FIRE BEHAVIOR FORECAST

GENERAL FIRE BEHAVIOR:

With the present weather pattern the fire will remain fuels driven. This means where continuous fuels are present there will be active burning throughout the forecast period. At night expect the fire to reverse and begin burning down slope, remaining active until approx. 0300hrs. There is a heavy concentration of dead and down fuels so hold over spot fires will continue to be a problem. 1000 and 10,000hr fuels are receptive fuels for spot fires. Expect torching once the RH gets below 25% and the inversion mixes out at approx. 1200hrs. Crown runs are probable where wind and slope align with continuous fuels. Spot fires are possible out to 1 mile.

SPECIFIC:

Branch II

- Expect the fire to continue burning to the north with the slope winds.
- The fire will continue to actively back down slope with some torching expect spots.

Branch III

- Expect the fire to progress to the northeast.
- Torching and spotting are probable with the RH at 25%
- Expect active crown fire where slope aligns with the wind, down slope will be active backing.

Branch IV

- The main fire progression will be to the north east.
- Torching and spotting will continue, out to 1 mile.
- Crown fire is probable in continuous timber.
- In Divisions A, Z&Y expect active backing fire with short range spotting.

Air Operations: Poor visibility until the inversion lifts approx. 1200hrs.

SAFETY:

Fuel moistures are at historic lows ERCs are high, expect extreme fire behavior!

INTENSE FIRE BEHAVIOR: This fire has exhibited a lot of extreme and changing fire behavior due to a number of factors including constantly changing weather conditions, drought-stressed fuels and steep terrain favorable to topography-driven fire spread, and wind alignment. Be prepared for further intense fire behavior and pay close attention to the weather forecasts.

SNAGS/HAZARD TREES: Tree hazards are everywhere on this incident. Flag and warn firefighters of any identified hazard trees. Only qualified fallers will fall trees. Don't let snags compromise your escape routes. Reassess your driving routes often and consider the impact from the fire progression.

DRIVING IN TOWN: We are making a significant impact in traffic to the small towns in the area. Please keep your speeds down and watch for pedestrians and local traffic. School is in session in town, watch for buses and children. Show safety and courtesy to the locals.

LONG TRAVEL DISTANCES: Many of the fire areas are starting to be a long distance from the ICP and Incident Base Camp. Anticipate longer travel distances and drive defensively with lights on, safe speed, seat belts in use, and watching carefully for local traffic.

ACCOUNTABILITY: Maintain crew accountability at night by frequent communications with crews and Base. Know the location of all crew members at all times, you may have to move or take action on short notice.
