

WEATHER SUMMARY: WIND SHIFT 1400 hours
From northeast to southwest

Today: Clear sunny skies, Maximum temperature 92-95° Minimum Relative Humidity 12-17%
20' winds Ridges northeast 3-6 mph in the morning, becoming Southwest 4-8mph Gust to 17mph
Canyons and Valley Northwest 2-4 becoming southwest-west 3-6 after 1500 hours

Tonight: Clear skies areas of smoke, Minimum temperature 58-64° Maximum Relative Humidity 27-38%

20' Winds: Ridges Southwest 4-7 becoming northwest
Slope and Valley Southwest 5-8 becoming down slope less than 5mph by 2100.

OUTPUTS

FIRE BEHAVIOR

GENERAL: The fire is burning in several major drainages. Terrain is flat to vertical escarpments. The fire is burning in grass oak land with gray pine and heavy brush pockets. Fine dead fuels are at 4%. Dead a down fuels are at, or close to, record lows for this time of year. The brush is making sustained runs when there is a dead fuel loading combined with wind and/or slope. Probability of Ignition 87. Primary spread of the fire has been by torching and then spotting ahead of the main fire.

Specific:

Optimal Forward Rates of Spread in the **oak wood and grass** will be 40-60 chains an hour with 7-9' flame lengths. Flanking fire Rate of Spread will be 4-5 chains per hour with flame lengths of 1-3'. Backing Rates of Spread will be 1-3 with 1-2' flame lengths. Spotting distances up to 1/3 of a mile.

Optimal forward rate of spread in **brush** will be 60-100 chains an hour with 20-25 flame lengths. Flanking fire spread will be 7-9 chains an hour with flame lengths of 6-8'. Backing fire rate of spread will be 2-4 with flame lengths of 3-5' spotting increases to 1/2 mile.

When the **grass is exposed** to the wind, rates of spread will be 80-140 chains an hour.

AIR OPERATIONS:

Smoke will hang in the drainages has the winds decrease around sunrise. As winds pick-up, the smoke will clear and turbulence will increase. Power lines are in the fire area.

SAFETY

With the spotting potential , Safety Zones are a must.
Be sure your safety zone(s) are identified and sized for the fire POTENTIAL.
Ensure everybody is aware of the location of the safety zone(s) and the escape routes.
Have more than one plan and have more than one escape route.
