

Strong and gusty trade winds will continue on Monday, but a band of moisture will move over the burn area by mid morning, bringing increased humidity and frequent showers. Wet and gusty conditions will persist through Tuesday. Trade winds and shower activity will decline on Wednesday.

Hi-visibility safety vests when working near traffic. Hard hats/eye & hearing protection/chaps if operating chainsaws</p> <p>Maintain isolation zones around helicopter landing zones. Follow helicopter SOPs. Coordinate all air operations with Air Boss.</p> <p>Ensure radios are properly programmed for today's IAP and that crews are trained in communications procedures for the incident.</p> <p>Maintain 720 degree situational awareness. Look up, Look down, Look around</p> <p>Stay hydrated!!! Time to think = time to drink. Document rest and hydration on 214.</p> <p>Remember LCES - LOOKOUTS, COMMUNICATIONS, ESCAPE ROUTES, SAFETY ZONES!!!</p> <p>Lookout for SNAGS and WIDOWMAKERS when working around areas with burned trees. Albizia trees are known to have weak branches that can fall at any time.</p> <p>Practice defensive driving. Drive with caution around steep, winding roads, loose gravel and blind turns.
