




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Be mindful of work/rest cycles and aerial ops. School in session, watch out for civilians at LZs and both foot and vehicular traffic.

Steep winding roads are throughout the incident. Slow down when driving on loose gravel and blind curves. Drive defensively with headlights on and use hands free devices. Working on steep, uneven terrain. Be mindful of rolling materials.

Ensure radios are properly programmed for today's IAP and that crews are trained in communications procedures for the incident.

Maintain situational awareness. Look up, Look down, Look around

Stay hydrated!!! Time to think = time to drink. Document rest and hydration on 214.

Remain mindful of what is going on around you! LCES!

HEADS UP!!! Lookout for SNAGS when working around areas with burned trees. Evaluate all wind damaged trees with large limbs before working under or around them.

Avoid complacency!!!

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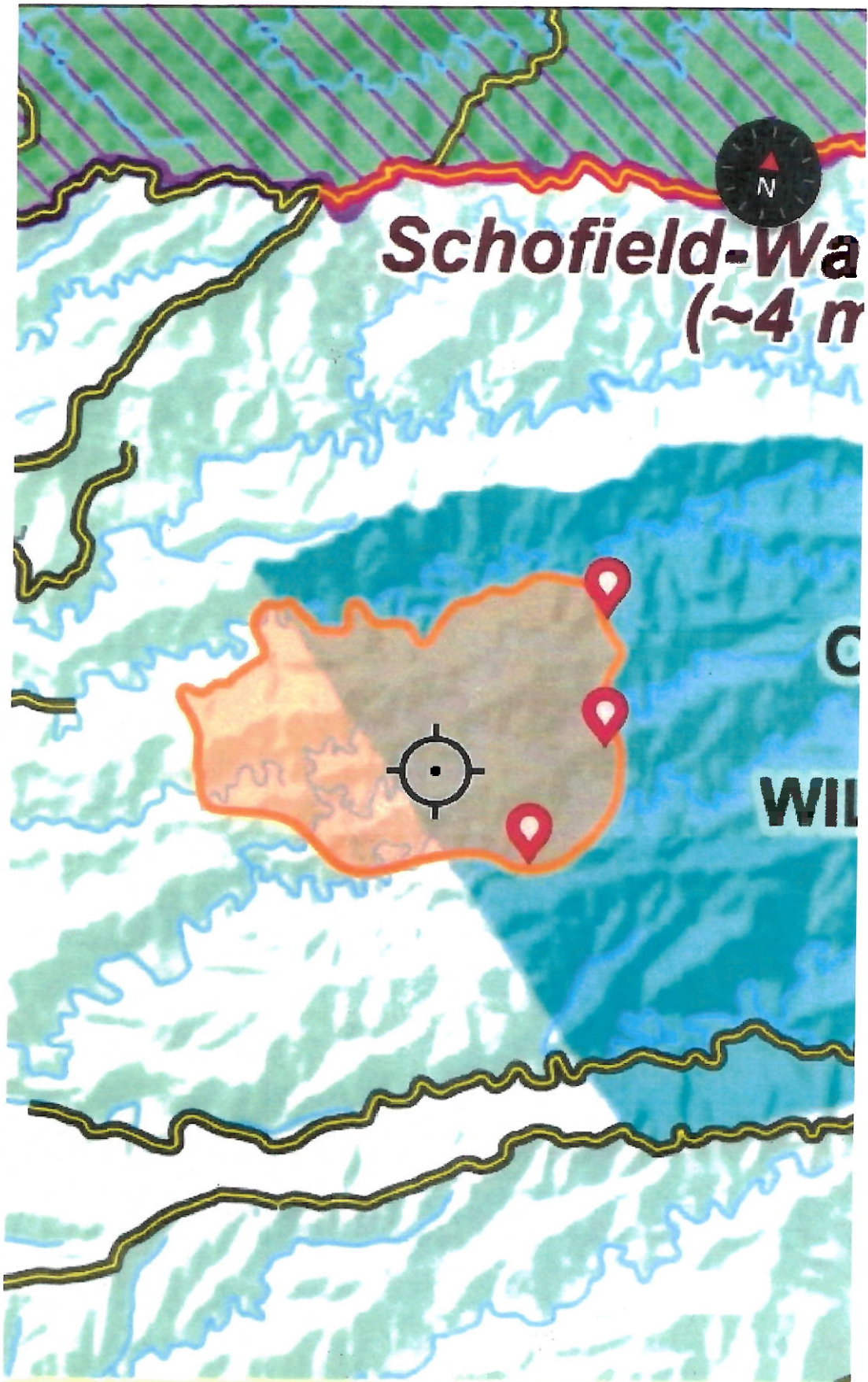

