WEATHER DISCUSSION: Marine air has filtered over most of the complex allowing temperatures to cool and rh's to rise. Expecting this trend to continue today with the northern half seeing the cooling effects as well. Winds will continue to be light and terrain induced. Smoke should continue to hang through most of the day as winds aloft remain light.

OUTLOOK FOR SUNDAY: Only subtle changes from Saturday to Sunday with slightly lower temperatures and slightly higher rh values. Ridgetop winds West 2-4 mph with gusts to 10 mph in the afternoon. Slope/Valley winds: West or Upslope 3-5 mph with gusts to 10 mph. Maximum temperatures 72-80 coast and 82-89 inland. Minimum humidity 48-57% near coast and 35-43% inland.

WEATHER SUMMARY: Sunny and smoky,

Coast: Day 70°F, 40% RH, Ridge winds NW 3-7 Gusts 14, Slopes – upslope 2-5 mph;

Night – 52-59°F, 90% RH, Ridge Winds NE 2-4, down slope 1-3 MPH.

Interior: Day - 90°F, 35% RH, Ridge winds NE, becoming NW 3-6 Gusts 12; Upslope/canyon 3-6 MPH.

Night – 56-63°F, 70% RH, Winds: Ridges NE 1-2 Valleys down slope 1-3 MPH.

See detailed weather forecast issued 7/11/08 at 1900 hours.

FIRE BEHAVIOR GENERAL:

Fuels have dried down due to intense heat over the last week. Current ERC's for the Boonville RAWs are at all time record levels for any time between the dates of May 1 to Sept. 30 for the data set of 1996-2007. Now the minimum RH's are rising and temperatures will be cooling, but remember that the time lag associated with the dead fuel moisture equilibrium with the air will be slow to react in the larger fuels. Jack pots of dead fuels will continue to burn quite well. The most significant changes will be associated with fine fuels. Spotting potential will drop significantly both on the coast and east of HWY 101. Torching should also significantly decrease except where there are large amounts of fuel loading at ground level. Firing operations may be difficult to start or may result in incomplete fuel consumption if conducted at night. RH recovery should range in the 70-95% across the county so fire activity should diminish at night as well. Overall fire activity should decrease, but the one trigger for extreme fire behavior remains wind speed. Expect fires to run, torch and spot if eye level winds have sustained winds greater than 8 MPH because all but the very fine fuels will remain bone dry. Fortunately these types of wind speeds are not forecasted.

SPECIFIC:

West of US 101 – Larger fuels will continue to burn out but expect much less fire activity associated with interior islands burning out. Spotting should diminish over the course of the day as fine fuel adjusts to increases in minimum RH's. Expect good RH recovery at night.

East of US 101 – The POI associated with spotting indicates that spotting will remain problematic, however at much reduced levels from have been observed the last couple of days. Expect interior islands on SW aspects to continue to burn late in the day. The active burning period will be 1400 to 1800 hours.

AVIATION OPERATIONS: Aircraft support will be limited until the smoke starts to clear around noon. Expect hazy conditions for the remainder of the day.

SAFETY: The one fire behavior factor that trumps all others is wind! ERC's are at all time record levels, and the higher RH effect on the fine fuels will disappear in a heartbeat if any moderate wind speeds materialize at eye level. Don't let your guard down. LCES. Have a safe day.

SAFETY STAND DOWN BRIEFING

The majority of injuries suffered to date statewide can be classified as "preventable." Preventable means that proper preparation before, during and after work duties is key to keeping you injury free. Every individual is responsible for their own safety and well being first, the personnel they serve with second and the citizens they serve third. Constant Situational Awareness is a necessity in order to determine protection, hydration and rest needs. All personnel must ensure their needs and the needs of those they are working with are being met in these areas.

Hydration is equally as key to protecting yourself from injury or illness. Drinking a minimum of one (1) quart of water or more per hour in extreme conditions or arduous work is critical.

ALL appropriate Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) is provided to ALL personnel and must be worn at ALL times during fire suppression operations. PPE is cumbersome, often difficult to work in and hot! As such, personnel must adjust accordingly by staying hydrated, taking frequent rest breaks as needed and communicating limitations to Supervisors. Incident Commanders and Supervisors must take these affects and limitations into consideration during operational planning. Production rates can be drastically reduced during times of extreme heat, low or high humidity's (resulting in high Heat Indexes), fatigue and resource drawdown.

