<u>WEATHER DISCUSSION:</u> High pressure will finally weaken and move to the east as a weak trough of low pressure moves across the fire area on Thursday and Friday. Gusty afternoon winds will affect the fire on Thursday afternoon as cooler, marine air infiltrates the area. Temperatures will be moderately cooler on Friday with relative humidity trending upward. Winds on Friday will be mainly terrain driven with afternoon sea breezes.

#### **INPUTS**

#### **WEATHER SUMMARY:**

The weather will remain warm and dry today with temperatures 85-90 degrees and relative humidity 15-23 percent. Overnight humidity should have a better recovery to 45-50 percent. Winds will be slope driven in the morning becoming west to northwest at 12-20 mph with gust to 30 mph. Refer to the weather forecast for more detailed information.

#### **OUTPUTS**

#### FIRE BEHAVIOR

#### GENERAL:

The fire area has been shaded by smoke at lower and higher elevations with slight lifting in the late morning and early afternoon. This will continue today, with slightly higher lifting in the afternoon. This shading has moderated the fire behavior slightly, which will increase if the air above clears allowing sun onto the fuels. The inversion has also prevented large plum growth and has reduced the spotting distance. The fire has become well established in the drainages to the west of the main ridge system on the southern portion.

#### SPECIFIC:

The north portion of the fire burned towards the residential areas to the north. The ridges are exposed and have light fuels, pay attention for the potential of the west wind to drive the fire towards the homes, as it transitions slopes. The east side of the fire will continue to back down the slopes to the valley floor and the agricultural fields. The southern portion of the east flank could be influenced by the stronger wind burning across the slope and making u hill runs in the sheltered areas. The southern portion of the fire has continued to progress south and west and will continue to back down into the canyon towards Carmel Valley Road. Watch for downslope/canyon winds to push it to the valley bottom. The west flank of the fire is predominately on top of the ridge and will have the driest conditions, and the wind will be parallel to the ridge during the day. Watch for rolling material igniting fire below you on the sections of the ridge where the fire has dropped below the ridge to the west.

#### AIR OPERATIONS

The mixing height above the fire may limit aircraft use over portions of the fire.

#### SAFETY

The River Fire and Carmel Fire are burning in close proximity to each other, make sure you are aware where the opposite fire is and burning conditions.

# **OUTPUTS**

#### **FIRE BEHAVIOR**

#### **GENERAL:**

The fire area has been shaded by smoke at lower and higher elevations with slight lifting in the late morning and early afternoon. This will continue today, with slightly higher lifting in the afternoon. This shading has moderated the fire behavior slightly, which will increase if the air above clears allowing sun onto the fuels. The inversion has also prevented large plum growth and has reduced the spotting distance. The wind will be in line with the valley bottom, from the northwest. The downcanyon winds will bring fire from the ridge tops to the valley overnight.

#### SPECIFIC:

The wind pattern will continue to spread the fire to the southeast during the day. Downslope/canyon winds in the evening could develop. The north side of the fire on the ridge above Carmel Valley Road could develop the strongest downslope/canyon winds. In the same area the River Fire is on the opposite slope above the road. Be aware of the fire conditions and the weather of both fires. The north side of the fire will continue to back against the wind and could be influenced with downcanyon winds in the evening. The fuels in the fire area are dry and will create spotting issues from the trees, however should remain short range with the inversion. The south end of the fire will be in an area of multiple drainages, be aware of slope reversal of the fire front.

#### **AIR OPERATIONS**

The mixing height above the fire is low which may limit aircraft use over portions of the fire.

#### SAFETY

The environment is dryer than in the past days increasing the potential for spots and increased fire behavior. Watch for wind and slope alignment as the wind shifts throughout the day.



# Archaeological and Historical Sites Fireline Guidance for the River Incident

Do not compromise safety for the protection and preservation of archaeological and historical sites. When feasible and prudent:

- 1. Be on the lookout for prehistoric and historic sites. Prehistoric archaeological sites include temporary camps containing scatters of obsidian and/or chert flakes that often look like broken glass. More permanent village sites containing circular depressions (house pits), artifact scatters, and dark brownblack soils (midden). These typically occur on flats near sources of water, along ridgetops and saddles, and other such places suitable for camping. Historic sites include old wooden buildings, structures and corrals, rock foundations, wells, and debris scatters. These kinds of resources can be found in the same kinds of environmental settings as prehistoric camp sites.
- 2. No archaeological or historical sites have yet been flagged. If you observe artifacts, features, or sites, attempt to avoid dozing or driving through and/or parking on these sites, if feasible, especially with heavy equipment.
- 3. If you can't avoid sites, minimize disturbance as much as feasible, only clearing the surface to as minimal a depth and width as necessary.
- 4. Leave all artifacts in place. Some artifacts may have been intentionally placed for religious or ceremonial reasons.
- 5. When a site is discovered, flag it for visibility and report its location to the Division Supervisor. If feasible, note locations of discovered resources on a map. Better yet, take a GPS reading. Leave information with the Plans Section so that the sites can be relocated and protected during both the suppression and fire suppression repair phases of the Incident.
- 6. If you encounter a burial or other human remains, cease work in that area immediately and contact the CAL FIRE Archaeologist. State law requires that CAL FIRE then contact the County Coroner, who will then determine if the remains are part of a crime scene. If the Coroner determines that the remains are Native American, State law requires the Coroner to contact the Native American Heritage Commission in Sacramento.

#### **Narrative**

Suppression Repair is conducted under the authority of sections 4675 and 4676 of the Public Resources Code. Suppression Rehabilitation is the necessary and reasonable repairs made and actions taken to minimize the effects of fire suppression activities on state and private property, soil, watercourses, cultural resources, wildlife and fish habitat. The following specifications shall be used in the repair of suppression activity associated with the River Incident:

#### **Control Lines:**

- 1. Where excessive berms were formed, back blade or pull berms onto control line surface.
- 2. Back blade or pull organic debris onto and scatter evenly over control line surface at designated sensitive areas.
- 3. Construct waterbars on slopes greater than 20% slope.
  - a. Waterbars shall be constructed at 35°-45° angle to the control line.
  - b. Waterbars shall be constructed to a depth of 6 inches below grade and 6 inches above grade.
  - c. Discharge shall be free of obstruction and where possible, shall discharge into rock, vegetation or other material that will disperse the water and reduce its energy.
  - d. Space waterbars every 75-100 feet on slopes 25 percent or less, 50 feet on slopes 26-50 percent and 30 feet on slopes greater than 50 percent.
- 4. On out sloped roads, remove lower berm, formed during suppression activity, to allow water to flow off the surface evenly.
- 5. At access points to dozer lines, scatter brush and other organic material available from suppression activity to hide the entrance and discourage use of the line.

### Watercourse Crossings and Waterways:

- 1. Remove dirt and other debris deposited in the watercourse to allow free flow of water and reduce the movement of material downstream.
- 2. Re-slope watercourse to original channel shape and location.
- 3. Notify fire suppression repair specialist of any damage to water diversion devices, such as culverts.

#### Access Roads:

- 1. Re-slope all constructed access roads to as natural as shape as existed before their use on the incident.
- 2. Breach berms according to the spacing standards for waterbars on dozer line.

#### Areas of Special Concern:

- 1. Archaeological Site:
  - a. Archaeological sites shall be evaluated for impact and need for State Archaeologist involvement. Sites shall be treated per Archaeological Certified staff or State Archaeologist.

#### General Cleanup:




