

SAFETY MESSAGE



- Dehydration and heat illness can kill. Good conditioning and HYDRATION are critical to ensure a safe return.
- SNAKES become aggressive when threatened, and most snake bites result from harassment of a snake.....just let them lie or encourage them to flee.
- Dozens of people a year die from BEE STINGS, mostly due to anaphylactic shock. Yellow jackets cause nearly 100 deaths a year in the USA.
- Bees can become aggravated from power tools up to 50 yards away, just be cautious and move on if large numbers of aggravated bees invade an area.
- Mosquitoes and ticks are the two largest carriers of debilitating diseases.
- In areas with large old Oaks, ASH PITS and WIDOWMAKERS are a threat, WATCH YOUR FOOTING and maintain SITUATIONAL AWARENESS.
- LOOKOUTS< COMMUNICATIONS<ESCAPE ROUTES<SAFETY ZONES



- ✓ SEEK MEDICAL AID IF STUNG MANY TIMES AND BREATHING IS DIFFICULT, OR IF ALLERGIC TO BEE'S.
- ✓ SNAKE BITES AND OTHER INJURIES REQUIRE IMMEDIATE MEDICAL ATTENTION.
- \checkmark MONITOR TICK BITES TO ENSURE THAT SIGNS OF INFECTION (BULL'S-EYE BRUISE) DO NOT DEVELOP.

.DISCUSSION...

STRONG HIGH PRESSURE OVER THE REGION WILL KEEP TEMPERATURES HOT AGAIN TODAY WITH A FEW HIGH CLOUDS DRIFTING OVER THE LOCATION. A LOW PRESSURE AREA MOVING INTO THE PACIFIC NORTHWEST TODAY WILL HELP TO PRODUCE STRONGER SOUTHWEST AND SOUTH FLOW OVER THE RIDGES TODAY AND THEN TONIGHT. WINDS WILL START OUT EASTERLY IN THE MORNING BUT SHIFT TO THE SOUTH AND THEN SOUTHWEST THROUGHOUT THE MORNING HOURS...BECOMING SOUTHWEST BY 11 AM.
