OBJECTIVES: STRATEGIC FRAMEWORK Implement a full suppression strategy on the Dolan Fire. Values at risk include human safety, private property, Anderson Communication Site, National Scenic Byway (Highway 1) and wilderness values. Apply tactics that offer the highest probability of success. MANAGEMENT OBJECTIVES Provide for firefighter and public safety through hazard recognition and application of the risk management process. Reduce the threat to private property, residences and infrastructure through the application of effective suppression Minimize risk and limit exposure to COVID-19 by daily screening, minimizing large group settings, social distancing, wearing face coverings, hand washing and practicing module of one concept. Reduce the impacts to the Ventana Wilderness values by ensuring minimum impact suppression tactics (MIST) are applied. Utilize historic fire control lines, trails, streams, ridges and natural barriers when possible for control lines. Coordinate suppression activities with assigned incident resource advisors to minimize impacts on natural and cultural resources. Distribute accurate and timely fire information to cooperators, the public, and stakeholders pertaining to fire behavior and suppression activities to enhance public awareness. Manage resources at a level to meet protection objectives while maintaining fiscal accountability CONTROL OBJECTIVES To prevent the fire spread to private property, surrounding communities, and values at risk, Keep the fire: North of Nacimiento-Fergusson Road to limit fire growth to the south. South of Partington Creek, Cold Springs Campground and the 4E07 trail to limit fire growth to the north to protect the community of Partington Ridge. West of 19S09 Road and Fort Hunter Liggett to limit fire growth to the east into the Ventana Wilderness and Fort Hunter Liggett. East of Highway 1, protecting the National Scenic Byway corridor and adjacent communities. 6. At higher elevations fire is easily flanking along ridgelines. Pockets of heat are standing up and growing together. When the fire becomes established in sub-drainages expect short duration, rapid head fire runs. The burn window has increased across the entire fire area, but with the small changes between day/night temps we expect smoke to settle in valleys through the morning as it did yesterday. Spotting will be up to ¼ mile when wind and slope are in alignment.

Probability of ignition will be 80-100% during the day, 60-75% at night.

### SPECIFIC:

Branch I: No forward fire progression is expected. Hot spots along the line in dozer berm and from DP 17 to below H2 will continue to be active. Unburned pockets of fuel along highway 1 will remain receptive to active fire spread, day and night.

Branch V and VII: Fire will continue to burn actively to the south & east. If the fire gets established on the south side of Hare Canyon or across Arroyo Seco, expect rapid rates of spread to the ridgetop where continuous fuel beds exist. Short uphill runs can be expected where rollout ignites fuel below the main fire. Fuel and weather conditions are enough to feed the fire's flanking across the upper half of slopes. Increased winds will dramatically increase spread under these conditions.

### AIR OPERATIONS:

Clear skies expected around the fire area. Smoke will limit visibility at lower elevations in the morning.

### SAFETY

Third straight day of extremely hot and dry conditions. No relief is in sight in the near term.


