WEATHER DISCUSSION: High pressure will dominate the weather pattern over California for the next week. A dry southwest flow aloft will keep temperatures around normal with no chance of precipitation. The humidity will change very little from day to day with dry conditions during the afternoon and moderate humidity recovery at night. The wind pattern will be diurnally driven; downslope from the East at night becoming South or Southwest in the afternoon. The wind speeds will not vary by much from day to day and will generally be light, however higher gusts in South to North oriented canyons are possible each afternoon. The weather pattern gets a little uncertain by next weekend as the upper high pressure over the West Coast strengthens and pushes further to the north. This will bring hotter temperatures to the higher elevations, however it will also strengthen the delta push and likely bring cooler and wetter air up the Central Valley to the fire area.

WEATHER FORECAST for Monday

WEATHER: Sunny.
TEMPERATURES: Maximums 90-93.
HUMIDITY: Staying above 20% most of the day with minimums 16-20%.
AFTERNOON 20-FOOT WINDS: Over ridges...South 7 to 10 mph with gusts up to 18 mph. On sheltered slopes...Southwest 4 to 7 mph.

WEATHER FORECAST for Tuesday

WEATHER: Sunny.
TEMPERATURES: Minimums 62-70. Maximums 90-94.
HUMIDITY: Maximums 40% on higher slopes to 55% at lower drainages. Minimums 17-21%.
AFTERNOON 20-FOOT WINDS: Over ridges...South 6 to 9 mph with gusts up to 14 mph. On sheltered slopes...Southwest 3 to 6 mph.

WEATHER FORECAST for Wednesday

WEATHER: Sunny.
TEMPERATURES: Minimums 64-72. Maximums 90-94.
HUMIDITY: Maximums 40% to 50%. Minimums 15-19%.
AFTERNOON 20-FOOT WINDS: South 7 to 11 mph with gusts up to 18 mph on exposed slopes.

EXTENDED FORECAST for Thursday and Friday: Mostly sunny and a little cooler. Maximum temperatures 85-89. Minimum humidity 20% to 25%. Afternoon winds South around 10 mph with gusts up to 20 mph possible.

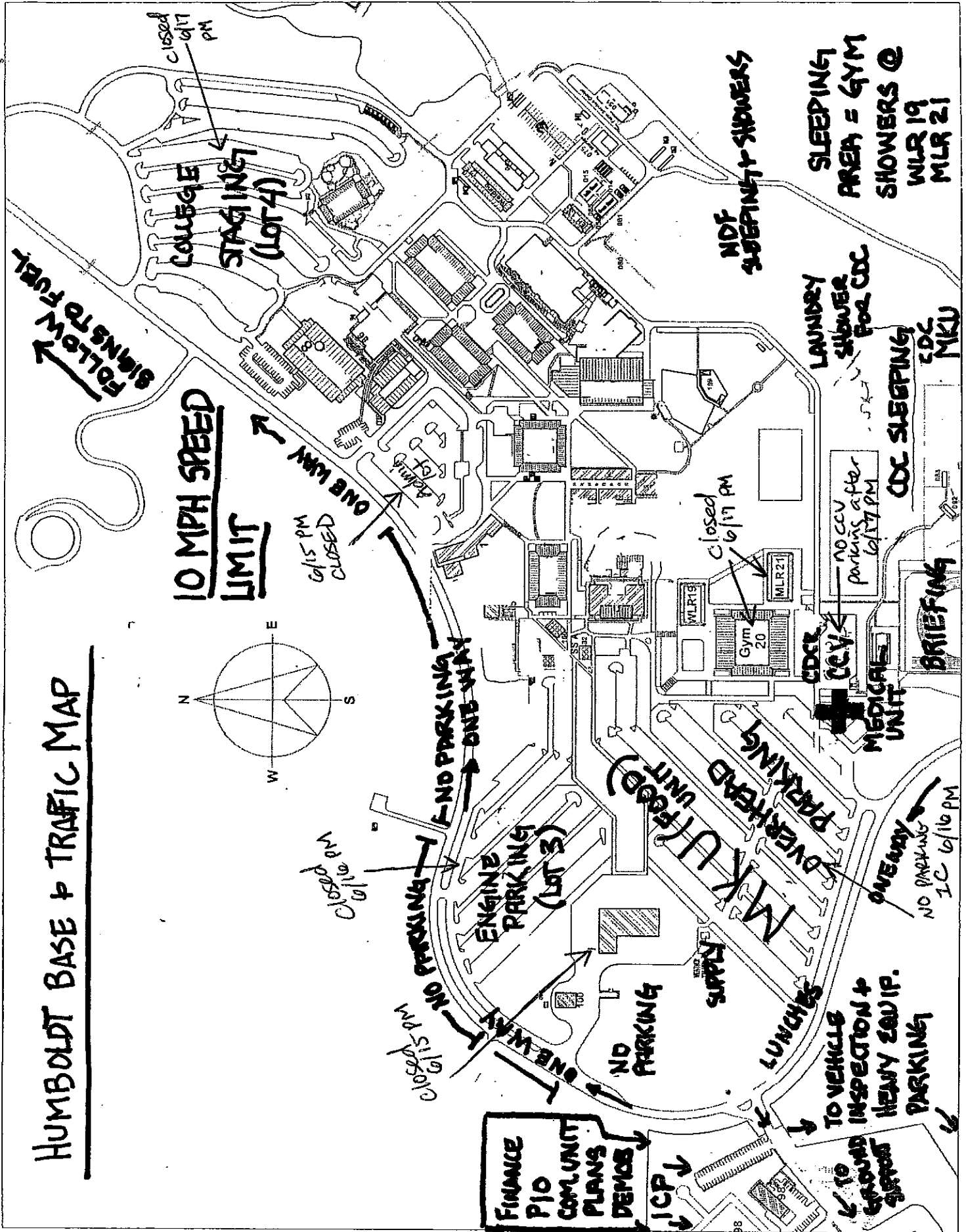
