.DISCUSSION... Weak offshore flow will persist each night and morning through the weekend, with gusts mostly less than 25 mph. Widespread low humidity of 5 to 10 percent will continue in the mountains, valleys and deserts through the weekend. Another Santa Ana event will develop early next week. Northeast to east winds will begin to increase early Monday morning in the northern areas, then spread into the southern areas by Monday afternoon. Winds will likely be strongest Monday night into Tuesday, with peak gusts of 40-50 mph in the mountains and foothills, and peak gusts of 25-35 mph in the valleys. Humidity will continue to be 15 percent or less through Tuesday. A Red Flag Warning has been issued for Monday and Tuesday for the mountains, passes, valleys, and inland Orange County. Onshore flow will return for Thursday and Friday, which will spread higher coastal humidity inland.
