WEATHER DISCUSSION: The hot weather pattern continues with just a slight dip in temperatures. Humidity levels and clouds will trend a little higher as monsoonal moisture begins to creep northward into the area. Winds will peak in the afternoon out of the south southwest. Smoke from the fire will generally track to the northeast during the day and then shift to the southwest overnight with the diurnal wind shift.

WEATHER FORECAST FOR MONDAY:

WEATHER: Morning smoke then dispersing with southwest transport winds. Sunny, warm and dry.

TEMPERATURES: Max....89-93F **24 HR Trend** little change

HUMIDITY: Min....14-17% **24 HR Trend** 4% wetter

20-FOOT WIND:

SLOPE/VALLEY - Downcanyon 1 to 4 mph in the morning becoming up-canyon / upslope 4 to 7 mph with gusts to 13 mph.

RIDGETOP- East southeast 3 to 5 mph in the morning becoming south southwest 5 to 10 mph in the afternoon. Gusts up to 15 mph.

INVERSIONS/STABILITY: Moderate morning inversion with smoke lifting by late morning.

WEATHER FORECAST FOR MONDAY NIGHT:

WEATHER: Smoke settling into the valleys with increasing clouds.

TEMPERATURES: Min....67-71F **24 HR Trend:** little change

HUMIDITY: Max...25-35% **24 HR Trend:** 7% wetter

20-FOOT WIND:


SLOPE/VALLEY - Upslope 2 to 5 with gusts to 13 mph in the early evening...becoming downcanyon/downslope 2 to 4 mph after 2300.

RIDGETOP - West-southwest 5 to 10 mph with gusts up to 15 mph in the evening...becoming east to southeast 3 to 5 mph overnight.

INVERSIONS/STABILITY: Smoke settling over the fire with a moderate inversion.

EXTENDED FORECAST: Humidity levels trend up a little this week with some monsoonal moisture moving into the area. Precipitation is expected to remain mainly over higher elevations to the east of the fire.

FIRE BEHAVIOR

GENERAL:

NFDRS- Energy Release Component is 74 well above the 95th percentile. BI – Burning Index is 49 also well above the 95th percentile. 100hr FM 7%, 1000 hr FM 6%. LFM in Chamise is 58% and Manzanita is 75% both at or approaching critical. Annual grass is completely cured. Fire area ranges from 2200' to 4500' elevation. Major drainages run NW to SE and there are numerous minor drainages. Beetle killed timber can be found throughout the area. Growth during daylight hours will primarily be to the ENE following terrain and normal upslope winds. Overnight, monitor for downslope winds with potential for SSW growth in aligned drainages.

SPECIFIC:

BRANCH 1

The fire will use upslope winds and terrain to move to the ESE towards the Hite Cove rd area. Afternoon Ridgetop winds from the Southwest will increase the frequency and distance for spotting. Down canyon winds overnight need to be monitored as the fire will be in alignment for potential SW growth.

BRANCH 3

Fire along Footman ridge is backing into Owl gulch and other minor drainages. If the fire continues to grow to the ENE here, it will be primarily backing fire in burn scar fuels with potential to become established in the Devil Gulch Drainage. Fuels East of Devils Gulch may not support sustained runs. The area also has numerous dead standing timber from the Ferguson fire.

BRANCH 5/10

The Southern and Western portion of the fire will be less impacted by overhead smoke today. This will increase fire behavior as the sun will be preheating fuels. The fire will generally be backing against upslope winds through the main drainage. Spots south of the fireline will move back toward the main fire. Down canyon winds overnight need to be monitored as the fire will be in alignment for SW growth.

AIR OPERATIONS:

Clear except for smoke.

SAFETY

Identify safety zones and TRA's early and throughout your shift. Each day there has been an increase in fire activity between 1500-1800 hours. Be observant and prepared.

CRITICAL FIRE CONDITIONS

Watch Out

- Live and dead fuels are extremely dry across the region.
- Extreme fire behavior and rapid rates of spread are occurring in these areas, even when winds are light.
- Fire behavior changes due to current fire weather indices resulting in explosive fuels.

