hold heat.

Branch 25: Smoldering and creeping fire. Containment lines expected to hold. Minimal fire spread/growth in the forecast. Isolated inaccessible areas still hold heat.

AIR OPERATIONS:

Moderate inversion sets up overnight, light smoke settling in drainages in the AM.
See daily weather forecast for specifics.

SAFETY

On relatively small fires or deceptively quiet areas of large fires. (IRPG Common Denominators)
Fire weakened timber poses overhead hazards. Stump holes will continue to hold heat.

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Hazards & Risks

Hazard Tree Removal: When working in a Hazard Tree area there are increased risk of you, or your vehicle being struck by a falling tree. Select a safe spot to park your vehicle. Some environmental conditions that increase risk of working in these areas are, strong or gusty winds, steep slopes, and fire weakened timber. Mitigation measures to discuss with your Modules. Minimize exposure by limiting the amount of time you are in the area or staying out of the area all together. Use heavy equipment when possible. Use lookouts and maintain communications with lookouts. Always know evacuation times & have a medical plan in place for the worst-case scenario.

Working around and with Heavy Equipment: Remember the limited visibility of the operator. If you can't see his or her face, chances are they can't see you. When working directly with Heavy Equipment maintain a safe distance and eye contact. If you are just in the area of Heavy Equipment that is working just keep eyes on them and maintain a safe distance. Sometimes radio communications can be challenging, with the noise levels in the area so talk 'with the operator before they start working and have a plan.

Heat Related Illness: Warm and dry conditions are forecast for the fire. Know the signs and symptoms of heat related stress. Staying well hydrated throughout your entire shift is essential. Good nutrition, fitness level and drinking plenty of electrolyte-replacing fluids along with frequent rest breaks will help reduce the chances of becoming sick.

- **Understand that heat stroke is a life-threatening condition!**
- Review the signs & symptoms and patient treatment guidelines found in the IRPG.

Stay Hydrated and take frequent breaks!
