

MEU COMPLEX WEATHER DISCUSSION: A Pacific low pressure system currently sitting just west of Pt. Arena will remain nearly stationary today before moving east across Mendocino County on Monday. Main affects from this system will be a subtle drop in temperatures today (Sunday) and tomorrow but little change in min rh's is expected. Winds aloft will shift to the south and southwest today...with gustier conditions possible along ridgetops and higher slopes. Instability will be greatest on Monday before stabilizing on Tuesday. A stronger marine push is expected Monday night into Tuesday morning. Little change is expected Tuesday through Thursday, with the marine layer entrenched along the coast, while hot and dry conditions continue across the interior. No significant wind events are expected through Thursday.

WEATHER SUMMARY:

Smoky with warm temperatures and low humidity's through Thursday. Inland high temps into the 90s, and low relative humidity's of 10-15%. Daily ridge winds will trend westerly in the afternoons, becoming northeasterly overnight. Terrain driven slope winds will follow the diurnal pattern. Coastal valleys will have a marine influence during the night and morning fog should be expected, with good overnight RH recovery. Coastal maximum temperatures will range from 72 to 80 with minimum RH's of 20-35%. Monday will see cooler temperatures with possible instability moving through the area however returning to more seasonal conditions for the remainder of the week. Thunderstorms are not expected in the fire area.

FIRE BEHAVIOR:

Local Thresholds:

These factors in combination with a high ERC will still allow for active fire behavior on new incidents: 20' wind speed over 10 mph; RH less than 30%; temperature over 90°. Large dead fuels are much drier than seasonal normal. Expect active burning when RH is below 30%; torching when RH is below 20%. ERC values are tracking above the 90th percentile for the year and above the 97th percentile for this time in the season.

Short Range (July 20, July 21):

Interior smoldering will begin to diminish as active fire cools in areas of unburned fuels. Heavy fuels will continue to hold heat. Falling snags and rolling debris are still a concern. Interior smokes will still be common. Fuel moistures will remain low and receptive to burning. Conditions will be favorable for mop-up and patrol. Initial attack success should remain high.

Medium Range (July 22, July 23):

Some heavy fuels may still hold heat in deep seated timber fuel types and will prove labor intensive during mop up. Interior smokes will still be likely. Fuel moistures will remain low and receptive to burning. No significant adverse fire weather with sustained winds greater than 10 MPH are expected, however warm and dry conditions will persist throughout the fire area.

Long Range (July 24 & later):

Near normal temperatures and no precipitation is expected. Fire indices should track at or above seasonal averages. Conditions will continue favorable for mop up and patrol.

AVIATION OPERATIONS:

Morning low clouds and fog may limit air operations, especially along coastal areas until good daytime mixing occurs. Fog and low clouds should begin clearing between 10 am and noon.

SAFETY:

Indices are above seasonal averages, and the fuels remain primed to burn. Accumulative fatigue must be considered as the season progresses. Maintain situational awareness and LCES as fire moves in this dynamic landscape.

I. RELEASE PRIORITIES

The following Release Priorities have been established by the Incident Commander.

- 1. Out of State resources
- 2. Local Government
- 3. OES
- 4. Federal Agencies
- 5. Military
- 6. Private equipment and personnel
- 7. Out-of-Region CAL FIRE resources
- 8. Within Region CAL FIRE resources
- 9. Home Unit CAL FIRE

II. GENERAL GUIDELINES

A. NO RESOURCES WILL LEAVE UNTIL AUTHORIZED BY THE DEMOB UNIT.

- B. Efforts will be made to ensure that all released personnel arrive home by 2200 hours.
- C. All vehicles shall have an Asbestos mitigating treatment, Sudden Oak Death (SOD) wash treatment and a Mechanical Safety Inspection.
- D. Prior to leaving the Incident the Demob Unit will brief all Supervisors and Strike Team Leaders.
- E. Notification to incident personnel will be by posting "Tentative Demob" list in advance.
- F. Actual departure times and ETA at destination will be relayed to Expanded Dispatch at time of departure.
- G. A Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) self-sign off (On the ICS-221) must be completed by all CAL FIRE personnel. Crew Leaders, Strike Team and Task Force Leaders may sign for subordinates under their command. All incident personnel must be accounted for as having serviceable, agency compliant PPE. Defective items may be exchanged in supply.
- H. All Trainees will see the Training Tech Specialist prior to departure.
- I. Maximum driving duration for federal resources will not exceed 10 hours/person/day.

III. RELEASE PROCEDURES

DMOB will post the date and time when Surplus resources can commence the Demob process and report to the Demob Unit.

The Crew Leader or individual will take the Demobilization Check-out form to:

COML (to confirm that radio and/or cell phone equipment is returned)

SUPL (to confirm all non-expendable property is returned)

GSUL (for Asbestos treatment, SOD wash treatment, and Mechanical Safety Inspection.)

Finance/Time (to confirm all finance and time documents are complete)




DMOB will be the **last stop** in the release process and:

- Collect the ICS-221


