Discussion:

High pressure will remain in control of the area for the next few days resulting in afternoon temperatures 10 to 15 degrees above normal. Moderate overnight humidity recoveries will occur over the mid-slopes and ridges. Afternoon humidity values will range from the teens to mid 20s over the valleys and mid 20s to mid 30s over the mid-slopes and ridges. Winds today will once again be breezy on the ridges into early portions of the operational period but gradually diminishing by late afternoon.

TODAY:

Sky/Weather: Mostly sunny and hot.

Max Temperature: Valleys: 89 to 95. Mid-Slopes and Ridges: 72 to 80. Min RH: Valleys: 15 to 25 percent. Mid-Slopes and Ridges: 25 to 35 percent.

20 ft Winds: Lower Valleys: Terrain 3 to 7 mph becoming northwest 4 to 8 mph with gusts to 12 mph.

Mid-slopes and Ridges: North-northeast 13 to 17 mph with gusts to 25 mph becoming northwest 6 to 10

mph with gusts to 15 mph after 1400.

Transport Winds: NE 8 mph.

Chance of Rain: 0 percent.

Expected Rain Amount: None.

TONIGHT:

Sky/Weather: Mostly clear. Patchy fog possible in low lying drainages.

Min Temperature: Lower Valleys: 53 to 57. Mid-Slopes and Ridges: 53 to 59. Max RH: Lower Valleys: 60 to 70 percent. Mid-Slopes and Ridges: 35 to 45 percent.

20 ft Winds: Valleys/Lower Slopes: Terrain/down-valley 4 to 8 mph.

Mid-Slopes and Ridges: Northeast 8 to 12 mph with gusts to 15 mph.

Inversion: 300 ft after 2100.

FRIDAY:

Sky/Weather: Continued mostly sunny and hot.

Max Temperature: Valleys: 89 to 95. Mid-Slopes and Ridges: 72 to 80. Min RH: Valleys: 15 to 25 percent. Mid-Slopes and Ridges: 25 to 35 percent.

20 ft Winds: Lower Valleys: Terrain 3 to 7 mph becoming north 4 to 8 mph with gusts to 14 mph.

Mid-slopes and Ridges: North-northeast 8 to 12 mph with gusts to 15 mph becoming west 8 to 12 mph with

gusts to 15 mph after 1400.

Transport Winds: SW 7 mph.

Chance of Rain: 0 percent. Expected Rain Amount: None.

OUTLOOK FOR SATURDAY THROUGH MONDAY: A shift in the weather pattern will begin on Saturday as the ridge of high pressure begins to break down allowing for more onshore flow. This will result in better overnight recoveries and moderate afternoon minimum humidity values. Temperatures will also trend downward through the period returning to near or below normal by Monday. A storm system will approach the area on Monday bringing the strong likelihood of a wetting rain.

FIRE BEHAVIOR

GENERAL:

- Conditions in the fire environment (▲temperature, ▼humidity, ▼fuel moistures) will become increasingly favorable for fire spread.
- Expect additional heat sources in the fire area to become visible.
- Moderate to poor overnight humidity recovery will make fuels available earlier in the day.
- Monitor afternoon winds in your area for alignment with unburned available fuels and slope.

SPECIFIC:

Branch X: Minimal fire activity throughout fire area. Monitor for fire/heat creeping through duff near control features, and the effect of winds in the afternoon on known pockets of heat or potential threats to the line. Keep an eye out for heat holdovers in stump holes or standing trees. Where heat can be smolder for a longtime without showing much smoke.

Branch XX: Minimal fire activity throughout fire area, except for active area on south and east aspects of Lightning Ridge. Heat has been holding in the heavier fuels and will start spreading through available unburned surface fuels as drying continues. Expect some increased activity in the Lightning Ridge area due to higher temps, lower humidities, and fuel moistures. Expect continued backing and flanking spread to the west with possible short uphill runs.

AIR OPERATIONS:

Even with a slight uptick in smoke production, anticipate little impact to air operations from smoke. Little cloud cover expected.

Sunrise: 7:15am, Sunset: 6:49pm, Daylength: 11 hours, 34 minutes, 48 seconds (-2:40 min)

SAFETY:

Fuels that have been harboring heat (logs, stumps, and roots) will more actively burn out. Be heads up for burning debris, rocks, and other material breaking loose and rolling downhill into roads and work areas.

General Safety Concerns:

- Driving: Many backroads allow access around the Bluff Creek and G-O Road closures. Beware
 of the public on roadways, it is hunting season and others drive faster than we do. Morning and
 evening mountain lighting going from sun to shade and shade to sun greatly limits our ability to
 see. HEADS UP!!!
- Risk versus benefit: Don't get caught up in the moment! Always weigh the risks of tactical
 operations against the potential benefit. Especially on steep slopes and in snag areas!
- Fuel conditions: Use all of the assessment tools; Heads up for new fires; Ensure LCES is in place; Take extra time to ensure it is safe to engage! Use extra caution all the time.
- Heat: A warming trend has begun and will last the next several days. Maintain equal work/rest
 cycles. Hydrate, hydrate. Ensure proper nutrition. Monitor crews and one another for
 signs of fatigue and heat related symptoms.
- Suppression repair: Remain diligent of steep terrain and loose soils. Rock strikes and new starts from heavy equipment continues to pose threats.

If you see a hazard or a dangerous situation developing, tell your supervisor and those around you.

Leaders set the Example

Line leadership has the responsibility to provide a behavior model for subordinates to emulate and follow. This includes:

- Don't show discouragement when facing setbacks.
- Choose the difficult right decision over the easy wrong one.