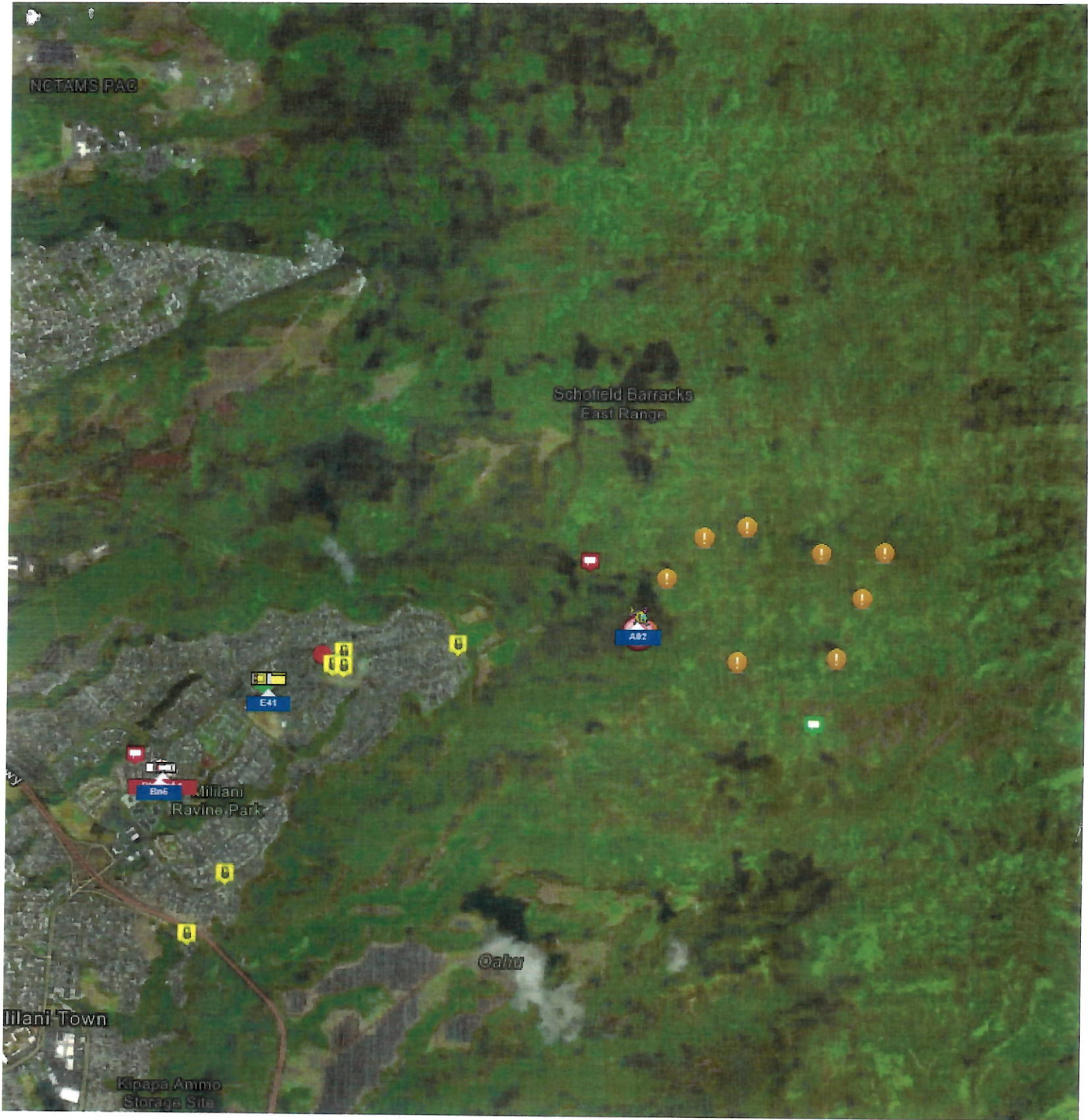

