<u>WEATHER DISCUSSION:</u> Hot weather will continue through Tuesday as high pressure continues over the area. Temperatures will be a few degrees cooler on Wednesday followed by more cooling on Thursday as high pressure weakens. Marine layer will remain very shallow through Tuesday night resulting in poor overnight RH recoveries. Seabreeze winds are expected to remain light through Tuesday night. By Wednesday the marine layer may deepen enough to allow gusty seabreeze winds to make it to the burn area Wednesday afternoon.

#### **WEATHER SUMMARY:**

The high temperatures will be in the mid to high 80s and minimum relative humidity 20 to 25 percent. Winds are described in detail in the weather forecast, the key point will be they will be stronger than the past several days at 9-12 mph with gust to 17 mph in the Carmel Zone and gust to 22 mph in the River Zone. The mixing height should lift slight higher than in previous days to 2100 feet.

#### **OUTPUTS**

#### **FIRE BEHAVIOR**

#### **GENERAL:**

There will be a slight change in the weather today in the area. Temperatures will be slightly cooler and the marine layer may move into the lower elevations. Fire activity in the afternoons have been increasing compared to the past several days as the moisture from previous weather systems has died out. This will contribute to increased intensity and rate of spread on the fires and any new spots or starts in the area. The fuels in the area are reaching critical level, the brush is capable of producing 20 foot or greater flame lengths. Watch for the transitions between fuel types, as it reaches light fuels it will increase the rate of spread, the brush will spread with the wind with high intensity.

#### SPECIFIC:

The River Fire progressed to the southeast yesterday towards Limekiln Road with a northwest wind. The wind today will vary slightly throughout the day but in general will be from the west to northwest. The effect of this wind will be felt mostly on the ridgetops but ay surface farther down the slope. Continue to monitor the weather throughout the day as the wind will be changing throughout the day depending where you are on the slope. Be aware of the west wind if it surfaces on the lower slope, the fire can make downhill runs. Watch for short range, less than 1/3 of a mile, spotting and rolling material starting fires below you. The marine layer may be present in the early evening but will only affect the very lower portions of the fire, the upper elevations will remain dry.

The Carmel Fire started yesterday and grew rapidly to the southeast. The wind will continue to drive the fire the same direction, with some variations as the marine layer moves on shore. The marine layer should have little to no effect on the fire except for the wind. There are several fuel breaks in the area, and a fire from previous years to the south. The south facing slopes are mostly grass and brush, with the north slopes containing an oak overstory.

#### AIR OPERATIONS

The mixing height above the fire is low which may limit aircraft use over portions of the fire.

#### SAFETY

The environment is dryer than in the past days increasing the potential for spots and increased fire behavior. Watch for wind and slope alignment as the wind shifts throughout the day.

COVID-19: Wear facial masks in accordance with CAL FIRE directive & Monterrey County Health Officer orders. Always practice social distancing.

**Hygiene:** Wash hands often with warm soap and water for a minimum of twenty seconds. Keep hand sanitizer nearby. Disinfect vehicle and any PPE used appropriately. Minimize hand to face exposure. Wash your hands before eating.

**Driving:** Limit speed inside of Toro Park ICP to 5MPH. Assume that there is an object (vehicle, tree, animal) lurking on every corner you can't see around, so be prepared to make room and/or stop.

Extreme Fire Behavior: Fuels are drought stricken and are receptive to fire spread. A small amount of wind on this dry fuel changes the game dramatically!! Be alert to changes in wind direction and expect changes in fire behavior. Flare-ups generally occur in deceptively light fuels, such as grass and light brush or islands within fire perimeters of unburned or partially burned fuels.

**Personnel:** Manage yourself and those around you for fatigue; many have driven long distances or been deployed for extended periods. As fatigue increases, injuries tend to increase also. Keep an eye on your crew and partner.

**Limited Resources:** With resource needs at a premium, tactics may be adjusted, however, SAFETY must never be compromised.

**Hydration:** By the time your body tells you it's time to drink – you are already DEHYRATED!!! On a regular basis drink fluids to maintain an appropriate energy level for any expected work

#### **Heat Illness Prevention:**

- Drink plenty of fluids:
  - Water and Gatorade
- · Avoid drinking energy drinks
- Rest when you can
- Find shade when you can
- Eat nutritious food regularly

#### **Management Objectives:**

Should be based on measurable factors:

- RH, Winds, and Fire Behavior
- Topographical boundaries
- Time constraints/Time of day
- Time /distance to safety zones
- Loss of suppression resources
- Fatigue, loss of Lookouts, or Communications.



