WEATHER SUMMARY:

RED FLAG WARNING in effect through 8pm Sunday 12/9

Elevated Fire Weather conditions will continue through next week

Northeast winds 10-20 mph with gusts to 35mph will continue in the area. Erratic winds will be present along ridgetops and drainages. High temp 80, Low 45, Min RH 5-10%. Expect poor overnight humidity recovery

OUTPUTS

FIRE BEHAVIOR

GENERAL: All fuels in the area are extremely dry, due to the recent heat wave in November, and long periods of little to no precipitation.

Fuels will ignite easily, with rapid growth, and long range spotting during the entire shift. Live fuel moisture levels are just above the critical percentile, with some regional areas well below the critical mark.

ERC's have climbed to historic levels since the fire began, and are currently well above the 97th percentile

The increase in ERC levels will greatly hamper control efforts for any new ignitions.

SPECIFIC: The fire behavior below outlines what can be expected from any spot fires and new starts in the local fire area.

GRASS: Rate of Spread....180 ft/min Flame Length....10 ft Spotting....1/2 mi Probability of Ignition 75%

GRASS SHRUB: Rate of Spread....130 ft/min Flame Length....10 ft Spotting....3/4 mi Probability of Ignition 75%

BRUSH: Rate of Spread....300 ft/min Flame Length....30 ft Spotting....1.5 mi Probability of Ignition 75%

Fuels are very receptive to ignition. Be cautious of work being done by heavy equipment, and parking locations.

Smoldering trees, and branches have the ability produce ember-cast and create a prime source of ignition throughout the shift. Trees and branches will release easily in windy conditions.

Sunset 12/9...16:49 Sunrise 12/10...06:49

AIR OPERATIONS: Transport winds will be Northeast 15mph with a mixing height of 1600' AGL. High winds will be present throughout the area hampering the effectiveness of aircraft. Erratic winds will be present over ridgetops.

Expect clear air over the area, unless a new fire develops to the East of the incident.

SAFETY

Fire weakened trees will begin to come down. Look up...and live. On relatively small fires or deceptively quiet areas of large fires. Stump holes will hold deep-seated heat for extended periods of time.

BRIEF ALL YOUR PERSONNEL ON THE CURRENT DAYS IAP BEFORE ENGAGING IN YOUR DIVISIONAL ASSIGNMENT.

- Use caution while working in the Riparian areas. Multiple hot ash-pits have been observed in these areas. Sound the ground you plan to walk on.
- > Stay aware of what is happening around you and adapt your exit strategy accordingly.
- Strong & erratic winds are predicted throughout the operational period. Any new ignition will grow rapidly will be difficult to control.
- > Establish: LOOKOUTS, COMMUNICATIONS, ESCAPE ROUTES & SAFETY ZONES.
- > Be aware of complacency. Many of us have been on multiple fire assignments this year, starting as early as March. Continue to be aggressive, but look out for each other.
- No PPE allowed in the eating areas. Wash hands regularly and always before entering the eating areas.
- If personnel get fatigued, (but it's not a medical emergency), use Fireline Paramedics for evaluation and rehab in a shaded area on the fire line.
- Drive with headlights on and Slow Down.
- > Use appropriate lifting techniques while lifting during backhaul of hose, trash, etc.

DEMOBILIZATION PLAN - SUMMARY

RYE Incident CA-LAC-362441 GENERAL INFORMATION

The Demobilization Plan is developed to facilitate the orderly removal and checkout of resources on the incident. By definition, surplus personnel are available for release if they have rested for a minimum of 8 hours, are cleaned up, outfitted and have a vehicle ready to depart to their next destination.

GENERAL GUIDELINES

- NO RESOURCES WILL LEAVE THE INCIDENT UNTIL AUTHORIZED TO DO SO BY THE DEMOB UNIT.
- o Efforts will be made to ensure that all released personnel arrive at their destination prior to 2200 hours.
- All Resources will arrive at the Demobilizations Unit at their scheduled time Only.
- All government and hired vehicles leaving the incident will have a safety inspection. If a vehicle is within 1,000
 miles of a "B" service, it is the responsibility of the resource to contact Ground Support and have an oil change prior
 to their scheduled demobilization time.
- o All Rental Vehicles will receive a safety inspection prior to leaving the incident.
- All trainees are to keep their time up to date and report to the Training Specialist with their task books and evaluations prior to completion of the demobilization process.
- All strike team leaders are responsible to call South Ops at 1-800-237-3703 immediately upon being released from the incident

RESPONSIBILITIES

Unit Leaders will declare resources excess to their Section Chief. Section Chiefs will declare excess resources to the Planning Section Chief through the Resource Unit Leader. This should be done 36 hours in advance of anticipated release. Use the Declaration of Excess Resources sheet or General Message Form (ICS-213) to list all excess resources. Include the resource name, request number, name of person, date and time of declared excess, and time in which the resource will be eligible to leave. Send to the RESOURCE UNIT where the resource will be determined to be surplus to the incident. Surplus resources will then be able to report to the DEMOB UNIT, receive a Demobilization Checkout Form (ICS 221), get the appropriate ICS 221 signatures, and then return the completed ICS 221 to the DEMOB UNIT prior to final release or reassignment. Resources are not to contact South Ops or the expanded dispatch center unless instructed to do so by the Demobilization Unit.

RELEASE PRIORITIES

- 1. Organized fire departments
- 2. OES engines
- 3. Hired personnel and equipment
- 4. Other agencies (USFS, BLM, etc.)
- 5. Out of region CAL FIRE forces
- 6. Within Region CAL FIRE Forces
- 7. Unit CAL FIRE Forces

TRAVEL INFORMATION

All resources will meet agency specific requirements on hours of travel per day. For CAL FIRE hand crews, a full 24 hour reset period shall be adhered to before departing from the incident. After a crew's last operational period they shall begin the demobilization release procedure during their 24 hour off shift. In addition, they must use the following complete 24 hour period as reset time before they depart from the incident.


