National Weather Service Sacramento
3:00 p.m. PDT Tue June 17, 2008

..Discussion...

High pressure over the area will continue dry weather with a gradual cooling trend towards the end of the week. A cold front will pass through on Saturday dropping temperatures further..with highs slightly below normal into next week. Downslope winds over the coastal range and foothills of the Northern Mountains and the sierra will bring areas with poor humidity recovery tonight and Wednesday night. Southwesterly flow is expected to increase relative humidity levels from Thursday on. Gusty winds are possible over higher terrain Thursday and Friday evening.

Norther Sierra foothills from 1,000 to 3,000 foot includes porions of Shasta-Trinity and Butte Units.



Repeater and base stations must be programmed with the Rx and Tx reversed.
