#### 3. Objective(s):

#### STRATEGIC FRAMEWORK

Confine, contain, or control all fires utilizing a full suppression strategy. Values at risk include human safety, private timberlands, communities, cultural, critical infrastructure, and associated improvements. Apply tactics that offer the highest probability of success.

#### LEADERS INTENT

Provide the highest level of customer service to all involved with or impacted. Ensure transparent, timely and accurate communication at all levels of the incident and strengthen relationships with cooperators. All incident assigned personnel should be prepared to take appropriate actions regarding:

- · Personal safety and the safety of others, including driving slowly and defensively.
- · Manage fatigue by taking breaks and maintaining work/rest cycles.
- Minimize risk and limit exposure to infectious disease by implementing Center of Disease Control, California Department of Public Health, and agency guidelines.
- · Professional behavior, and timely/effective communication.

#### MANAGEMENT OBJECTIVES

- Prior to engagement, stop and discuss strategies and tactics to ensure sound risk management principles are in place to provide for firefighter and public safety.
- · Implement fire suppression activities in accordance with Incident Resource Advisors.
- Minimize impacts to communities, cultural resources, natural resources including old growth redwoods, critical power, communication and other infrastructure, private property inholdings, Tribal Lands, Timber Lands, TESC Species, and watersheds.

#### CONTROL OBJECTIVES

Keep Fires within the Six Rivers National Forest:

- · Within remote National Forest areas to protect heritage, cultural, natural resources.
- Away from private lands, Hoopa, Orleans, and Hwy 96 to protect the communities along the Klamath River corridor and private lands.

Keep Fires within the Redwood National Park:

· As small as possible and within park lands to protect old growth redwoods, private timber land and cultural values.

### 4. Operational Period Command Emphasis:

- Manage risk to firefighters by ensuring hazards are identified, assessed, and where possible mitigated. Be prepared to accept residual risk when values threatened warrant it and the probability of achieving objectives is high.
- 2. Utilize strategies and tactics that commit responders only to operations where and when they can be successful, and under conditions where important values at risk are protected with the least exposure necessary.
- Contain and control portions of the fire that are a threat to identified values to be protected.
- 4. Mop-up to the extent necessary to prevent escape of the fire and additional spread or damage to other values within the perimeter.
- Implement practices that reduce the potential for spread of infectious disease, such as distributed operations, adhering to CDC guidelines and other actions that improve the health environment for firefighters and support personnel.

#### General Situational Awareness:

- 1. Complete a good size up of your work area to mitigate hazards, 2. Be prepared for changing weather conditions.
- 3. Minimize firefighter exposure to falling tree hazards.
- 4. Know who you are working for.

WEATHER DISCUSSION: An area of low pressure will remain over the region with just enough lingering instability to keep a 15% chance of afternoon showers in the forecast across the SRF Complex. Best chances look to be in Branch X and XX. Otherwise expect partly cloudy skies with temperatures warmer than the last few days but still running near or slightly below normal with valley highs in the upper 70s and lower 80s while the higher ridges above 3000 feet will stay in the upper 60s. General winds will be from the West to Northwest and light. Humidity values will only lower to around 55-65%

FORECAST FOR TODAY: Some patchy morning fog otherwise partly cloudy. A 15% chance of an afternoon rain shower. Rain amount with any showers less than 0.10 with most areas staying completely dry.

Extended Forecast: A seasonal weather pattern sets up for much of next week with weak high pressure at the surface and zonal flow aloft. This should translate to near normal temperatures and little or no precipitation. Daytime highs warming back into the upper 70s ridges with upper 80s and lower 90s in the valleys by mid to late week. Overnight lows in the 50s. Afternoon humidity lowering 30-40% with good nighttime recovery. General winds remain from the West, strongest in the afternoon hours with gusts 10-15 mph but with light slope winds night and morning hours.

<u>Discussion:</u> Lingering clouds and fog this morning with skies turning partly cloudy this afternoon. About a 10% chance of a stray shower or sprinkle this afternoon as lingering instability remains with low pressure finally exiting. Any rain amounts would be less than a tenth with the most likely scenario being no rain over the Lost Fire. Continued seasonably mild with highs in the 60s with high humidity readings. Winds will be onshore or westerly and generally light with gusts to around 15 mph afternoon hours.

**Extended Forecast:** Seasonal weather pattern returns for much of next week with temperatures running near normal and persistent onshore/westerly winds. Daytime highs in the 60s with lows in the 50s. Humidity values remain moist, only lowering 65% afternoon hours with full recovery at night. No precipitation forecast other than patchy drizzle or fog night and morning hours.

FUELS: Primary fuels are conifer with litter and brush understory. The area has multiple burn scars adjacent to the fires with light fuels. Fire scars over 5-8 years old have a higher fuel load. Fire scars beyond 8-10 years old generally have a significant dead and down component with higher and more continuous brush that will support substantially higher rates of spread and intensity under dry conditions.

### Outputs

#### General

Conditions today are similar to yesterday with very good overnight recovery and moderate humidity and temperatures throughout the normal burn period today. Fine dead fuels are saturated due to recent rain, and high humidity recovery at night will slow the recovery to dryer conditions. Down woody fuels will be slow to dry and this will further shorten potential burn periods over the next several days. Average to above average live fuel moisture in the timber and brush will remain. Fire Indices are below average for this time of year and ERC's and heavier woody fuels will be slow to rebound above average for this time of year.

#### FIRE BEHAVIOR:

With the precipitation on the fire over the last 2 days and consistent high overnight humidity recovery, the time needed to dry out fuels will be extended resulting in a period of low fire activity. What activity that occurs will mostly involve the heavy downed woody fuels and stump holes. Little to no fire spread will occur on all of the fires within the complex today.

#### SAFETY:

#### LCES-

Lookouts. When fire activity is high, post as many lookouts as needed to monitor your area of work and the surrounding area. Topography and weather may limit the effectiveness of lookouts; post more lookouts as needed. Establish communication with all lookouts to maintain and improve situational awareness.

<u>Step 3</u>. Submit final time documents electronically to Finance per directions in the IAP. Provide a valid email address. Finance will post your time, let you review a draft, and send your final documents to you, all electronically.

- ➤ MEDICAL INCIDENT REPORTING Do you know what to do in case of a medical emergency? When in the field of operations, call Communications on a command frequency and provide a Medical Incident Report. Review Medical Plan (ICS 206) and become familiar with the "Medical Incident Report". Your actions may be what save a life.
- ➤ PERSONAL HYGIENE & INFECTIOUS DISEASE Wash your hands frequently and before you eat. Limit folks in face to face briefings to key members of your crew to limit spread of germs. Maintain your overall rest, hydration and nutrition.
- ➤ COMMUNICATIONS Test your communications frequently on command to ensure you can reach communications. If you don't, designate the dead areas and work out a plan, i.e. human repeaters, incase you have a medical and need critical resources. Don't wait till an emergency to find out you don't have a way to communicate.
- ➤ HEAVY EQUIPMENT Spend a few minutes in the morning to discuss the hazards of working around heavy equipment & chippers and how to maintain separation and work safety with the equipment.
