<u>WEATHER DISCUSSION:</u> Onshore westerly flow in the lower elevations with a southwest flow aloft will continue Friday with slightly cooler temperatures and increased humidity. Smoke from nearby fires will continue to move over the incident with poor visibility at times. Morning inversions will break by late morning with moderate to good mixing in the afternoon. Additionally fog along the coast in the overnight hours and early mornings may pose issues for aviation. Over the weekend the pattern will begin to chance with the flow at ridgetops shifting to the south and then southeast as a weather system moves up the California coast from Baja. Some high clouds will arrive on Saturday with additional clouds on Sunday.

#### **INPUTS**

#### **WEATHER SUMMARY:**

The weather will continue to be warm and dry through today, maximum temperatures 77-81 degrees and a minimum humidity of 15-23 percent. Minimal humidity recovery is expected overnight, 30 to 35 percent. The winds will be out of the west 12-17 mpg with gusts to 25 mph, with the strongest period in the afternoon to early evening. Overnight the winds will be terrain driven with downslope/canyon. See the weather briefing for more details.

#### **OUTPUTS**

#### FIRE BEHAVIOR

#### **GENERAL:**

The fire again experienced another day of shading from the smoke from the Santa Cruz fires. The shading from the smoke helps, however the fuels are at critical levels and will be receptive to embers. The fire continues to burn actively in the afternoon hours at a moderate to rapid rate of spread, depending on sheltering from the wind. The wind affects the fire differently depending on the location. The fire can build enough heat to be able to build vertical through the inversion. There is a potential for areas to reburn in the brush as the winds increase speeds.

#### SPECIFIC:

The northern end of the fire will experience strong west to northwest winds again this afternoon into early evening. The winds will have some variation on direction as it works around into the valley on the east. The fuels will burn at a rapid to dangerous rate during the high winds, watch for spotting down slope. The fire on the southern end of the fire continues to actively burn, and increases intensity in the late afternoon. The high winds in the valley to the east of the fire has the possibility to increase down slope winds on the east side of the predominant ride, drawing fire downhill. As the fire continues to burn through multiple drainages watch for slope reversal, increasing speed and intensity of the fire. The fire has the potential to pass to the east of the Carmel Fire. In the afternoon if the fire builds in intensity it could start to have and influence on the Carmel Fire increasing its activity. Be aware of what the other fire is doing during the day.

#### AIR OPERATIONS

The mixing height above the fire may limit aircraft use over portions of the fire.

#### SAFETY

The River Fire and Carmel Fire are burning in close proximity to each other, make sure you are aware where the opposite fire is and burning conditions.

The weather will remain warm and dry today with temperatures 77-89 degrees and relative humidity 23-28 percent. Overnight humidity should have a better recovery to 55-65 percent. Winds will be slope driven in the morning becoming west 6-10 mph with gust to 16 mph. Locally gusty wind will increase to 25 after 1500. Overnight the wind will be terrain driven with downslope/canyon. Refer to the weather forecast for more detailed information.

#### **OUTPUTS**

#### FIRE BEHAVIOR

#### **GENERAL:**

The fire area has been shaded by smoke at lower and higher elevations with slight lifting in the late morning and early afternoon. This will continue today, with slightly higher lifting in the afternoon. Even with the shading the fuels are receptive and at critical moisture levels. The inversion has also prevented large plum growth and has reduced the spotting distance. Do not get complacent as spotting will occur, especially with terrain driven runs and compounded with wind alignment. The wind will be in line with the valley bottom, from the northwest. The downcanyon winds will bring fire from the ridge tops to the valley overnight.

#### SPECIFIC:

The wind pattern will continue to spread the fire to the southeast during the day. Downslope/canyon winds in the evening could develop. The north side of the fire on the ridge above Carmel Valley Road could develop the strongest downslope/canyon winds. In the same area the River Fire is on the opposite slope above the road. Be aware of the fire conditions and the weather of both fires. The north side of the fire will continue to back against the wind and could be influenced with downcanyon winds in the evening. The fuels in the fire area are dry and will create spotting issues from the trees, however should remain short range with the inversion. The south end of the fire will be in an area of multiple drainages, be aware of slope reversal of the fire front.

#### **AIR OPERATIONS**

The mixing height above the fire is low which may limit aircraft use over portions of the fire.

#### SAFETY

The environment is dryer than in the past days increasing the potential for spots and increased fire behavior. Watch for wind and slope alignment as the wind shifts throughout the day.




