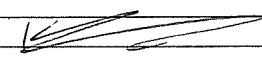

Values at risk associated to the incident include human safety, private and public property and associated improvements, electrical power infrastructure, and cultural values. Minimize acres burned on all lands by utilizing effective and efficient strategies and tactics while maintaining safety first. <u>Leaders Intent</u> Work effectively with cooperative partners towards a common goal of protecting values in a safe and efficient manner. All incident assigned personnel should be prepared to take the appropriate actions regarding: -Professional behavior, conduct timely and effective communications. -Personal safety and safety of others, including driving slowly, safely, and defensively. -Implementation of tactics that offer a high probability of success. -Manage fatigue by taking breaks and maintaining work rest cycles. <u>Management Objectives</u> -Fight fire aggressively while maintaining safe work practices to minimize threats to the public and emergency responders, all actions and efforts will focus on safeguarding the residents and resources of Los Angeles City and Los Angeles County. -Minimize damage to structures, private and public property, and other improvements in the fire area. -Ensure repopulation takes place in a quick, efficient, and effective manner. -Protect natural, cultural, and heritage resources. -Continue to foster and maintain positive relationships with all local cooperators and stakeholders. -Ensure coordinated, timely and accurate release of public information. -Ensure costs are aligned with mission priorities. <u>Control Objectives</u> Keep the fire North of the Pacific Ocean Keep the fire South of US 101 Keep the fire East of Malibu Canyon Keep the fire West of the Interstate 405

WEATHER DISCUSSION:

...RED FLAG WARNING UNITL 600 PM WEDNESDAY...

Through the operational period, critical fire weather conditions can be expected with gusty north to northeast winds and low relative humidity. The worst conditions are expected through this afternoon during the period of strongest winds and lowest humidity. However, elevated to critical fire weather conditions will continue tonight into Monday morning. **Therefore, a RED FLAG WARNING is in effect.**

From Monday afternoon through Wednesday, critical fire weather conditions are expected to continue as Santa Ana winds increase. The strongest winds are expected late Monday night and Tuesday with strong Santa Ana winds forecast. Relative humidity will remain low each day with little, if any, overnight recovery. This combination of strong winds, low relative humidity and dry fuels will bring an extended period of critical fire weather conditions and the **RED FLAG WARNING** will remain in effect until 600 PM Wednesday.

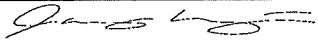

OUTLOOK FOR MONDAY:

Mostly clear skies are expected. Afternoon high temperatures will be in the mid 50s to mid 60s. Overnight lows will generally be in the upper 40s to mid 50s. Relative humidity will bottom out in the 15-25% range with poor overnight recovery. North to northeast winds will continue through the period, increasing in strength Monday evening and Monday night.

FIRE BEHAVIOR OUTPUTS

GENERAL: Critically dry fuels combined with the return of windy conditions will allow for dangerous to critical rates of spread and increased spotting distances. In areas where fuels are sheltered by the wind you can expect topographically driven runs. Be alert to fires that change aspects as slope reversals are possible.

SPECIFIC: BRANCH I: Fires in drainage bottoms sheltered from the wind can exhibit topographical runs. Pay attention for possible slope reversal situations.

BRANCH V: Fire weakened trees or infrastructure can pose a threat to crews engaged in mop up operations.

BRANCH VII: Watch for fires that establish themselves in drainages aligned with Monte Nido community.

BRANCH X: Greatest rates of spread and fire behavior in aligned drainages near Topanga Canyon.

STRUCTURE GROUP: Be alert as fuels adjacent to buildings remain receptive to ember cast.

