

WEATHER DISCUSSION: Another day of stable conditions will be seen across the fire today. This will lead to continued poor air quality and visibility, especially in the interior valleys. Northern and western sections will likely see some improving conditions in the afternoon as the overall wind flow is to the south and southeast. RHs will again remain elevated, generally remaining above 30% through the day and temperatures will increase by about 2 to 3 degrees. Very good overnight RH recoveries are expected tonight along with drainage winds 2-5 mph. There may be some enhanced downslope winds up to 8 mph over the west facing slopes. Strong high pressure will set up over California Sunday bringing well above normal temperatures, dry conditions, and diurnal winds for much of next week. RHs will trend downward through the weekend and are expected to bottom out in the teens during the day along with poor overnight recoveries.

SKY/WEATHER TODAY (SATURDAY): Sunny, but smoky. Stable conditions are expected again today leading to poor overall mixing bringing with it poor air quality and reduced visibility for much of the day, especially interior valleys. Some clearing is possible across the northern and western sections of the fire in the afternoon. Winds in the valleys and slopes are expected to be light through the morning hours and then become upslope/upvalley in the afternoon. Ridge winds will remain NW around 5 to 8 mph. Overall RHs will remain slightly elevated.

Large dead woody debris is at record lows. High elevation ERC's remain above the 97<sup>th</sup> percentile. Stable air will restrict movement of the smoke. Expect visibility to improve by mid afternoon. Active ground fire is burning out interior islands. Heavy fuels continue to burn down. Steep slopes produce roll out of hot material. Fire weakened trees and burning snags threaten control lines and roads. Flare ups and short range spotting likely near recently burned area. Fire spread will tend to the east and south, primarily by surface spread and short range spotting.

#### SPECIFIC:

Branch XXI – Active ground fire in some interior islands. Snags can drop burning embers into receptive fuels, and are failing. Heat can be found close to the green in the DP 10 area. Favorable conditions for holding and mop up. Fire into fuel jackpots will cause flare ups, with short range spotting.

Branch XXV – Favorable conditions for holding and mop up. Active ground fire and large material burning out adjacent to control lines. Steep slopes above Blue Ridge Rd and Balch Park Rd have material dropping into and across roads.

Branch XXIX – Fire has been checked up above Garfield Creek by helicopter bucket work. Similar opportunity may exist today, providing more time to complete control lines. The surface fire progression does not favor fire reaching the SF Kaweah River in the next shift.

**AIR OPERATIONS:** Limited visibility due to smoke and inversion in the western and southern portions of the fire. Visibility in the north and around Garfield Creek should be fair to moderate by late-morning.

#### SAFETY:

Burning snags carry fire well above the surface fuels, and emit hot embers leading to short range spotting. Note where you have burning snags near the line, where the embers are going, and what is likely to happen if the snag falls. Avoid the fall line.

#### **DEMOBILIZATION PLAN - SUMMARY**

#### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

The Demobilization Plan is developed to facilitate the orderly removal and checkout of resources on the incident. Surplus Personnel are available for release if they have rested for a minimum of 8 hours, are cleaned up, outfitted and have a vehicle ready to depart to their next destination.

#### **GENERAL GUIDELINES**

- $\circ$  NO RESOURCES WILL LEAVE THE INCIDENT UNTIL AUTHORIZED TO DO SO BY THE DEMOB UNIT.
- o Efforts will be made to ensure that all released personnel arrive at their destination prior to 2200 hours.
- o All Resources will arrive at the Demobilizations Unit at their scheduled time Only.
- All government and hired vehicles leaving the incident will have a safety inspection. If a vehicle is within 1,000 miles of a
  "B" service, it is recommended of the resource to contact Ground Support and have an oil change 24 hours prior to their
  scheduled demobilization time.
- All Rental Vehicles will receive a safety inspection prior to leaving the incident.
- All trainees are to keep their time up to date and report to the Training Specialist with their task books and evaluations prior to completion of the demobilization process.
- All strike team leaders are responsible to call South Ops at 1-800-237-3703 immediately upon being released from the incident

#### RESPONSIBILITIES

Unit Leaders will declare resources excess to their Section Chief. Section Chiefs will declare excess resources to the Planning Section Chief through the Resource Unit Leader. This should be done 36 hours in advance of anticipated release. Use the Declaration of Excess Resources sheet or General Message Form (ICS-213) to list all excess resources. Include the resource name, request number, name of person, date and time of declared excess, and time in which the resource will be eligible to leave. Send to the RESOURCE UNIT where the resource will be determined to be surplus to the incident. Surplus resources will then be able to report to the DEMOB UNIT, receive a Demobilization Checkout Form (ICS 221), get the appropriate ICS 221 signatures, and then return the completed ICS 221 to the DEMOB UNIT prior to final release or reassignment. Resources are not to contact South Ops or the expanded dispatch center unless instructed to do so by the Demobilization Unit.

