Re-evaluate management action point: OPS Map 7-10-18

Valley fire has continued to spread in a general northwest direction threatening Hwy 38 by burning across the Skinner Creek Drainage.

Considerations

- Based on fire intensity, weather, etc., the following should be discussed and subsequent actions taken:
 - Request advisory level evacuation procedures from the San Bernardino County Sheriff's office for the community of Angelus Oaks.
 - As fire increases, consider advisory level evacuation procedure for Mtn Home Village
 - Consider ordering structure protection resources for Angelus Oaks via Big Bear Valley Egress.

Angelus Oaks management action point:

Considerations

- Valley fire has continued to spread in a general northwest direction threatening Hwy 38 by burning across the East Fork Mountain Home Creek Drainage.
 - Request mandatory level evacuation procedures from the San Bernardino County Sheriff's office for the community of Angelus Oaks.
 - Implement structure protection procedures for Angelus Oaks via Big Bear Valley Egress
 - Consider ordering structure protection resources for Mtn Home Village.
 - Consideration for closing or proposing precautionary evacuations for organized camps, Forest Service recreation facilities in Barton Flats Area.
 - Consideration for implementing closure of the north side of the San Gorgonio Wilderness.
 - Conduct planning discussions/meetings for the potential fire impact on the upper Santa Ana River Drainage and Big Bear Valley Area.
