

... WIND ADVISORY IN EFFECT UNTIL 3 AM PST THURSDAY...

.DISCUSSION...An upper level ridge is building over the region as the exiting storm system moves east of the area. In the wake of this storm, northerly winds will increase over southern Santa Barbara County, including the Santa Ynez Range. Gusts up to 35 mph are expected around the spot location, with gusts 40 to 45 mph over the foothills and ridges above Montecito. The winds will shift to the northeast and begin to subside after midnight. By Thursday, the winds will be much weaker and easterly, then shifting to the southwest by Thursday afternoon. Northeast winds will remain weak to locally moderate Thursday night into Friday, and are then likely to increase again somewhat Friday night...but with gusts up to around 25 mph. Dry conditions are expected through Friday, with clear skies and warming temperatures.

ALL	ALL DRIVING HAZARDS Be alert for potential muddy and slick road surfaces. Evaluate bridges for structural compromises. Maintain appropriate speed for the current road conditions.						
ALL	HAZARDOUS STRUCTURE	 Follow Structure Size Up (IRPG p.13). Be aware of propane tank and natural gas hazards. Scout areas prior to committing resources to work assignments. Void spaces (pools and wells) may be hidden by mud and debris.

Bring your video and pictures to the Public Information trailer; they will be reviewed and possibly uploaded to our many CAL FIRE social media sites. Remember, we don't want photographs or videos that depict unsafe, unprofessional or embarrassing circumstances, which are a serious breach of ethics.

If you have lost an item please leave your contact information and what you have lost at the Information Section. If you have found an item on the incident, bring the item to the Information Section with your contact information as well.




