STRATEGIC FRAMEWORK

Confine, contain, or control all fires utilizing a full suppression strategy. Values at risk include human safety, private timberlands, communities, cultural, critical infrastructure, and associated improvements. Apply tactics that offer the highest probability of success.

LEADERS INTENT

Provide the highest level of customer service to all involved with or impacted. Ensure transparent, timely and accurate communication at all levels of the incident and strengthen relationships with cooperators. All incident assigned personnel should be prepared to take appropriate actions regarding:

- Personal safety and the safety of others, including driving slowly and defensively.
- Manage fatigue by taking breaks and maintaining work/rest cycles.
- Minimize risk and limit exposure to infectious disease by implementing Center of Disease Control, California Department of Public Health, and agency guidelines.
- Professional behavior, and timely/effective communication.

MANAGEMENT OBJECTIVES

- Prior to engagement, stop and discuss strategies and tactics to ensure sound risk management principles are in place to provide for firefighter and public safety.
- Implement fire suppression activities in accordance with Incident Resource Advisors.
- Minimize impacts to communities, cultural resources, natural resources including old growth redwoods, critical power, communication and other infrastructure, private property inholdings, Tribal Lands, Timber Lands, TESC Species, and watersheds.

CONTROL OBJECTIVES

Keep Fires within the Six Rivers National Forest:

- · Within remote National Forest areas to protect heritage, cultural, natural resources.
- Away from private lands, Hoopa, Orleans, and Hwy 96 to protect the communities along the Klamath River corridor and private lands.

Keep Fires within the Redwood National Park:

· As small as possible and within park lands to protect old growth redwoods, private timber land and cultural values.

4. Operational Period Command Emphasis:

- Manage risk to firefighters by ensuring hazards are identified, assessed, and where possible mitigated. Be prepared to accept residual risk when values threatened warrant it and the probability of achieving objectives is high.
- 2. Utilize strategies and tactics that commit responders only to operations where and when they can be successful, and under conditions where important values at risk are protected with the least exposure necessary.
- Contain and control portions of the fire that are a threat to identified values to be protected.

<u>WEATHER DISCUSSION:</u> A weak weather system will pass overhead today and keep skies partly cloudy this afternoon. There is a 5-10% chance the system could generate a stray shower over the higher ridges and peaks but most areas will see partly cloudy skies this afternoon. Look for an overall trend of warmer and drier bringing conditions back closer to seasonal normals for early September. General winds will be from the west with slope driven winds in the drainages and lower/mid slopes. Increased sunshine will start the drying process for the fine fuels. Mostly clear tonight with good humidity recovery and light winds.

Extended Forecast: A seasonal weather pattern sets up for much of this week with weak high pressure at the surface and zonal flow aloft. This should translate to near normal temperatures and little or no precipitation. Daytime highs warming back into the upper 70s ridges with upper 80s and lower 90s in the valleys by mid to late week. Overnight lows in the 50s. Afternoon humidity lowering 30-40% with good nighttime recovery. General winds remain from the West, strongest in the afternoon hours with gusts 10-15 mph but with light slope winds night and morning hours. Mixing heights currently around 4000-5000 feet should rise to around 6000-7000 feet by late in the week with increased sunshine that will begin to dry out the fine fuels as the fire environment will gradually change.

<u>Discussion:</u> No big day over day changes forecast for the Lost Fire and Branch XL today. A weak weather system will pass overhead and keep onshore winds in place. This should keep skies partly to mostly cloudy over the Lost Fire. Winds will remain moist and predominantly from the northwest direction. Afternoon humidity remains high with full nighttime humidity recovery. Gradual warming and drying, mainly along Holter Ridge and elevations above 1800 feet from Tuesday and beyond.

Extended Forecast: Seasonal weather pattern returns for much of this week with temperatures running near normal and persistent onshore/westerly winds. Daytime highs in the 60s to lower 70s with lows in the 50s. Humidity values remain moist, only lowering 65% afternoon hours with full recovery at night. No precipitation forecast other than patchy drizzle or fog night and morning hours.