Please take the opportunity to review the Stand Down information that is available. Do so as time allows during your incident operations.

EMERGENCY WATERSHED PROTECTION GUIDELINES FOR GENERAL FIRELINE SUPPRESSION REPAIR

Dozer Lines

1. Install waterbars; spacing not to exceed 100 feet on any dozer line. All areas should be considered to have high erosion potential.

Guideline for spacing of waterbars and rolling dips:

₩	Spacing	Road or Fire Line Gradient

	100 feet 75 feet 50 feet	30% or Less 30% to 50% 50% or Greater

- 2. Waterbars should be deep enough to significantly reduce the chance of being damaged and should be constructed at an angle of approximately 45 degrees to the fire line.
- 3. Where dozer lines cannot be drained by installation of waterbars (due to steepness or dozer lines within swales), the equipment operator will tractor pack a sufficient amount of woody vegetation into the surface to prevent erosion.
- 4. For dozer lines located along long ridgelines, alternate the direction of the waterbars (in a herring bone configuration), if the situation dictates.
- Waterbars should be located to discharge into natural vegetation where possible; where waterbars are within 75 feet of a watercourse, install sufficient size rocks, other durable organic material and/or pack outlets with slash.
- 6. Remove berms created during dozer line construction.
- 7. Scatter organic debris over dozer line surface near areas where dozer lines intersect roads.
- 8. Reshape cross-slope control lines to as natural a contour as possible and remove lower berm.
- 9. Break apart dozer piles and spread out along dozer line.

Handlines

Install waterbars at the following spacing:

Fire Line Gradient	Spacing
30% or Less	100 feet
30% to 50%	75 feet
50% or Greater	50 feet

- Fill in all under-slung trenches along cross slopes using material from the lower berm. Remove berms to allow flow of water across outsloped fireline.
- Lop and scatter slash along the fire line near road intersections and within 75 feet from a watercourse.
- 4. Where handlines cannot be drained by installation of waterbars (due to steepness or handlines within swales), scatter slash along that portion of the handline to prevent erosion.

Watercourse Crossings

- 1. Remove all displaced soil and debris from the stream channel.
- 2. The excavated channel should be wider than the natural channel.
- 3. Slope back the approaches to prevent future stream bank failure.
- 4. As needed, scatter sufficient quantities of slash to stabilize exposed soil down to the edge of the active channel.
- Clean out culvert inlets and outlets as needed.

General Cleanup

1. Collect all fire suppression-generated trash such as plastic water bottles, cardboard, plastic flagging, foodstuffs, wrappers, blown hose and plastic bags and pack it out.



The citizens of California and CAL FIRE Incident Command Team 4 truly appreciate your hard work on this incident. The purpose of the Incident Base/Camp is to provide service and support for the fire, rest and relaxation for personnel, and potential reassignment to different incidents.

The incident has had more than 2,000 firefighters at the various facilities while in operation. As you know, with any large operation such as this cooperation and understanding from all individuals assists everyone in their endeavors. Please observe common courtesy at all times.

So that you may have a clear understanding of the Command Team's expectations, we have provided the following rules and guidelines which need to be followed.

Prohibited Activities with **ZERO TOLERANCE**:

- 1. Possession or use of <u>DRUGS</u> or <u>ALCOHOL</u> is NOT PERMITTED on Base/Camp or on the incident.
- 2. Returning to the Incident Base/Camp or Incident <u>UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF DRUGS or ALCOHOL is NOT PERMITTED</u>. The entire crew/engine will be released, even if only one crew member is involved.
- 3. Packages may be searched upon entering the Base.
- 4. NO WEAPONS allowed in Incident Base/Camp, <u>Except Law Enforcement Personnel in the ICP Area</u>.
- 5. NO SEXUAL activity.
- 6. NO SMOKING in buildings, food line or around entry areas of Sections/Units.
- 7. NO HORSEPLAY or FIGHTING.
- 8. NO GAMBLING.
- 9. NO LOUD MUSIC.
- 10. NO VULGAR LANGUAGE.
- 11. NO DAMAGE to Fairgrounds buildings, facilities or off-site accommodations.

Limit group sizes if traveling off Base/Camp.

INCIDENT BASE/CAMP WEAR Policy (7070.7.1)


