

GENERAL CONTROL OBJECTIVES Management Objectives -Provide for and maintain public and first responder safety by utilizing the incident safety analysis process. -Protect critical assets at risk to include the agricultural industry, historical assets within the affected area, infrastructure and improvements, watersheds, and transmission lines. -Utilize tactics that consider protection of sensitive natural and cultural resources in the affected wilderness areas, the Sespe Wild and Scenic River, and the Sespe Condor Sanctuary. - Ensure transparent, timely, and accurate communication at all levels of the incident. -Be financially responsible for all assigned management and fire suppression tactics. - Foster and enhance community and political relationships. -All management actions and efforts will be focused on serving, safeguarding, and protecting the citizens and natural resources within Ventura County, Santa Barbara County, and Los Padres National Forest. Control Objectives -Hold fire within the current southern perimeter to protect life and property values in the wildland-urban interface. -Keep the fire south of the Mount Pinos Ranger District boundary to minimize impacts to the Sespe watershed, Sespe Wild and Scenic River, and the Sespe Wilderness. -Keep the fire east of Gibraltar Road and north and east of 5N16 Road to minimize exposure and duration of incident. -Hold fire within the current eastern perimeter to minimize impact to the condor sanctuary, oil fields, and wilderness.

Incident Meteorologists

Weather conditions across the Thomas Fire area today will be warmer and drier as high pressure remains positioned across Southern California. Weak surface pressure gradients will translate into light east northeast winds along the ridges and upper slopes. Light onshore winds are expected along the coast and lower elevations.

A gradual warming trend has begun with temperatures increasing 5 – 7 degrees each day until Sunday. Minimum relative humidity values are expected to range between 5-12% (ridges/upper slopes) 10-15% (along coasts/lower elevations) Saturday afternoon. Overnight relative humidity recoveries are expected to be poor only reaching 20-25% during the overnight hours. No rainfall is expected through the end of the year.



FIRE BEHAVIOR

GENERAL:

Fuels in the fire area remain critically dry. With the short days and lack of significant winds no forward fire progression is expected. With two days of poor RH recovery, expect to see more visible smoke in the fire perimeter.

Areas with the most potential for fire spread are those areas with continuous one hour (grass/needle cast) fuels. Identify these areas in your assigned work location.

Spotting is not expected but check areas where rollout could challenge containment. Pig 70%

SPECIFIC:

Ventura Zone/Branch II

No forward fire spread is expected. Heat remains in Bear Haven and expect to see some smoke in this area. Heat also remains in the Cherry Creek drainage. With the incomplete consumption of fuels from the previous burning there is a potential for reburn but it is low. Pockets of timber will continue to hold fire and some torching should be expected.

Santa Barbara Zone/Branch X

No forward fire progression is expected in the Santa Barbara Zone. Expect to see some interior pockets of smoke but no fire will challenge containment.

No significant fire activity expected tonight in the absence of wind.

AIR OPERATIONS: Clear Skies and minimal winds, VFR conditions

- Every shift can be dynamic, be prepared for changes, what you planned may not work, have "plan B" thought out and be pro-active.
- Are you prepared for a Medical Emergency? Review your 9-line



- Give your unit name and advise what EMTs are on scene/needed
- Give your location and if possible Lat/ Log

INCIDENT STATUS - Give the nature of the medical problem
SEVERITY OF EMERGENCY - Give Number of Injured and Severity (RED/YELLOW/GREEN)
Request type of evacuation resources needed:
Air/Ground Support/ Ambulance /REM/Specialized
ADDITIONAL RESOURCES - Request Line Medic/REM Response/Specialized
For Air Evacuations:

The following additional information will be needed:
