

Spot Forecast for XSB January Storms...CAL FIRE

National Weather Service Los Angeles/Oxnard CA

DISCUSSION...Dry weather is expected to persist over the region through Tuesday, aside from a slight chance of light rain north of Point Conception Tuesday morning. Weak offshore flow tonight into Monday morning will turn onshore Monday afternoon through Tuesday but will remain weak.

Warm and dry weather will continue Wednesday and Thursday, with rain potentially affecting the incident area starting Thursday evening as a Pacific storm system crosses the region. Rain chances will continue through Friday afternoon, with possible showers lingering Friday night. Estimated rainfall totals at this time are 0.10 to 0.20 inches across the incident area. Friday night temperatures will be chilly as the cold front passes, with lows potentially in the upper 30s to lower 40s.

Sky/weather......Mostly sunny.

Max temperature.....68-71.

Min humidity.......25-30 percent.

Surface winds.......East winds 3 to 6 mph becoming southwest to west 6 to 12 mph in the afternoon.



BRANCH	HAZARDOUS ACTIONS/ CONDITIONS	MITIGATIONS/WARNINGS/REMEDIES
ALL	DRIVING HAZARDS	 Be alert for potential muddy and slick road surfaces. Evaluate bridges for structural compromises. Slow down to reduce dust production.
ALL	HAZARDOUS STRUCTURE	 Follow Structure Size Up (IRPG p.13). Be aware of propane tank and natural gas hazards. Scout areas prior to committing resources to work assignments. Void spaces (pools and wells) may be hidden by mud and debris.
ALL	HAZARDOUS TREES	 Follow Hazard Tree Safety Guidelines (IRPG p. 22). Many of the trees within the inundation zone and along roadway may be compromised.
ALL	FATIGUE	 Monitor incoming and outgoing resources for level of fatigue. Provide sufficient rest during the work cycle.
ALL	HEAVY EQUIPMENT	 Review Working with Heavy Equipment (IRPG p.80) Stay at least 100 feet in front and 50 feet behind the equipment.
ALL	TRAFFIC HAZARDS	 Watch for utility vehicles in your areas. Keep apprised of road closures in the area.
ALL	PERSONNEL SAFETY/HYGIENE	 All personnel are responsible for their personal safety. Be sure to wear all required PPE while on assignment. Wash hand prior to eating and after using the facilities. Decontaminate personnel protective equipment after your shift.
ALL	POWER LINES/UTILITIES	 Follow Power Line safety guidelines (IRPG pg.24) Treat all downed power lines as energized. Identify and avoid natural gas lines. Be aware of damaged gas services near structures.
ALL	HYDRATION	 Drink water before, during and after each shift. Be alert for signs of heat stress in yourself and others.
ALL	COMMUNICATIONS	Check the communication plan for frequency assignments.
ALL	BRIEFINGS	 Make sure everyone gets a briefing on the plan for the day. Document this on your ICS 214.
ALL	LCES	Ensure that LCES is being utilized.
ALL	AIRCRAFT AWARENESS	 Be aware of rotor wash when working near helicopters. Understand that hazard trees may react to helicopters overhead. Monitor assigned aircraft frequencies.
ALL	DEBRIS FLOWS	 Work within your current training and qualifications. Watch for shifting material.
ALL	SEARCH and RECOVERY OPERATIONS	 Do not get complacent. Pace yourself and your crew for the work assignment. Watch your footing, be cautious of slips, trips and falls.

We are all experiencing a devastating crisis.

We are many agencies: Law Enforcement, Fire, EMS, Private Contractors, and Military.

There are many kinds of trauma, grief and losses present. We are all human and these things can have impact on all of us, no matter who you are or what your background. These include:

- · Some of us live here, and may know somebody that has suffered a lost.
- The effects from this current incident as well as recent incidents.
- Dealing with multiple evacuations and rescues in high intensity environments.
- The large magnitude and destruction of residences, commercial buildings, critical infrastructure and community landmarks.
- · Extensive media presence.
- Dealing with fatalities and ongoing search for missing persons.
- Repopulation and the anguish we witness from the community.
- Providing emotional support for the community and each other.
- The time spent away from our families.

All of these stressors and more can pile up. The cumulative effect of these stressors, along with the stresses of normal daily life can feel overwhelming.

We all need to stick together, take care of ourselves and each other. Talking about your experiences with a Peer is a great way to lessen the impact.

We know how to watch out for each other on the fire line for our physical safety. The same is necessary for our emotional and psychological safety.

Come by the Peer Support Tent, we are on the grass adjacent to the briefing area.

# Critical Incident Stress Management (CISM) Information Sheet


Stress is a normal part of every significant job. At different times during your career with the Department, your level of stress may reach a significant or critical point. An acute stress reaction is frequently related to a specific unusual event (death of a co-worker, multi-casualty incident, severe dismemberment or disfigurement of a victim, death of a child, personally knowing or relating to the victim, etc.) A delayed reaction may happen days, weeks, and/or years after an event. This typically occurs after you are re-exposed or "triggered" by a similar sight, sound, smell, taste, touch, or situation. Cumulative stress is the buildup of stress over time and/or when you are experiencing significant amounts of stress simultaneously in your life. This buildup may eventually reach a critical mass resulting in a stress reaction.


A stress reaction is an important signal - it is your body's way of coping with the temporary state of being overwhelmed by a situation. The duration of symptoms (hours, days, weeks or months) depends on your personal circumstance. However, once properly addressed, most acute stress reaction will significantly lessen within 24-72 hours and a thoughtful combination of stress management strategies will lessen the impact of most situations.


