

<u>WEATHER DISCUSSION:</u> Low pressure off the West Coast will keep a dry southwest flow aloft over California and continue to spread variable cloudiness over Mendocino County. The onshore flow will continue to slowly spread cooler and wetter conditions further inland over the entire complex area. Branch I continues to be the hottest and driest portion of the forecast area. The afternoon sea-breeze should develop a little earlier than yesterday. Once the sea-breeze develops, the humidity comes up and the temperatures begin to drop within an hour or 2. A weak cold front passes north of the area Thursday night bringing breezy southwest winds to the ridgetops. Cooler temperatures are expected Friday with a significant warming trend early next week.

BRANCHES 1, 2, 3, & Ern 4

Mostly sunny. Areas of smoke in the morning.

Maximums 83-88...down 3. Minimums 22-27%...up 5%.

South 3-7 mph until 1400, then West 7-10 mph with gusts up to 18 mph.

Upslope/upvalley 3-5 mph until 1500 then West 4-8 mph with gusts to 13 mph.

BRANCHES Wrn 4, 5, 6

Fog and smoke in the morning becoming mostly sunny.

Maximums 70-75...little change. Minimums 47-52% and around 40% above 2000'...up 5% on ridges.

Northwest 3-6 mph until 1300, then increasing to 7-11 mph with gusts to 20 mph.

West 2-5 mph until 1400, then increasing to 7-10 mph with gusts to 16 mph. Higher gusts in Boonville.

INVERSION: Moderate smoke in lower drainages will lighten up around 1100, about the same as yesterday. The marine fog will retreat to the West 1000-1200.

Mostly clear. Valley smoke.

Minimums 55-60 except 61-66 on ridges...little change Maximums 80-90% except near 60% on ridges...up 5%

West 3-6 mph after 2100. Downslope/downvalley 2-5 mph after 2100.

BRANCHES Wrn 4, 5, 6

Mostly clear with valley smoke. Fog will develop after 2100.

Minimums 51-55 except 56-61 on ridges...little change Maximums 85-95% except near 65% on ridges...up 5% on ridges

Northwest 4-8 mph after 2100. West 2-5 mph after 2200.

INVERSION: Moderate-heavy smoke will settle into valleys and lower drainages after 2000, mainly near the most active burning. Fog will develop below 2000 feet on the coastal branches after 2100.

OUTLOOK FOR THURSDAY: Partly cloudy, morning fog near the coast. Breezy on ridges in the afternoon. Ridgetop winds West 8-13 mph with gusts to 25 mph. Slope/Valley winds: West 7-11 mph with gusts to 20 mph. Maximum temperatures 65-70 and 80-85 inland. Minimum humidity 50-55% and 28-32% inland.

OUTPUTS

FIRE BEHAVIOR

GENERAL:

The marine inversion will remain in place and the on shore flow will dominate our county. This on shore flow will bring overall cooler and wetter conditions and the dead fine fuels should respond accordingly. The ERC's and large fuels (100 & 1000 HR) are no longer at historic levels but still remain in the critical range. Fire behavior is expected to remain unchanged from Tuesday, and no significant fire growth is predicted. The area with the highest potential for fire growth remains Branch I, Red Mtn., and the northern portion of Branch II. This fire complex continues to be fuel/slope driven. Triggers for dangerous rates of fire spread (1-3 MPH) to watch for will be sustained eye level wind speeds greater than 10 MPH and RH's less than 30%.

SPECIFIC:

<u>Middle, Hardy, Pipe, Lynch Creek, Juan Creek, Indian, Cowshed, Malo A & B,& Cliff:</u> The marine inversion will dominate these fires and RH's are not expected to drop below 50%. Winds will be steady out of the west-northwest and strongest where topographic alignment occurs. Winds are not expected to penetrate the conifer canopies to fire at ground level in most areas. No significant fire spread is expected.

Sugarloaf, Orr Springs, Daugherty Gates, Horse-Albion, Nash, Mc Carvey Creek 1 & 2, & Shingle Mill: The marine inversion will keep RH's the same as Tuesday. The canyon bottom RH's will be in the 50% range and the ridge top should not drop below 40%. Fire activity is not expected to be significant below the marine inversion. Fire activity has the potential to be active on ridge tops and in exposed areas on the eastern and southern flanks of each fire. Fire runs are still possible where light fuels are in topographic alignment (slope and chutes) with the general wind direction, however significant fire growth is not expected.

<u>Jack Smith</u>: The majority of the southern portion of this fire will be sheltered from the NW winds due to the ridge north of Redwood Creek. Winds will be light/ slope driven in sheltered areas. The main concern will be the eastern edge of the fire where NW winds are in alignment with Jack Smith Creek. The fire area will be influenced by the marine intrusion until 10-11 AM, and minimum RH's in exposed areas are expected to be 30-35%. Significant fire growth is not expected.

<u>Red Mt</u>: The most significant threat for fire expansion will be the SE portion of Red Mtn. 3. Current levels of spotting will decrease slightly as the RH increases due to on shore flow. The sea breeze (W-NW winds) should develop earlier in the day than Tuesday, and conditions will be slightly cooler. No significant fire growth is expected.

