Line Specs - Crew Operations

- Primary containment lines. Secure dozer and retardant use as appropriate.**
- Alternate containment lines. Improvement of existing trails by hand tools.**
- Snagging trees 150' into burn side of trail.**
- Clearing ladder fuels 150' into burn side of trail**
- create 4x4 burn piles of ladder fuels**
- reduce saw cut where possible. Log lengths greater than the 4' are ok.**

Contingency containment lines- utilize black line from Empire and S. Fork fires. Utilize hand line on ridge tops to tie South Fork and Empire together.

Emergency containment lines- Protect life and property Yosemite Valley/Yosemite West/Wawona/Foresta.