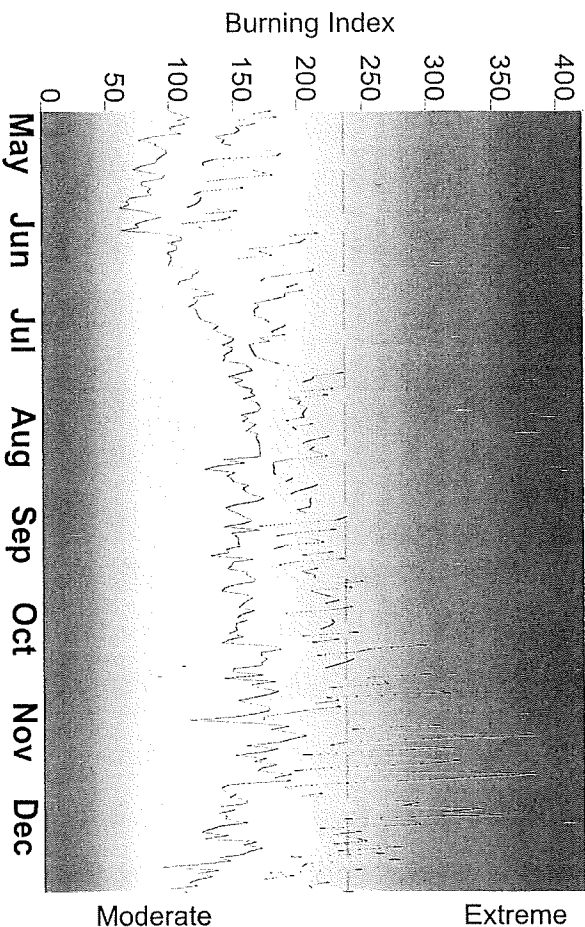

SAFETY

- ◆ Acquaint yourself with local thresholds that shout watchout. Learn from past experiences.
- ◆ Familiarize yourself with weather and local factors that influence fire behavior.
- ◆ Be alert for slope reversal as historical fires have caused serious injuries when changing fire direction occurs.

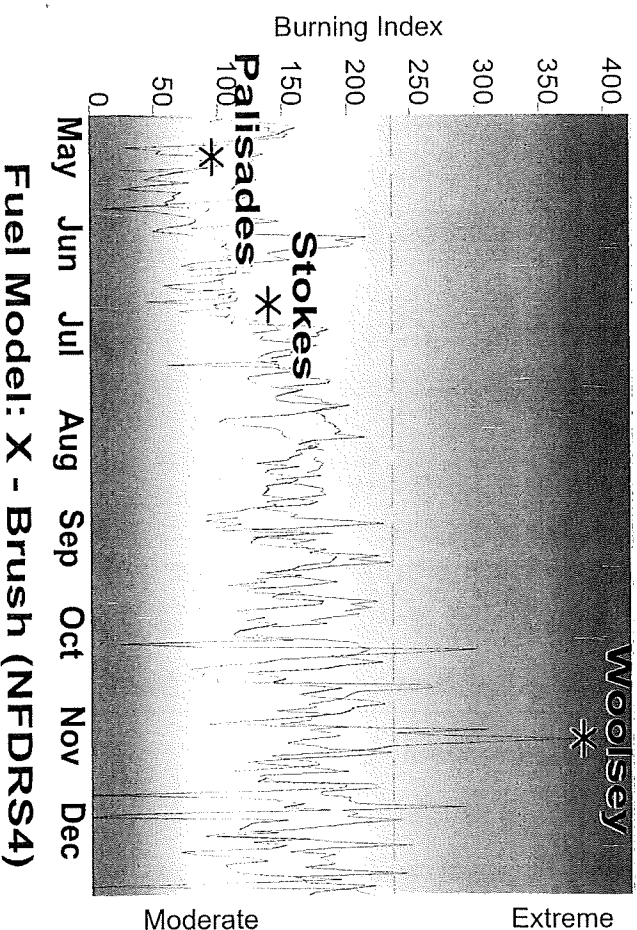

Local Thresholds - Watch out: Combinations of any of these factors can greatly increase fire behavior:
20' Wind Speed over 30 mph, RH less than 20%,
Temperature over 80, Burning Index over 0

Remember what Fire Danger tells you:

- ✓ Burning Index gives day-to-day fluctuations calculated from temperature, humidity, wind, daily temperature & rh ranges, and precip duration.
- ✓ Wind is part of BI calculation.
- ✓ Watch local conditions and variations across the landscape -- Fuel, Weather, Topography.
- ✓ Listen to weather forecasts -- especially WIND.

SAFETY MESSAGE

CRITICALLY DRY FUELS!!!

Lack of rain, Very low fuel moistures, Highly receptive to burning

- Check the communications plan for frequency assignments.
- Continue to drive slowly and cautiously; watch out for civilians and wildlife.
- When approaching Heavy Equipment, make eye contact with the operator.
- Multiple hazards in the WUI: Steep narrow roads, heavy fuel loading, wells, septic tanks, long escape routes, public presence, and power lines.
- Look Up, Down, and Around: overhead, surface, and underground hazards.
- Leaders attend operational briefing and brief every firefighter every shift.
- Chronic dehydration is real. Don't let it catch up with you! Drink water!
- Be aware of fire behavior, and plan for slope reversal and reburn potential.