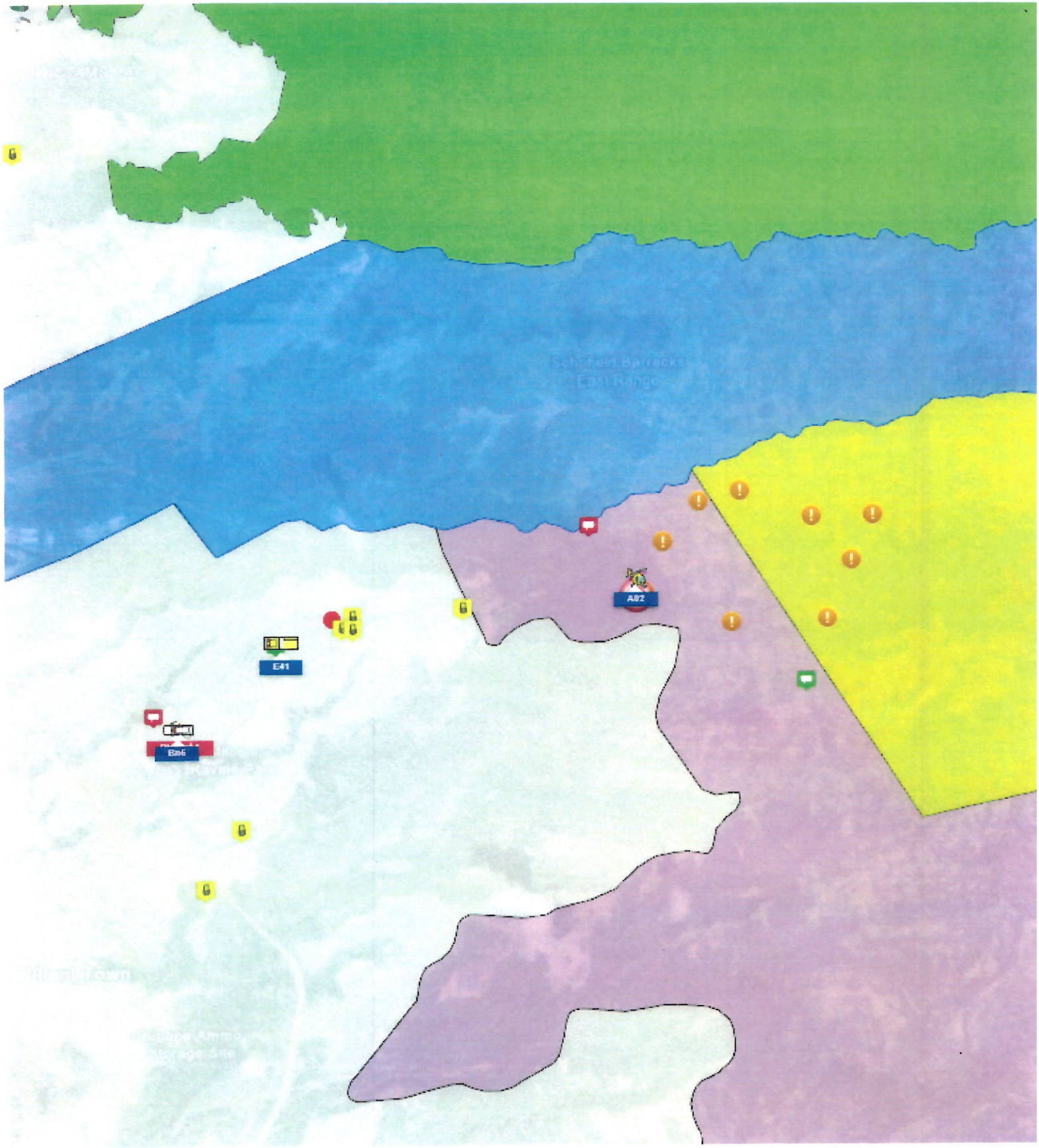
