#### **OUTPUTS**

#### FIRE BEHAVIOR

#### GENERAL:

Most of the current fire perimeter lies within the 2017 Garza fire footprint. The fire area is dominated at lower elevations by cured, grazed annual grasses and live shrubs, transitioning to patchy brush and grass-oak woodland intermixed with gray pines in the upper elevations. Cured grass loading increases significantly with elevation.

Fire danger indices (ERC, BI, SC) at the Alcalde RAWS are near their historic minimum values for the period of record after a several-day window of cooler temperatures and increased humidity. Fine fuels will respond quickly to the warming and drying weather conditions, however, and larger size classes remain seasonally dry and available. Maximum probability of ignition during peak midafternoon burning conditions will be 40-60%.

#### SPECIFIC:

**DIV A/Y:** No further movement is anticipated. Expect isolated heat and smokes interior.

**DIV F/K/L:** No further movement is anticipated. Any heavy fuels still smoldering in this area have been burning for up to a week; be alert for stump holes, ash pits, and fire-weakened trees.

**DIV O/S:** No further movement is anticipated, but changes to the general wind direction may result in enhanced smoke production from previously overlooked areas of heat.

**DIV W:** Isolated heat is still possible near the edges of unburned islands in areas of recent fire activity. Local terrain influences will tend to modify westerly winds to a more northerly direction in this area. Evaluate newly constructed control lines for areas that may still be harboring heat as weather warms and dries.