- 1. Organized fire departments
- 2. OES engines
- 3. Hired personnel and equipment
- 4. Other agencies (USFS, BLM, etc.)
- 5. Out of region CAL FIRE forces
- 6. Within Region CAL FIRE Forces
- 7. Unit CAL FIRE Forces

#### TRAVEL INFORMATION

All resources will meet agency specific requirements on hours of travel per day. For CAL FIRE hand crews, a full 24 hour reset period shall be adhered to before departing from the incident. After a crew's last operational period they shall begin the demobilization release procedure during their 24-hour off shift. In addition, they must use the following complete 24-hour period as reset time before they depart from the incident.

### Media Law

The <u>California State Penal Code Section 409.5(d)</u> allows the news media to enter scenes of disaster, riot, or civil disturbance. Properly identified members of the news media should not be restricted from entering locations specified within the code. However, this does not include crime scenes, and does not imply that the news media may interfere with incident operations while they are in the areas of concern. If entering such a location that is hazardous, they should be advised; media access cannot be prevented for safety reasons unless their presence would impede CAL FIRE's mitigation of the incident or the disturbing of evidence. When working around the media, remember:

- Media is not permitted on private property without the property owner's permission.
- If approached and questioned by the media and or the public, talk about your assignment or task at hand. Remember to wear all the appropriate PPE.
- If needed call for an incident PIO through the chain of command.
- Never speculate, give opinions or speak for others.
- There is no such thing as an "off the record" comment.

### CAL FIRE Social Media Policy (Social Media 0691)

Social Media is increasingly being used by public agencies, the media as well as the public. This form of communication continues to grow rapidly in order to supply the instant gratification needs of society. Therefore, when on a CAL FIRE incident, you will adhere to the CAL FIRE Social Media Policy, 0691. You can get further information about the CAL FIRE Social Media Policy from the incident Public Information Officer. While assigned to the incident, there will be **no** posting of:

Inappropriate information or materials, no opinions, no endorsements, inappropriate pictures or videos

### FIRE SUPPRESSION REPAIR PLAN: West CASTLE INCIDENT

Fire suppression repair is the repair of damage caused directly from fire suppression activities. It is  $\underline{not}$  the repair of infrastructure or rehabilitation of burned areas that happened as a result of the fire itself.

Damaged facilities will be returned to functional status in order to prevent further damage. Projects too large or complex to be completed by the Fire Suppression Repair Group shall be transferred to the Comp/Claims Unit or the local Unit. Repair work shall only occur in locations authorized by the Operations Division and where fire suppression activities are complete. Fire Suppression Repair Group resources shall evaluate all Divisions for appropriate repair needs. This includes areas inside and outside the fire perimeter, provided the damage was caused by official fire suppression activities. Extra care will be exercised and equipment will be monitored when operating in locations where new fire starts are more likely to occur, such as rocky areas in dry grass. New fires will be reported following the instructions in the radio call plan.

Examples of items that may be repaired include, but are not limited to:

Infrastructure Damage	Natural Resource Damage
Fences and gates	Soil erosion
Culverts, bridges, and other watercourse crossings	Adverse impacts to air and water quality
Water sources	Adverse impacts to protected species of plants and
Utility distribution lines (above or below ground)	animals
Road barriers removed for fire access	
Trash, debris, and supplies left by fire suppression	
resources	
Miscellaneous damage to residential property	


### **Dozer Line Repair**

Dozers construct both fire and contingency lines. Dozer line width varies greatly. The following measures shall be implemented for constructed dozer line:

- Berms and push-piles may be spread out to the extent feasible. This may be accomplished by back-blading and/or using ripper shanks or grapples. Debris piled against trees or perched above watercourses is especially important to remove or disperse.
- Waterbreaks shall be constructed at a 30-45 degree angle and shall be a minimum depth of 12 inches from the bottom of the cut to the top of the berm. Where feasible, the discharge from waterbreaks shall be directed into vegetated or rocked areas.
- Where slopes exceed the range at which a tractor can effectively work, waterbreaks shall be constructed with hand tools.
- Roads used in fire suppression activities shall be left in the same condition they were found or better. Gravel and soil-surfaced roads shall be watered to prevent excessive dust. Where fire suppression activities have damaged or rendered road drainage facilities non-functional, waterbreaks or drivable dips shall be installed for drainage.
- Where fire suppression activities have filled in or damaged inside ditches, the ditches shall be cleaned and left unobstructed.
- Spacing of waterbreaks shall be as follows:

Prevailing gradient	Maximum waterbreak spacing
0-10%	200 feet
11-25%	150 feet
26-50%	100 feet
>50%	75 feet

Spacing criteria is a general guide. Actual location of waterbreaks should be tailored to the topography and placement suited to the best dispersal of water flow.



### Federal Interagency Suppression Repair Guidelines

### Fire Line

- Restore natural contour.
- Prevent erosion by constructing waterbars, pulling back vegetation with excavator, straw bale etc.
- De-compact fire line and pull vegetation back in with excavator.
- Attempt to conceal or hide the entrance and exit using the landscape and available materials.
- To prevent access to off highway vehicles (OHV)
  where fire lines intersect roads or trails block these
  intersections with large rocks, large trees, or walls
  of brush.
- Concentrations of slash along commonly used areas such as roadways, developed recreation areas, and structures should be chipped and spread across the landscape.

### Heli-spots, Drop Zones, Sling & Medi-vac Sites

 Use standards similar to fire line repair to repair these fire suppression activity areas. If available, use cleared vegetative material for soil cover. Place waterbars where appropriate.

### Line in or through Watercourses

 Restore preexisting streamflow and remove any deposited debris that was not present before suppression efforts.

### **Water Drafting Sites**

 Restore water sources used or developed as draft sites to original condition. Remove any dams, dikes, or other impoundments created for fire suppression activities. Backhaul any trash.

### **Concentrations of Slash**

 Concentrations of slash created by fire suppression activities along commonly used areas such as roadways, developed recreation areas, and structures should be chipped and spread across the landscape. Chip piles should not exceed six inches in depth. Lop and scatter concentrations of slash not to exceed 18 inches in height.

### Roads

- Road repair should follow the existing design of the road prism. Repair damage to pavement, gates, cattle guards, and culverts. Remove soil pushed into cattle guards.
- Remove all slash and debris created by fire suppression from culvert inlets and outlets.

- Clean and grade ditch lines, rolling dips, and lead off ditches to repair function.
- Physically close off all unauthorized routes/roads opened for suppression activities.
   Place rocks or logs to disguise the entrance to prevent unauthorized OHV.

### Litter, Trash, and Flagging Removal

 Remove all litter, trash, and flagging from all suppression activity areas; this includes microtrash.

### Wilderness and Wilderness Study Area Guidelines

• Areas of fire suppression in wilderness will follow many of the General Repair Guidelines previously discussed, but with an emphasis on restoring wilderness aesthetics and characteristics. One way to think of this is to "make it look like we were never there." The use of mechanized equipment may require special authorizations to repair the area. Verify with the appropriate land manager before use of equipment in wilderness or WSA's.

# **Tree Disposal from Dozer-lines and Roadside Hazard Mitigation**

- Reduce fuel loadings along access roads accessible dozer-lines and cleared areas following suppression activities.
- Fallen trees will be yarded and decked.
- Do not stockpile fuels against standing live or dead trees.
- Locate decks in disturbed areas where trees can be safely processed.
- Use low impact machinery on improved surfaces.
- Locations for roadside hazard tree and fire line tree disposal will be determined by assigned Resource Advisors or agency personnel.
- The locations will be recorded on the Suppression Repair Map, which will be provided to the assigned Equipment Managers and equipment operators completing this work.
- Do not enter known archeological sites with heavy equipment or skid logs across arch sites.
- Felled trees within arch sites must be left in place unless they can be removed without skidding (i.e. full suspension).
- Where it is feasible, equipment can reach into an arch site and pluck the tree (or portion of a tree) up without skidding.
- If it is necessary for equipment to pass through a known site, raise the blade or other attachments while within the site boundaries.











