Incident: Debris/Flood Response | Date: January 10 | Shift: 0700-0700

### Hazards and Risks:

- Electrical / Gas Hazards: Identify and notify all personnel of electrical and Gas hazards in flood area. Work with reps from each agency to mitigate.
- **Driving:** Scout wet/ muddy areas before driving through. Reduce speeds during heavy rains. Park on stable surfaces.
- Heavy Equipment Operations: Ensure communications are established with operators. Give proper spacing while working near equipment.

## SPECIAL HEALTH HAZARD

### Caution working in and around water and mud

- Recognize exposures to potential hazardous substances
  - Household wastes, Bacteria from human and animal remains
- Protect yourself
  - Gloves, masks, consider gross decontamination
- Recognize signs and symptoms
  - Abdominal pain, rash, fever, vomiting, diarrhea