Hazardous Structures

- Li-ion battery walls/EV Batteries
- Structure collapse potential
- Damaged utilities: gas/electrical
- Void spaces: septic/tanks/pools
- Scout areas prior to committing resources to work assignments

PALISADES INCIDENT RISK ANALYSIS (ICS 215-A)

LOC	HAZARDOUS ACTIONS/CONDITIONS	MITIGATIONS / WARNINGS / REMEDIES
ALL	CRITICALLY DRY FUELS	-Fuels are receptive and will carry fire at a dangerous rate of spread. -Know your LCES and maintain Situational Awareness. -Use experienced Lookouts. -Monitor weather for changes in the wind, temp, and RH throughout the shift. -Have a contingency plan with established decision points and safety zones.
ALL	FATIGUE, HEAT, & DEHYDRATION	-Don't underestimate your task. Adhere to work/rest cycles. -DRINK WATER before, during and after shifts, up to 1.5 gal. per shift. -Review heat-related emergencies (IRPG Pg.110). -Monitor for signs of stack-effect of fatigue, heat, and dehydration.
ALL	PERSONNEL SAFETY	-All personnel are responsible for their personal safety. -Be sure to wear all required PPE while on the fire line, especially eye protection. -Make sure everyone gets a briefing on the plan for the day. -Document your briefings and actions on your ICS-214.
ALL	AIRCRAFT OPERATIONS	-Monitor air-to-ground frequencies; they are your eyes in the sky. -Use air-to-ground frequency to communicate with aircraft. -Monitor air-to ground for possible starts in the operational area. -Prepare for nighttime operations with signal lighting for crews and supervisors.
ALL	LINE CONSTRUCTION & IMPROVEMENT	-Conduct thorough briefings for all personnel. -Ensure LCES is in place prior to engagement. -Use Downhill Fireline Construction Checklist for downhill line construction.
ALL	STEEP TERRAIN / ROLLING DEBRIS	-Watch your footing while hiking in steep terrain. -Be careful of loose rolling debris. -Maintain Situational Awareness. -Know Tree Hazards in the work area. -Dangerous Winding Roads = SLOW Defensive Driving.
ALL	GAS & ELECTRICAL	-Follow Power Line safety guidelines (IRPG pg.22) -Treat all downed power lines as energized! -There have been instances of electrical back feed in powerlines. -Be alert for gas leaks and fires. Shut off if valve intact. Do NOT extinguish burning gas.
ALL	DRIVING HAZARDS	-SLOW DOWN! -Conduct a 360* circle of safety prior to moving vehicles. -Drive with headlights and seat belts on; drive defensively. -Use chocks, spotters and backers. When in doubt, scout it out! -Dive carefully in camp. Do not ride on the exterior of moving vehicles.
ALL	HAZARDOUS STRUCTURES	-Follow WUI Structure Size Up (IRPG p.12). -Be aware of propane tank and natural gas hazards. -Scout areas prior to committing resources to work assignments. -Void spaces (pools) may be hidden by ash and debris. -Damaged or destroyed EV, residential, and commercial Lithium Ion battery packs.
Br V	HEAVY EQUIPMENT	-Make positive contact with operator before approaching. -Use hand signals if other communications are unavailable. -Maintain a 50'-100' exclusion area around equipment. -Close roads or trails if necessary for public safety. -Maintain safe working distance from equipment.

National Parks and California State Parks

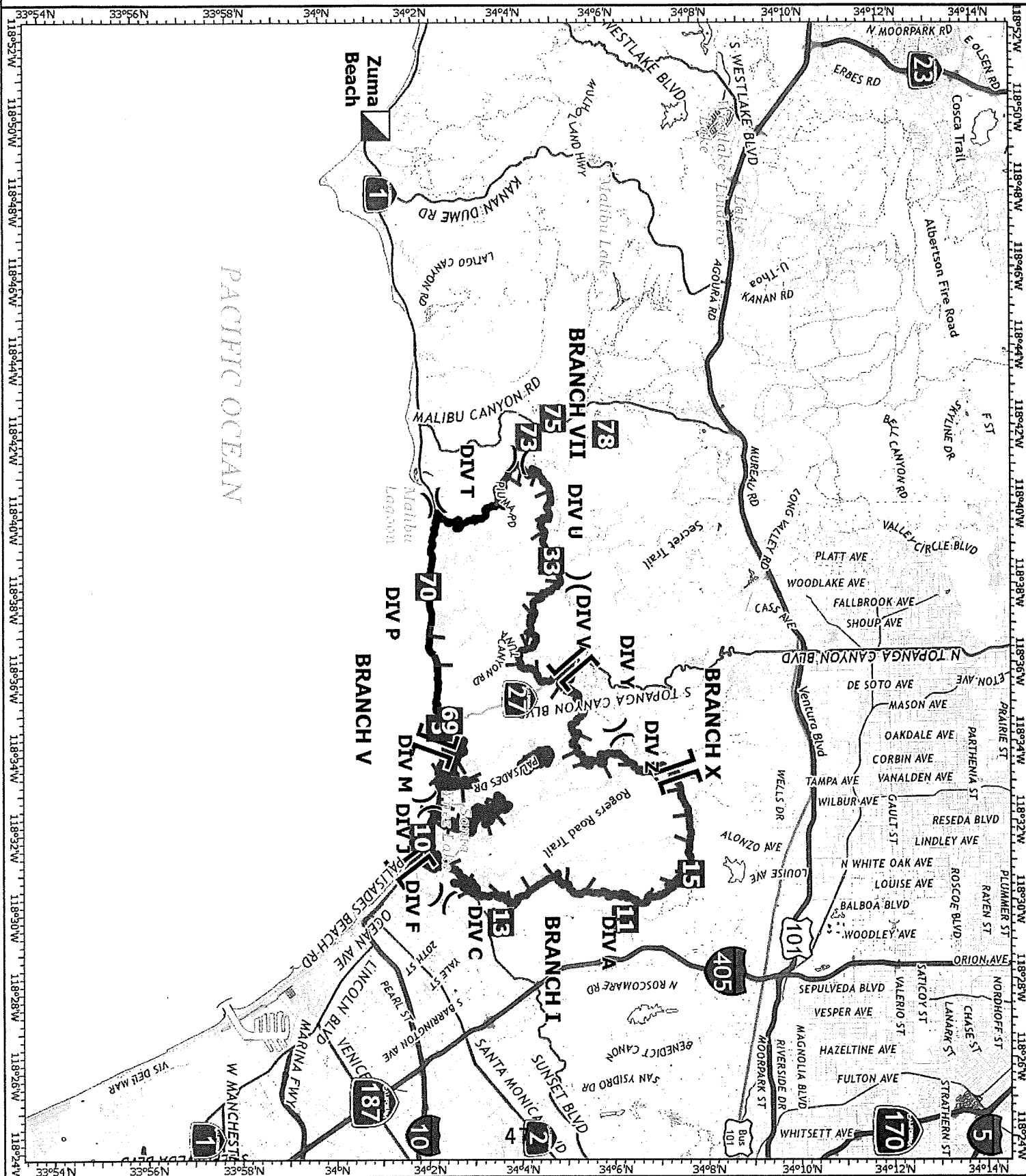
- If stream crossings are unavoidable, Heavy Equipment should cross with blades up
- Minimize soil disturbance, with preference to wet line and burn out methods.
- Minimize wetland disturbance. Sensitive resources can be easily impacted by changes to natural drainage and irrigation.
- Retain vegetation as much as possible in areas with high erosion potential.
- High-pressure wash vehicles and heavy equipment before and after suppression or suppression repair.
- Similarly, reduce spread of seed via cargo, netting, clothing, boots, line packs.
- Scrape around trees liable to ignite.
- No sport falling - only cut trees that are a threat to firefighter safety or containment. Do not buck.
- On CSP property, READs must approve felling operations.
- Return logs to a natural arrangement with minimal disturbance even during mop-up. Tool use which damages logs potentially introduces disease or fragments habitat.
- DIVS U is a hotspot for invasive shot hole borer – please do not remove any wood from DIVS U.
- Do not disturb caves, artifacts, built structures, or dark soils with high concentration of shell without oversight from CSP READs.
- Please clean up all crew trash from the fireline.

