STRATEGIC FRAMEWORK

Confine, contain, or control all fires utilizing a full suppression strategy. Values at risk include human safety, private timberlands, communities, cultural, critical infrastructure, and associated improvements. Apply tactics that offer the highest probability of success.

LEADERS INTENT

Provide the highest level of customer service to all involved with or impacted. Ensure transparent, timely and accurate communication at all levels of the incident and strengthen relationships with cooperators. All incident assigned personnel should be prepared to take appropriate actions regarding:

- Personal safety and the safety of others, including driving slowly and defensively.
- Manage fatigue by taking breaks and maintaining work/rest cycles.
- Minimize risk and limit exposure to infectious disease by implementing Center of Disease Control, California Department of Public Health, and agency guidelines.
- Professional behavior, and timely/effective communication.

MANAGEMENT OBJECTIVES

- Prior to engagement, stop and discuss strategies and tactics to ensure sound risk management principles are in place to provide for firefighter and public safety.
- Implement fire suppression activities in accordance with Incident Resource Advisors.
- Minimize impacts to communities, cultural resources, natural resources including old growth redwoods, critical power, communication and other infrastructure, private property inholdings, Tribal Lands, Timber Lands, TESC Species, and watersheds.

CONTROL OBJECTIVES

Keep Fires within the Six Rivers National Forest:

- Within remote National Forest areas to protect heritage, cultural, natural resources.
- Away from private lands, Hoopa, Orleans, and Hwy 96 to protect the communities along the Klamath River corridor and private lands.

Keep Fires within the Redwood National Park:

As small as possible and within park lands to protect old growth redwoods, private timber land and cultural values.

4. Operational Period Command Emphasis:

- 1. Manage risk to firefighters by ensuring hazards are identified, assessed, and where possible mitigated. Be prepared to accept residual risk when values threatened warrant it and the probability of achieving objectives is high.
- 2. Utilize strategies and tactics that commit responders only to operations where and when they can be successful, and under conditions where important values at risk are protected with the least exposure necessary.
- 3. Contain and control portions of the fire that are a threat to identified values to be protected.
- 4. Mop-up to the extent necessary to prevent escape of the fire and additional spread or damage to other values within the perimeter.
- 5. Implement practices that reduce the potential for spread of infectious disease, such as distributed operations, adhering to CDC guidelines and other actions that improve the health environment for firefighters and support personnel.

<u>OUTLOOK FOR SUNDAY:</u> Persistent weather system will be slow to lift out of the area on Sunday. This will maintain at least slight chances for additional rain showers on Sunday. Temperatures for Sunday will be similar to temps on Saturday along with relative humidity values.

Extended Forecast: Weather system will push to the east by Monday. This will lead to temperatures gradually moderating and a very gradual drying trend. Daytime temperatures will remain in the 70s with overnight lows remaining in the 50s. Minimum relative humidity values will fall to near 50 percent and recover overnight to 80 percent or higher.

2023 KNF/RW Complexes Fire Behavior Summary

CIIMT 2 assumed command of the KNF/RW lightning Complexes on August 19, 2023. Fire behavior at the time the team assumed management of the complexes is best described as Fuels and Topography dominated. The fire was mainly in a backing alignment and primary fire spread was active backing and flanking fire through heavy dead and down fuels. The Energy Release Component (ERC) from the North Coast and NW Mountain PSAs were at average for this time of year. Primary fire spread for both complexes was in 100 and 1000 hour fuel types. Some brush fields would burn if they were aligned with wind and slope with clear air. Spotting was generally short range and mainly from rollout. Observed flame lengths were 1-6 feet in timber Fire Behavior Fuel Model (TU-5) and 2-8 feet in the brush (SH-9).

Fire behavior on both Complexes was significantly affected by other fires in the area. Smoke from other fires shaded the complexes which moderated fire behavior. For example very little torching was observed unless the fuels were in direct sunlight.

On August 24th thunderstorms developed over the complexes. Several new starts occurred as a result of the storms. Moisture from the storms moderated fire behavior significantly. ERCs for both PSAs dropped to well below average as a result of the rain and there was an expected decrease in fire behavior.

The fire experienced one day (August 30th) of high winds and dry unstable conditions, fire growth this day was limited to the Copper Fire, which was in clear air and made a slope aligned run in continuous fuels of approximately 500 acres. Smoke from fires to the north soon shaded this fire and fire behavior moderated.

Transition Day: Go Slow to Go Fast

Regardless of fire behavior or activities, transition is a likely time for things to slip through the cracks! Know who you are working for and establish good communication with them for accountability. If you don't know something, **ASK**. If you have helpful information pass it on. Remember that an obvious hazard to you may be unknown to others, unless YOU communicate it!!!

- There are new division supervisors, do you know who you are working for?
- Do you have an updated map?
- Do you know what command and tactical channels you are using?
- Do you know what to do in case of a medical emergency? (See the ICS 206)

Snags:

- There are dead and fire weakened trees throughout the burn area. Maintain strong situational awareness for snag issues in your work area at all times. Ensure a good size up of the area and only mop-up to the extent needed to secure the line. Look up, look down, and around.
- Perform a risk assessment before working in snags and evaluate the risk vs. benefit.




