Strategic Framework

- Implement a full suppression strategy on the Mosquito Fire. Values at risk include human safety, private timberlands, communities, critical infrastructure, and associated improvements. Apply tactics that offer the highest probability of firefighter safety and success.

Leaders Intent

Provide the highest level of customer service to all involved with or impacted by the Mosquito Fire. Ensure transparent, timely, and accurate communication at all levels of the incident; and strengthen relationships with stakeholders and cooperators. All assigned personnel shall be prepared to take appropriate action regarding:

- Personnel safety and the safety of others; including driving slowly and defensively.
- Fatigue management by maintaining work/rest cycles, taking breaks, and being fit for duty.
- Minimization of risk and exposure to infectious disease through implementation of Center of Disease Control, California Department of Public Health, and agency guidelines.
- Professional behavior, conduct, and timely/effective communication.

Management Objectives

- Provide for firefighter and public safety through hazard recognition and application of the risk management process.
- Coordinate suppression activities, suppression repair, and hazard tree abatement with assigned incident resource advisors to minimize impacts on natural and cultural resources.
- Provide initial attack assistance to both the Eldorado and Tahoe National Forests.



WEATHER DISCUSSION: Offshore winds overnight will continue through the early morning hours, primarily along ridges over 5,000'. These winds hampered any RH recovery overnight, so expect another day of very dry conditions. Temperatures will be a bit warmer than Thursday. While there may be a stray gust from the east in the morning, winds will make their typical shift to southwest in the afternoon.

Friday Weather: Sunny and very dry. Breezy again over the ridges in the early morning.

TEMPERATURES: 82-85 below 3000 feet and 76-80 3000-5000 feet...up 1 degree.

MINIMUM HUMIDITY: 12-17%...down 3%.

20 FT WINDS:

RIDGETOP - East northeast 10 to 15 mph with gusts 20 mph through 1100, becoming west to southwest 6 to 10 with gusts 15-18 mph.

SLOPE/VALLEY - Down valley 4 to 8 with gusts 12 mph through with 1100, then switching to up canyon 4 to 7 mph. Near DIV J, gusts 10-12 mph through the afternoon.

INVERSION: Morning inversion lifting around 1100 hours. **MIXING HEIGHT:** 5500 feet **LAL:** 1

Friday Night: Clear. Another night of enhanced east to northeast winds overnight along the ridges. Poor humidity recovery again.

TEMPERATURES: 56-63...no change.

MAXIMUM HUMIDITY: 25-30% in the evening, dropping to 15-20% in the early morning...down 1%.

20 FT WINDS:

RIDGETOP - West to southwest 6 to 9 mph through 1900, then northeast-east 6 to 9 mph.

SLOPE/VALLEY - Up canyon 3 to 6 mph early, becoming light and variable, then becoming down canyon 3 to 6 mph at 2200.

STABILITY/INVERSION: Moderate inversion setting up overnight. **LAL:** 1


OUTLOOK FOR SATURDAY: Dry air aloft will continue to make for very poor RH recovery, compounding the drying across the fire area. Saturday should be the warmest in this stretch with temperatures well into the 80s. RH values will dip into the 15% range before slowly rebounding late in the day. Winds should be generally light and terrain-driven.

EXTENDED FORECAST: High pressure will shift away from the area as a weather system approaches the CA coast. Onshore flow will create a subtle cooling trend starting on Sunday and lasting through Tuesday. No sign of precipitation in the next 5 days.

INPUTS

WEATHER SUMMARY: Clear, warm, and dry weather will continue to dominate for the coming days. Above normal temperatures with low day time RH's and poor overnight recoveries will continue to increase fuel flammability across all types and size classes. Periods of localized enhanced overnight winds will be felt on ridges in overnights periods, focused Wed night. **** See daily Weather Forecasts for details/discussion****

OUTPUTS

FIRE BEHAVIOR

GENERAL:

As warm, dry weather persists, fuels will continue to become more available following mid-September precipitation. Energy Release Component (ERC) values have increased to near 90th percentile values and may break some daily records. **This trend will increase fuel availability and lead to continued increases in fire activity in areas of remaining heat or uncontained fire line.** The increases include potential isolated torching as well as re-burn in areas with significant leaf or needle cast resulting from initial fire activity. Max spotting distances between ¼ & ½ of a mile.

In heavy timber understory and brush fuels, spots across fire lines or new initial attack fires could exhibit flame lengths at or exceeding the capability for direct action without water or air support. Rates of spread will be greatest in areas of slope and wind alignment, but the lack of a strong wind pattern is likely to make initial actions successful. Rates of spread may also be limited in grass and herbaceous fuels greening up from September precipitation, though this impact will wane in the next 1-2 weeks if no additional precipitation occurs.

SPECIFIC:

Branch 10 (Div. J): Existing containment lines expected to hold. Remaining Interior heat will result in slow to moderate spread in areas of unburned fuel or re-burn in areas with significant needle cast.

Branch 25 (Div. U): Low flame lengths with low to moderate spread in areas without containment. Isolated torching of brush and small trees is likely as fuels continue to dry and become available.

AIR OPERATIONS:

Air operations may be needed if fire escapes containment or during initial attack support. Inversions will impact air operations until late morning or early afternoon.

SAFETY

The fire has been very mellow for multiple weeks, with limited heat detections via IR flights and none via satellite detection (MODIS/VIRS) in recent days.

If the fire escapes containment or new IA fires occur, burning is likely to be far more aggressive than what your recent observations tell you!

- Fatigue
- Stress reactions
- Hazardous attitudes
- Review your IRPG for more information on these factors