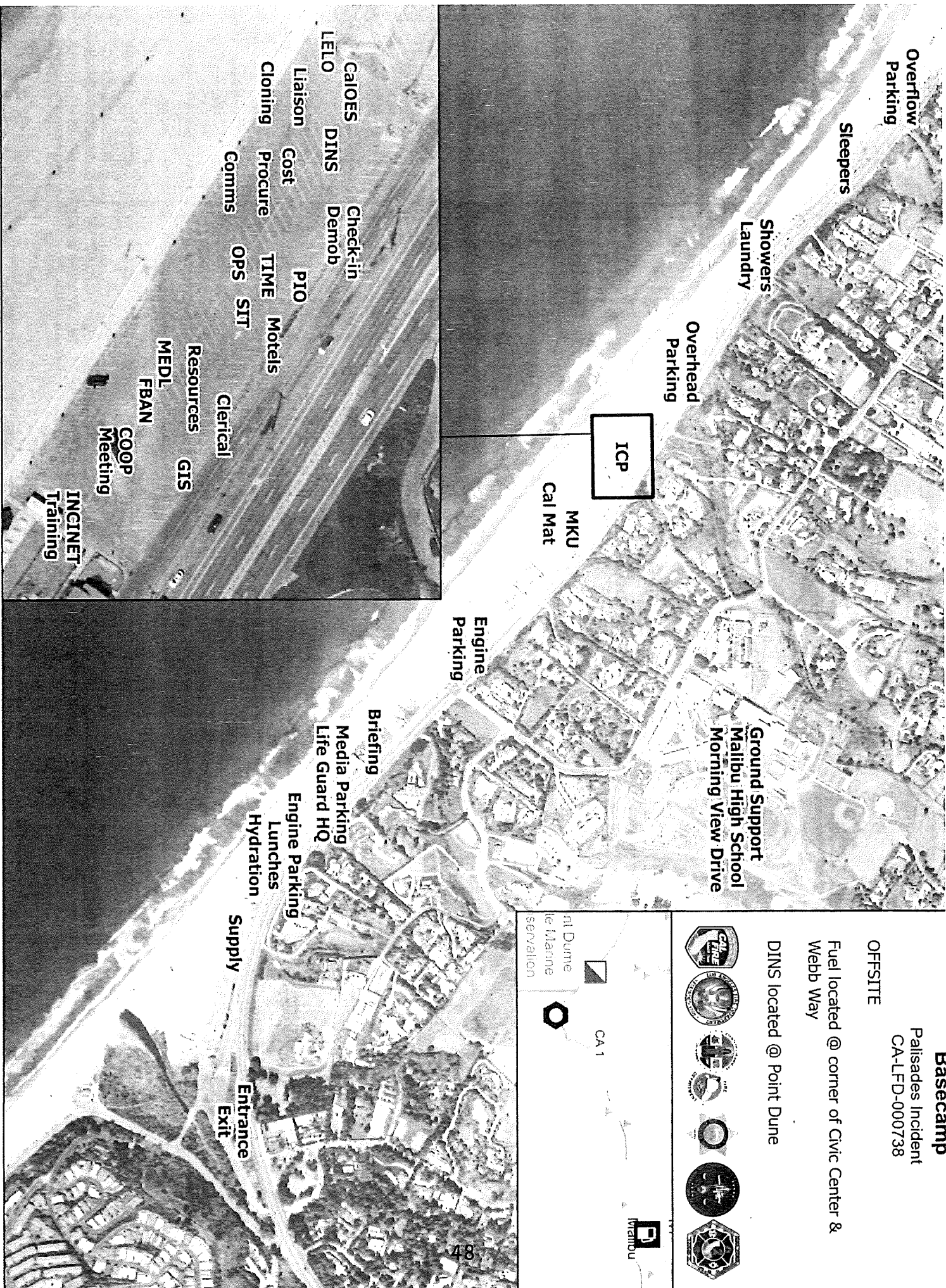
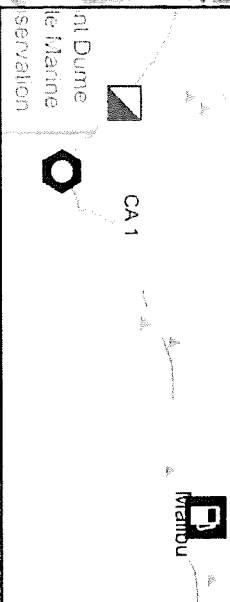