# **CAL FIRE IMT COVID-19 ACTIONS**

#### PERSONNEL WITH COVID-19 SYMPTOMS

- Symptoms per the CDC's current guidelines include the following:
  - o Cough, fever(100.4), chills, muscle pain, shortness of breath, sore throat, new loss of taste or smell
- Incident Base or Fire Line
  - o Maintain appropriate face covering
  - o Notify supervisor and proceed to CALMAT
  - o Isolate and assess patient
  - o Medical direction to test, return patient to home unit/agency for testing

#### CONTACTED OR EXPOSED PERSONNEL AND ASYMPTOMATIC

- Notify supervisor
- Maintain appropriate face covering
- Self-monitor for symptoms
- Employee will continue assignment with preventative measures

#### PREVENTATIVE MEASURES TO SLOW THE TRANSMISSION COVID-19:

- Wash your hands regularly with soap and water, or clean them with alcohol-based hand rub.
- Maintain at least six feet distance between you and people coughing or sneezing.
- · Avoid touching your face.
- Cover your mouth and nose when coughing or sneezing.
- Stay home if you feel unwell.
- Refrain from smoking and other activities that weaken the lungs.
- Practice physical distancing by avoiding unnecessary travel and staying away from large groups of people.
- Maintain proper personal care (healthy diet and rest)

# Fire and COVID-19 Briefing Checklist

## Self-Awareness / Screening

- Immediately separate yourself from others.
- "Notify supervisor if you or others experience:
  - Cough, more than expected
  - Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing

- Review and follow crew and division plans to isolate, triage, and transport symptomatic personnel.

## Hygiene on the Fireline

- Properly wash or sanitize your hands often, especially before and after eating or entering a public place, and after coughing or sneezing.
- Avoid handshakes and communal use items.
- Maintain a supply of hand sanitizer and hand wipes. Inform supervisor of needed resupply.
- Disinfect high touch surfaces often:
  - Radios, phones, doors, pumps, fuel cans, etc.

## Social Distancing and Protective Equipment

- Initiate, practice, and remind others of social distancing.
- Conduct briefings and conversations outdoors and at least 6 feet apart.
- Utilize face coverings as a tool when practical.
- Clean or replace dirty face coverings, equipment, and PPE.

#### Communications

Face coverings and social distancing complicate communications.
 Ensure effective sender/receiver messaging.

#### Archaeological and Historical Sites Fireline Guidance for the River Incident

Do not compromise safety for the protection and preservation of archaeological and historical sites. When feasible and prudent:

- 1. Be on the lookout for prehistoric and historic sites. Prehistoric archaeological sites include temporary camps containing scatters of obsidian and/or chert flakes that often look like broken glass. More permanent village sites containing circular depressions (house pits), artifact scatters, and dark brownblack soils (midden). These typically occur on flats near sources of water, along ridgetops and saddles, and other such places suitable for camping. Historic sites include old wooden buildings, structures and corrals, rock foundations, wells, and debris scatters. These kinds of resources can be found in the same kinds of environmental settings as prehistoric camp sites.
- 2. No archaeological or historical sites have yet been flagged. If you observe artifacts, features, or sites, attempt to avoid dozing or driving through and/or parking on these sites, if feasible, especially with heavy equipment.
- 3. If you can't avoid sites, minimize disturbance as much as feasible, only clearing the surface to as minimal a depth and width as necessary.
- 4. Leave all artifacts in place. Some artifacts may have been intentionally placed for religious or ceremonial reasons.
- 5. When a site is discovered, flag it for visibility and report its location to the Division Supervisor. If feasible, note locations of discovered resources on a map. Better yet, take a GPS reading. Leave information with the Plans Section so that the sites can be relocated and protected during both the suppression and fire suppression repair phases of the Incident.
- 6. If you encounter a burial or other human remains, cease work in that area immediately and contact the CAL FIRE Archaeologist. State law requires that CAL FIRE then contact the County Coroner, who will then determine if the remains are part of a crime scene. If the Coroner determines that the remains are Native American, State law requires the Coroner to contact the Native American Heritage Commission in Sacramento.

#### Narrative

Suppression Repair is conducted under the authority of sections 4675 and 4676 of the Public Resources Code. Suppression Rehabilitation is the necessary and reasonable repairs made and actions taken to minimize the effects of fire suppression activities on state and private property, soil, watercourses, cultural resources, wildlife and fish habitat. The following specifications shall be used in the repair of suppression activity associated with the River Incident:

#### **Control Lines:**

- 1. Where excessive berms were formed, back blade or pull berms onto control line surface.
- 2. Back blade or pull organic debris onto and scatter evenly over control line surface at designated sensitive areas.
- 3. Construct waterbars on slopes greater than 20% slope.
  - a. Waterbars shall be constructed at 35°-45° angle to the control line.
  - b. Waterbars shall be constructed to a depth of 6 inches below grade and 6 inches above grade.
  - c. Discharge shall be free of obstruction and where possible, shall discharge into rock, vegetation or other material that will disperse the water and reduce its energy.
  - d. Space waterbars every 75-100 feet on slopes 25 percent or less, 50 feet on slopes 26-50 percent and 30 feet on slopes greater than 50 percent.
- 4. On out sloped roads, remove lower berm, formed during suppression activity, to allow water to flow off the surface evenly.
- 5. At access points to dozer lines, scatter brush and other organic material available from suppression activity to hide the entrance and discourage use of the line.

#### Watercourse Crossings and Waterways:

- 1. Remove dirt and other debris deposited in the watercourse to allow free flow of water and reduce the movement of material downstream.
- 2. Re-slope watercourse to original channel shape and location.
- 3. Notify fire suppression repair specialist of any damage to water diversion devices, such as culverts.

#### Access Roads:

- 1. Re-slope all constructed access roads to as natural as shape as existed before their use on the incident.
- 2. Breach berms according to the spacing standards for waterbars on dozer line.

#### Areas of Special Concern:

- 1. Archaeological Site:
  - a. Archaeological sites shall be evaluated for impact and need for State Archaeologist involvement. Sites shall be treated per Archaeological Certified staff or State Archaeologist.




