DISCUSSION

FRONTAL PASSAGE TODAY

A storm system will swing through California bringing unsettled weather. The Salt Incident is at the tail end of this system with only a few scattered showers developing. OUTPUTS

FIRE BEHAVIOR

GENERAL:

Most of the current fire perimeter lies within the 2017 Garza fire footprint. The fire area is dominated at lower elevations by cured, grazed annual grasses and live shrubs, transitioning to patchy brush and grass-oak woodland intermixed with gray pines in the upper elevations. Cured grass loading increases significantly with elevation.

Fire danger indices (ERC, BI, SC) at the Alcalde RAWS have fallen below their seasonal averages for the period of record and continue to trend downward. Fine fuels will respond quickly to the changing weather conditions, but larger size classes remain dry and available. Absent a wetting rain, maximum probability of ignition during peak midafternoon burning conditions will be 50-70%.

SPECIFIC:

DIVS A / F / K / L: No further movement is anticipated. Expect isolated heat and smokes interior. Any heavy fuels still smoldering in these areas have been burning for nearly a week; be alert for stump holes, ash pits, and fire-weakened trees.

DIVS O / S: The fire has reached control features on both divisions. Heavy fuels interior will continue to smolder and consume; flare-ups remain possible in remaining islands of unburned brush within the perimeter. Watch for burning snags close to control lines.

DIVS W / Y: Rollout potential remains in areas of recent fire activity above steep slopes. Any remaining pockets of unburned fuel adjacent to control features will present a threat until secured, although this risk continues to diminish as weather cools and moistens.

- Situational Awareness: Continue to observe your specific environment and evaluate any changes that can affect your mission and safety. Know what is going on around you.
- Valley Fever: Limit dust exposure. Utilize recirculation for A/C. For more information, please scan QR codes that are in base camp.
- L.C.E.S: Post Lookouts, ensure Communications and everyone is aware of Escape Routes and Safety Zones.
- **Heavy Equipment**: Establish radio and visual contact before engaging. Avoid working below operating equipment. Remain visible during operations.
- **Demob/Travel**: Routes of travel may have tight areas with limited visibility. Pedestrian traffic in Ground Support and base camp can happen at any time. Have patience while driving.

Defensive Driving

- Be the Professional.
- Safe speeds are a must! Use caution when driving on blind corners and watch for civilian traffic.
- Evaluate your driving routes, monitor speed, gear selection, and brake usage.
- Turn on headlights. Prepare for the unexpected.
- Utilize chocks, backers and spotters. When in doubt – scout it out!
- Monitor yourself for fatigue. Stop and take short rest breaks as needed.


