WEATHER DISCUSSION: A pattern change will take place today. Cooler temperatures and moister RH's are expected as a Fall-like airmass moves over the fire. Better RH recovery last night will help to keep afternoon RH's above 20% this afternoon. Winds will generally be light and slope-driven. The cooler weather and higher RHs will remain for the beginning of next week.

Sunday Weather: Sunny, but cooler. Better RH recovery last night.

TEMPERATURES: 76-79 below 3000 feet and 70-74 3000-5000 feet...down 3 degrees.

MINIMUM HUMIDITY: 22-30%...up 10 percent.

20 FT WINDS:

RIDGETOP - East northeast 4 to 8 mph through 1100, becoming west to southwest 6 to 10 mph.

Gusts to 15 mph in the afternoon.

SLOPE/VALLEY - Down canyon 3 to 6 mph through 1100, then switching to up canyon 4 to 7 mph.

Near DIV J, gusts 10-12 mph through the afternoon.

INVERSION: Morning inversion lifting around 1100 hours. MIXING HEIGHT: 2500 feet LAL: 1

Sunday Night: Clear and cooler. Much better RH recovery.

TEMPERATURES: 46-52...6 degrees cooler.

MAXIMUM HUMIDITY: 45-55%...up 20%.

20 FT WINDS:

RIDGETOP - West to southwest 5 to 7 mph through 1900, then northeast-east 4 to 6 mph.

SLOPE/VALLEY - Up canyon 3 to 6 mph early, becoming light and variable, then becoming

down canyon 3 to 6 mph at 2200.

STABILITY/INVERSION: Weak inversion setting up overnight. LAL: 1

OUTLOOK FOR MONDAY: The shift to cooler weather will hold for Monday. RH recovery to start the day will be the highest the fire area has seen in over a week. Sunny skies early will yield some rare clouds moving in during the afternoon. Winds will generally be light and slope/diurnally-driven.

EXTENDED FORECAST: Cooler weather with higher RHs and some clouds will linger through at least Tuesday. By Wednesday, a new ridge of high pressure starts to build in allowing temperatures to climb a few degrees. This will let minimum RH values start to fall towards 20%. Winds are expected to be generally light through the week.

INPUTS

WEATHER SUMMARY: Clear, warm, and dry weather will continue to dominate for the coming days. A slight cooling trend with better overnight RH recoveries begins Sunday, though recoveries remain moderate to poor. Winds become light & diurnal both day and night with the overnight enhanced easterly breezes fading into typical downslope winds after early Saturday morning. *See daily Weather Forecasts for details/*

OUTPUTS

FIRE BEHAVIOR

GENERAL:

Continued warm and dry weather has made all fuels more available than normal for the time of year, as evidenced by the high ERC values, which are above daily records and approaching fire season 90th percentile values. Recent interior flare-ups validate the potential for problematic fire behavior if fire establishes over containment lines, during interior island consumption, during needle cast re-burn, or when responding to an IA.

Problematic fire behavior could include isolated torching and flame lengths that challenge direct control efforts without water or air support. Max spotting distances between ¼ & ½ of a mile are likely and may increase if unpredicted winds or terrain channeling are present. Rates of spread will be greatest in areas of slope and wind alignment, but the lack of a strong wind pattern is likely to make initial actions successful. Rates of spread may also be limited in grass and herbaceous fuels greening-up from September precipitation, though this impact will wane in the nest 1-2 weeks if no additional precipitation occurs.

Consider reviewing pocket cards for local knowledge on fire environment triggers and thresholds:

El Dorado NF ERC Y Pocket Card: NOTE - wind *is NOT* part of ERC



Tahoe NF West Side BI Y Pocket Card: NOTE -wind IS a part of BI



SPECIFIC:

Branch 10 (Div. J): Existing containment lines expected to hold. Remaining Interior heat will result in slow to moderate spread in areas of unburned fuel or re-burn in areas with significant needle cast.

Branch 25 (Div. U): Low flame lengths with low to moderate spread in areas without containment. Isolated torching of brush and small trees is likely as fuels remain dry and available for consumption

AIR OPERATIONS:

Air operations may be needed if fire escapes containment or during initial attack support. Inversions will impact air operations until late morning or early afternoon.

SAFETY

The slight uptick in overnight recovery and longer, cooler nights may result in wide swings between fine fuel availability during the early morning hours and mid to late afternoon. Be aware that fine fuels change rapidly in response to changes in hour-to-hour temperature, humidity and sunlight.

Remember, light flash fuels are a common factor in blow-ups and tragedy fires.

Hazards & Risks

Fatigue and Work-Rest: With many crews coming from other incidents and/or beginning to time out, cumulative fatigue is a growing safety concern. Ensure your drivers are well rested. Give periodic breaks to personnel out on the line and provide adequate time for meals, showers and sleep for those coming off of shift. Good hydration, nutrition and physical conditioning along with adequate rest are factors that help reduce the impacts of cumulative fatigue. Periodic breaks from mental stressors will also help the body recover.

Are You Fatigued? Know the Signs:

- Falling asleep and head nodding
- Feeling restless and irritable with people
- Having difficulty focusing on simple tasks
- Feeling apathetic having a lack of motivation
- Trouble grasping complex situations
- Cannot keep track of the current situation
- Inability to think about several things at once
- Cannot assess risk or anticipating consequences
- Cannot control mood exhibiting inappropriate behavior
- SOLUTION: Rest, good hydration and balanced nutrition

<u>Chipper Operations:</u> Loud, noisy chippers can be a distraction. Assign cutters, draggers & feeders of the beast. Watch where the chip-spray nozzle is being pointed. Have traffic control in place and road guards posted if working along a roadway. Be careful of loose clothing!! Wear all your PPE, especially eye and hearing protection. Use a trained and qualified operator. JHA's are available from the Safety shop.