FUELS: Primary fuels are conifer with litter and brush understory. The area has multiple burn scars adjacent to the fires with light fuels. Fire scars over 5-8 years old have a higher fuel load. Fire scars beyond 8-10 years old generally have a significant dead and down component with higher and more continuous brush that will support substantially higher rates of spread and intensity under dry conditions.

Outputs

General

Fuel moisture is similar to yesterday with very good overnight recovery. Higher temps and lower humidity throughout the day will have a limited effect on fire spread of even activity today. Fine dead fuels are saturated due to recent rain, and high humidity recovery at night will slow the recovery to dryer conditions. Down woody fuels will be slow to dry and this will last over the next several days. Average to above average live fuel moisture in the timber and brush will remain. Fire Indices are below average for this time of year and ERC's and heavier woody fuels will be slow to rebound above a level that promotes fire growth.

FIRE BEHAVIOR:

Given the seasonality and recent weather the amount of time needed to dry out fuels will be extended, resulting in a period of low fire activity that will last longer than the rebound to active fire spread conditions that would be anticipated earlier in the year. Fire activity that occurs will be limited to the heavy downed woody fuels and stump holes that were able to hold heat through the rain. Little to no fire spread will occur on all of the fires within the complex today.

SAFETY:

LCES-

Lookouts. When fire activity is high, post as many lookouts as needed to monitor your area of work and the surrounding area. Topography and weather may limit the effectiveness of lookouts; post more lookouts as needed. Establish communication with all lookouts to maintain and improve situational awareness.







Share these points with the public as you have an opportunity.

- Recent rains have diminished fire intensity but have not put the fires out. Expect to see more smoke as the weather warms back up, although significant fire movement is unlikely.
- Firefighters are using a combination of direct and indirect attack to safely construct containment lines around the fires where possible. Several fires have already been fully contained and are being checked daily.
- Some of the more remote fires may not have constructed firelines but will be confined using natural fire breaks such as rock outcrops, ridgelines, and old fire areas until wetting rains put the fires out. This strategy provides for firefighter safety while minimizing resource disturbance.
- Suppression of the 2023 SRF Lightning Complex and Redwood Lightning Complex Fires is a collaborative effort involving US Forest Service, National Park Service, California State Parks, Karuk, Yurok, and Hoopa tribal authorities, and many other cooperators working together.
- Activities on the 2023 SRF Lightning Complex and Redwood Lightning Complex fires is being coordinated with other fires in the vicinity including the South Fork Complex, Happy Camp Complex, and Smith River Complex.

Look Up for **Fire weakened and hazard trees** – We know they are there, we know even sturdy trunks can have hazard limbs and we know one snag can live up to the term Widow Maker! While some snags require mitigation, others may not if we don't need to be within falling distance. Weigh the risk vs benefit on every snag! Park in open areas or ensure a good size-up around the area you park.

Complacency – Most injuries occurred during the Mop Up phase of a fire. Keep a heads up for previously identified hazards and NEW hazards as you progress further along the fireline. Do Not assume everyone else is familiar with existing hazards, be sure to communicate hazards as identified! Review the Chipping Risk Assessment and be familiar with working around heavy equipment.

Expect **Driving** hazards around every curve and over every hill - Assume other drivers are distracted and may not be watching out for you. Drive at slow speeds. Keep your lights on, drive to the right side of your lane to provide an extra buffer when passing on coming vehicles. Use appropriate helmet when operating ATV's and UTV's. Ascend and descend hills in the same gear to avoid burning brakes.

Sanitation is a primary defense against **Infectious Disease** – Wash hands as often as possible and use sanitizer when wash stations aren't available on hands before rubbing nose, touching food, reaching into a cooler, or even using tobacco. Use disinfectant wipes on shared cooler tops/handles routinely.

Hazard Tree Safety

Environmental conditions that increase snag hazards:

- · Strong winds
- Night operations
- Steep slopes
- · Diseased or bug-kill areas


Hazard tree indicators:

- Trees have been burning for an extended period
- High risk tree species (rot and shallow root system)
- Numerous down trees
- Dead or broken tops and limbs overhead
- Accumulation of down limbs
- · Absence of needles, bark or limbs
