STRATEGIC FRAMEWORK

Confine, contain, or control all fires utilizing a full suppression strategy. Values at risk include human safety, private timberlands, communities, cultural, critical infrastructure, and associated improvements. Apply tactics that offer the highest probability of success.

LEADERS INTENT

Provide the highest level of customer service to all involved with or impacted. Ensure transparent, timely and accurate communication at all levels of the incident and strengthen relationships with cooperators. All incident assigned personnel should be prepared to take appropriate actions regarding:

• Personal safety and the safety of others, including driving slowly and defensively.

· Manage fatigue by taking breaks and maintaining work/rest cycles.

Minimize risk and limit exposure to infectious disease by implementing Center of Disease Control, California Department of Public Health, and agency guidelines.

• Professional behavior, and timely/effective communication.

MANAGEMENT OBJECTIVES

• Prior to engagement, stop and discuss strategies and tactics to ensure sound risk management principles are in place to provide for firefighter and public safety.

Implement fire suppression activities in accordance with Incident Resource Advisors.

• Minimize impacts to communities, cultural resources, natural resources including old growth redwoods, critical power, communication and other infrastructure, private property inholdings, Tribal Lands, Timber Lands, TESC Species, and watersheds.

CONTROL OBJECTIVES

Keep Fires within the Six Rivers National Forest:

• Within remote National Forest areas to protect heritage, cultural, natural resources.

• Away from private lands, Hoopa, Orleans, and Hwy 96 to protect the communities along the Klamath River corridor and private lands.

Keep Fires within the Redwood National Park:

· As small as possible and within park lands to protect old growth redwoods, private timber land and cultural values.

4. Operational Period Command Emphasis:

 Manage risk to firefighters by ensuring hazards are identified, assessed, and where possible mitigated. Be prepared to accept residual risk when values threatened warrant it and the probability of achieving objectives is high.

2. Utilize strategies and tactics that commit responders only to operations where and when they can be successful, and under conditions where important values at risk are protected with the least exposure necessary.

3. Contain and control portions of the fire that are a threat to identified values to be protected.

4. Mop-up to the extent necessary to prevent escape of the fire and additional spread or damage to other values within the perimeter.

Warming and Drying Trend Starts Today

WEATHER DISCUSSION: High pressure begins to build today with morning clouds mixing out and skies becoming mostly sunny. A noted warming trend with highs back into the 80s mid and lower slopes. Humidity values will be noticeably lower as well, dropping to around 30% under full sunshine on southerly exposed slopes. General winds will be from the Northwest but continued light overall, especially under thick canopy with stronger gusts ridges and areas closer to recent fire scars with brushier fuels. Skies remain mostly clear overnight mid and upper slopes with low clouds in the river valleys. Good humidity recovery except moderate highest ridges above the nighttime inversion layer.

Extended Forecast: A seasonal weather pattern sets up for much of this week with weak high pressure at the surface and zonal flow aloft. This should translate to near normal temperatures and no precipitation. Daytime highs warming back into the upper 70s ridges with upper 80s and lower 90s in the river valleys by mid to late week. Overnight lows in the 50s. Afternoon humidity lowering 30-40% with good nighttime recovery. General winds remain from the West, strongest in the afternoon hours with gusts 10-15 mph but with light slope winds night and morning hours. Mixing heights currently around 4000-5000 feet should rise to around 6000-7000 feet by late in the week with increased sunshine that will begin to dry out the fine fuels as the fire environment will gradually change.

Discussion: A seasonal weather pattern for the Lost Fire and Branch XL as high pressure builds and allows northwest winds to stay in place today. Marine clouds this morning will dissipate during the afternoon as skies turn partly cloudy. Afternoon highs upper 60s to around 70 under full sunshine but cooler under thick canopy. Afternoon humidity lowering to around 60%. Light slope winds under the canopy with ridge winds from the Northwest with afternoon gusts 15 mph exposed ridges. Marine clouds will spread inland tonight with full humidity recovery.

Extended Forecast: Seasonal weather pattern returns for much of this week with temperatures running near normal and persistent onshore/westerly winds. Daytime highs in the 60s to lower 70s with lows in the 50s. Humidity values remain moist, only lowering 60% afternoon hours with full recovery at night. No precipitation forecast other than patchy drizzle or fog night and morning hours.

FUELS: Primary fuels are conifer with litter and brush understory. The area has multiple burn scars adjacent to the fires with light fuels. Fire scars over 5-8 years old have a higher fuel load. Fire scars beyond 8 -10 years old generally have a significant dead and down component with higher and more continuous brush that will support substantially higher rates of spread and intensity under dry conditions.

Outputs

General

Fuel moisture is still above average and will need several days to dry before active behavior is likely. Higher temps and lower humidity throughout the day will have a limited effect on fire spread or even activity again today. Fine dead fuels are still very moist due to recent rain, and high humidity recovery at night will slow the return to dryer conditions. Down woody fuels will be slow to dry and this will last over the next several days. Average to above average live fuel moisture in the timber and brush will remain. Fire Indices are below average for this time of year and ERC's and heavier woody fuels will be slow to rebound above a level that promotes fire growth.

FIRE BEHAVIOR:

Given the warming trend, fuels that were sheltered from the rain or large fuels that retained heat through the rain over the last several days will begin to produce more smoke if they are exposed to low humidity and bright sunny weather throughout the day. Both will be critical for fuels to dry out. The amount of solar radiation reaching the ground due to time of year and the thick timbered areas that have carried the fires so far combined with the recent weather will extend the time needed for fuels to dry enough to support active burning or fire spread. This will result in a period of low fire activity that will be limited to the heavy downed woody fuels and stump holes that were able to hold heat through the rain. Little to no fire spread will occur on all of the fires within the complex today.

SAFETY:

Although fire activity has moderated substantially, there are still lingering effects from the fire activity that can affect firefighters. Varied fire behavior will increase the likelihood that the hazard from snags, live trees and rolling debris will be prolonged, which can increase complacency where the fire did not burn intensely.

Share these points with the public as you have an opportunity.

- Recent rains have diminished fire intensity but have not put the fires out. Expect to see more smoke as the weather warms back up, although significant fire movement is unlikely.
- Firefighters are using a combination of direct and indirect attack to safely construct containment lines around the fires where possible. Several fires have already been fully contained and are being checked daily.
- Some of the more remote fires may not have constructed firelines but will be confined using natural fire breaks such as rock outcrops, ridgelines, and old fire areas until wetting rains put the fires out. This strategy provides for firefighter safety while minimizing resource disturbance.
- Suppression of the 2023 SRF Lightning Complex and Redwood Lightning Complex Fires is a collaborative effort involving US Forest Service, National Park Service, California State Parks, Karuk, Yurok, and Hoopa tribal authorities, and many other cooperators working together.
- Activities on the 2023 SRF Lightning Complex and Redwood Lightning Complex fires are being coordinated with other fires in the vicinity including the South Fork Complex, Happy Camp Complex, and Smith River Complex.