<u>Branch 1 and the northern portion of Branch II</u>: Winds will be W-NW 7-10 MPH with gusts to 20 MPH in the afternoon, and strongest where winds are in topographic alignment with the major drainages of the Eel River. The minimum RH will be 24-29%. The probability of ignition will be 75%. Head fire (bush) in alignment with the wind and slope has the potential of 2 MPH with flame lengths of 30 ft. Sheltered areas should have much less active fire growth.

AIR OPERATIONS: Pockets of smoke near active fires in the major drainages and valleys. The fog will extend over the western edge of the county for most of the morning. The remaining area should be mostly clear.

SAFETY

This forecast speaks of cooler temperatures and slightly higher RH's, and the predictions of no significant fire growth in many areas of this complex. Observed fire activity the last two days supports this forecast. The elephant (dragon) on the table is *COMPLACENCY*, and it grows each day folks take short cuts and nothing happens! History is full of stories where spot fires and short uphill runs have resulted in fatalities. The ERC's are at critical levels, and the identified triggers for dangerous fire behavior are possible throughout most of the county. Full PPE, LCES and knowing where all personnel are located at all times is critical to your safety. Don't take short cuts. Maintain situational awareness. Don't allow complacency to develop. Have a safe day.

LCES: Lookouts - Communications - Escape Routes - Safety Zones

MAKING LCES WORK:

- Train lookouts to observe the wildland fire environment and to anticipate and recognize fire behavior changes.
- Position lookouts where both the hazard and the firefighters can be seen.
- Set up communications systems radio, voice, or both by which the lookout warns firefighters promptly and clearly of the approaching threat.
- Establish at least two escape routes and make them known.
- Re-establish escape routes as their effectiveness decreases.
- Establish safety zones locations where refuge may be taken without shelter deployment.

DRIVING

Be alert while driving on narrow dusty roads.

Do not assume the roads are clear; watch your speed.

Local vehicles and ATV's are operating within your operational areas.

Hands-free cell phone use law is now in effect !!!!!!!!

EXPOSURES

Limit exposures to the best of your ability.

Poison Oak is very prevalent in most operational areas. Apply Tecnu as a pre-treatment if necessary.

Keep windows up in dusty areas.



This plan will assist Law Enforcement and Fire Department personnel in the implementation of an evacuation plan. It is designed to provide coordination and improve effectiveness in the accomplishment of assigned incident objectives.

Definitions:

- 1. Evacuation Order Movement of community members out of a defined area due to an immediate threat to life and property from an emergency incident.
- 2. Evacuation Warning Alerting of community members in a defined area of a potential threat to life and property from an emergency incident. An evacuation may be ordered as a result of the threat.
- Shelter in Place Directing community members to stay secured inside their current location. Only used if the safety of the citizens can be assured if they remain; or if evacuation will cause a higher potential for lose of life.
- 4. Safe Refuge Area A temporary safe location to hold evacuees until evacuation routes are open.

...Instructions:

- 1. If immediate threat to civilian life (within 1 to 2 hours), refer to the "Immediate Evacuation Plan".
- Establish and co-locate an Incident Command Post (ICO) with Law Enforcement (LE) and the Fire Department (FD). Establish Unified Command or an LE Branch or Group.
- 3. Assess and validate the need for an evacuation warning and/or evacuation order. Determine the location, potential size, and direction of incident spread or travel.
- 4. Notify LE and FD dispatch; request they begin formal notification processes and respond appropriate resources.
- Complete initial Evacuation Plan.
- 6. Coordinate closely with Command and General Staff managing the incident.

This pian will assist Law Enforcement and Fire Department personnel in the implementation of an immediate need evacuation plan. It is designed to provide coordination and improve effectiveness in the accomplishment of assigned incident objectives.

Immediate Need Evacuation Guidelines

- 1. Determine need for an immediate evacuation.
- 2. Order fire and law enforcement resources required to conduct evacuation and mitigate emergency.
- 3. Determine location of evacuation utilizing Thomas Brothers Map or other appropriate map reference; provide map page reference and grid. Include area of incident potential when determining evacuation area.
- 4. Establish an Incident Command Post (ICP); co-locate law enforcement at ICP.
- 5. Unified Commanders determine potential for incident spread and request appropriate resources to complete evacuation and mitigate incident concurrently.
- 6. Divide incident into appropriate divisions of labor and develop incident organization. Establish divisions, groups and staging areas early.
- 7. Identify areas that must be immediately evacuated and label "evacuation order" areas.
- 8. Identify areas that are potentially threatened and label "evacuation warning" area.
- 9. Identify "safe refuge" areas inside evacuation areas.
 - 10. Determine and publish evacuation routes.
 - 11. Identify traffic control points and Levels of Closure(Note: Media is allowed access under all closure levels unless prohibited under PC 409.5)

 Level 4 Closure- Closed to all traffic including FD and LE

Level 3 Closure-Closed to all traffic except FD and LE

Level 2 Closure-Closed to all traffic except FD, LE and critical incident resources (i.e. utility companies CalTrans, County Roads, etc.)

Level 1 Closure-Closed to all traffic except local residents, may require escorts