Mitigation

- Brief, Brief, Brief! Brief at all levels of your organization and brief throughout the shift.
- Take tactical pauses and evaluate conditions and brief on current and predicted fire behavior.
- Consider if conventional tactics are appropriate during these unconventional conditions.

Accountability

Watch Out

- Working with and relying on hired equipment
- Multiple fires in one geographic area
- IA and Immediate need resources may be off the radar

Mitigation

- Line supervisors perform routine accountability checks on all resources assigned to you
- Remain vigilant, know your maps and ingress and egress routes
- Line supervisors make sure everyone on the Fireline gets a briefing down to the lowest level, including hired equipment operators coming in for night shift

HIGH TEMPERATURES – HEAT ILLNESS

Watch Out

- Profuse sweating
- General reduction in work production
- Weakness, headache, muscle cramps, nausea, and vomiting

Mitigation

- Provide for cooling of the bodies core temperature
 - Provide Shade, rotate crews into air-conditioned vehicles when possible
 - Try to facilitate evaporated cooling of the body
- Provide significant periods of rest
- Hydrate with **cold** fluids when possible



DIV	HAZARDOUS ACTIONS/CONDITIONS	MITIGATIONS / WARNINGS / REMEDIES
ALL	FATIGUE/HEAT/DEHYDRATION	Be alert for signs of fatigue and take breaks as necessary. Monitor incoming resources for level of fatigue. Drink water before, during and after shifts, up to 1.5 gal. per shift. Be alert for signs of heat stress in yourself and others; Find shade when you can. Drink electrolyte drinks at a 2 water to 1 sport drink ratio.
B,D,H,J, L,	FIRING OPERATIONS	Ensure firing plan is in place and communicated. Follow the firing operations go/no go checklist. Utilize risk management process IRPG (p. 1). Communicate to adjoining zones, branches and divisions of firing operations
ALL	COMPLACENCY	Don't underestimate the task at hand -then ask questions Everyone should be briefed on the conditions and circumstances regarding the fire and their assignments per the IRPG. Be alert while working along roadways.
B,D,H,J, L,,Y	FIRE BEHAVIOR	Know your LCES and maintain Situational Awareness. Use experienced Lookouts. Monitor weather for changes in the wind, temp, and RH during the shift. Have a contingency plan with established decision points and safety zones.
ALL	AIRCRAFT OPERATIONS	Monitor air-to-ground frequency, they are your eyes in the sky. Use air-to-ground frequency to communicate with aircraft. Use clear, concise statements when directing aircraft. Clear the area for incoming water and retardant drops. BE AWARE OF NIGHT OPERATIONS
ALL	HEAVY EQUIPMENT	Watch for rolling material avoid working below heavy equipment. Monitor safe working distances provide adequate working space. Utilize communication with the operators, stop if poor visibility (radio or hand signals).
B,DH,J,L ,N	LINE CONSTRUCTION	Ensure LCES in place prior to engagement. Establish adequate safety zones. Use Downhill Line Checklist. Follow "Look Up, Look Down, Look Around" procedures. Utilize Risk Management Process. Reference the IRPG.
ALL CAMP HOTELS	COVID 19	Wear a mask when applicable. Utilize hand sanitizer and wash hands frequently. Maintain social distancing. Disinfect apparatus and coolers frequently. Adhere to local, state and federal Covid-19 guidelines.
ALL	DRIVING HAZARDS	Complete appropriate DOT daily vehicle inspection. Slow Down! Long travel times to the line, stay alert. Stop if fatigued. Drive defensively! Expect the unexpected around every curve. Drive with headlights and seatbelts on. Narrow roads with limited passing room. Expect roads to deteriorate over the shift.
ALL	COMMUNICATIONS	Confirm correct tactical and command channel. No unassigned radio channels. Check your Air to Ground to make sure it is correct for your branch. Check your command frequency if you have moved branches or divisions. Ensure correct communication with neighboring federal zones.
ALL	HAZARD TREES/TREE FELLING SAFETY	Look up, look down, look around when entering timber. Identify and isolate the area to provide for the safety of others. Flag and make proper notifications. Size up and mitigate concerns, work within your qualifications.
ALL	ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS	Maintain situational awareness for illegal activity and hunters. Wash poison oak off hands and clothes. Be aware of wild animals. (Bears, Mountain Lions, Bees, etc.)

