DISCUSSION...A weak storm system will continue to move across the area through Saturday morning. There is a very low chance of rain for the incident area through early Saturday, but any rainfall if it occurs will be very light. Gusty north winds are expected through late Saturday morning, with gusts up to 35 mph near the incident location, with stronger gusts likely in the higher terrain above Montecito. The winds will begin to subside Saturday afternoon, and will shift to the northeast late Saturday night. Weak onshore winds are expected Sunday afternoon as another weak storm system approaches the area. Colder temperatures will move into the area tonight, and will linger through the weekend. Overnight lows are expected to drop into the lower 40's, with daytime highs in the low 60's.

The next storm system will brush the Central Coast late Sunday night through Monday, with a 10 percent chance of rain for the incident location Monday daytime. Another weak storm system will cross the area midweek, with rain chances for southern Santa Barbara County Wednesday night through Thursday afternoon.

Sky/weather.....Mostly sunny.

Chance of pcpn.....5 percent.

Max temperature.....61-63.

Min humidity......38-43 percent.

Surface winds......North winds 12 to 20 mph with gusts to 30 mph, becoming 8 to 15 mph with gusts to 25 mph in the afternoon. North winds gusting to 40 mph in the hills in the morning.

SATURDAY NIGHT...

Sky/weather.....Mostly clear becoming partly cloudy.

Chance of pcpn.....0 percent.

Min temperature.....40-45.

Max humidity......75-80 percent.

Surface winds......North winds 10 to 15 mph with gusts up to 23 mph in the evening. becoming northeast 8 to 15 mph after midnight.

BRANCH	HAZARDOUS ACTIONS/ CONDITIONS	MITIGATIONS/WARNINGS/REMEDIES
ALL	PERSONNEL SAFETY/HYGIENE	 All personnel are responsible for their personal safety. Be sure to wear all required PPE while on assignment. Wash hands prior to eating and after using the facilities. Decontaminate personnel protective equipment after your shift.
ALL	SEARCH and RECOVERY OPERATIONS	 Do not get complacent. Pace yourself and your crew for the work assignment. Watch your footing, be cautious of slips, trips and falls.
ALL	HAZARDOUS TREES	 Follow Hazard Tree Safety Guidelines (IRPG p. 22). Many of the trees within the inundation zone and along roadway may be compromised.
ALL	DRIVING HAZARDS	 Be alert for potential muddy and slick road surfaces. Evaluate bridges for structural compromises. Slow down to reduce dust production.
ALL	AIRCRAFT AWARENESS	 Be aware of unmanned aircraft (Drones) flying within your division. Communicate with operators as necessary Monitor assigned aircraft frequencies.
ALL	HEAVY EQUIPMENT	 Review Working with Heavy Equipment (IRPG p.80) Stay at least 100 feet in front and 50 feet behind the equipment.
ALL	POWER LINES/UTILITIES	 Follow Power Line safety guidelines (IRPG pg.24) Treat all downed power lines as energized. Identify and avoid natural gas lines.
ALL	HAZARDOUS STRUCTURE	 Follow Structure Size Up (IRPG p.13). Be aware of propane tank and natural gas hazards. Scout areas prior to committing resources to work assignments. Void spaces (pools and wells) may be hidden by mud and debris.
ALL	FATIGUE	 Monitor incoming and outgoing resources for level of fatigue. Provide sufficient rest during the work cycle.
ALL	TRAFFIC HAZARDS	 Watch for utility vehicles in your areas. Keep apprised of road closures in the area. Be aware of missing street signs
ALL	HYDRATION	 Drink water before, during and after each shift. Be alert for signs of heat stress in yourself and others.
ALL	COMMUNICATIONS	Check the communication plan for frequency assignments.
ALL	BRIEFINGS	 Make sure everyone gets a briefing on the plan for the day. Document this on your ICS 214.
ALL	LCES	Ensure that LCES is being utilized.
ALL	DEBRIS FLOWS	 Work within your current training and qualifications. Watch for shifting material.



Critical Incident Stress Management (CISM)

Information Sheet


Stress is a normal part of every significant job. At different times during your career with the Department, your level of stress may reach a significant or critical point. An acute stress reaction is frequently related to a specific unusual event (death of a co-worker, multi-casualty incident, severe dismemberment or disfigurement of a victim, death of a child, personally knowing or relating to the victim, etc.) A delayed reaction may happen days, weeks, and/or years after an event. This typically occurs after you are re-exposed or "triggered" by a similar sight, sound, smell, taste, touch, or situation. Cumulative stress is the buildup of stress over time and/or when you are experiencing significant amounts of stress simultaneously in your life. This buildup may eventually reach a critical mass resulting in a stress reaction.


A stress reaction is an important signal - it is your body's way of coping with the temporary state of being overwhelmed by a situation. The duration of symptoms (hours, days, weeks or months) depends on your personal circumstance. However, once properly addressed, most acute stress reaction will significantly lessen within 24-72 hours and a thoughtful combination of stress management strategies will lessen the impact of most situations.