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

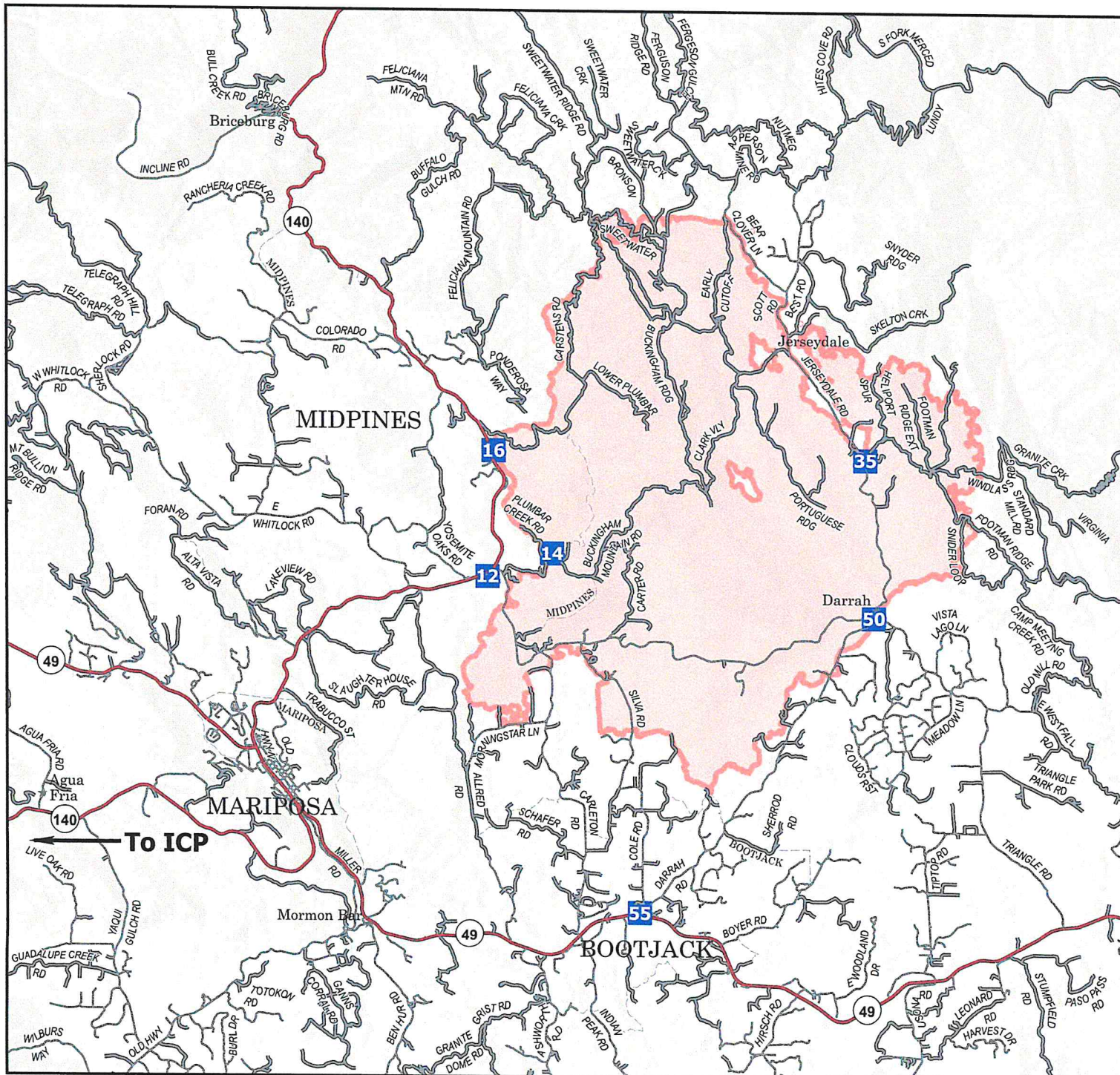
