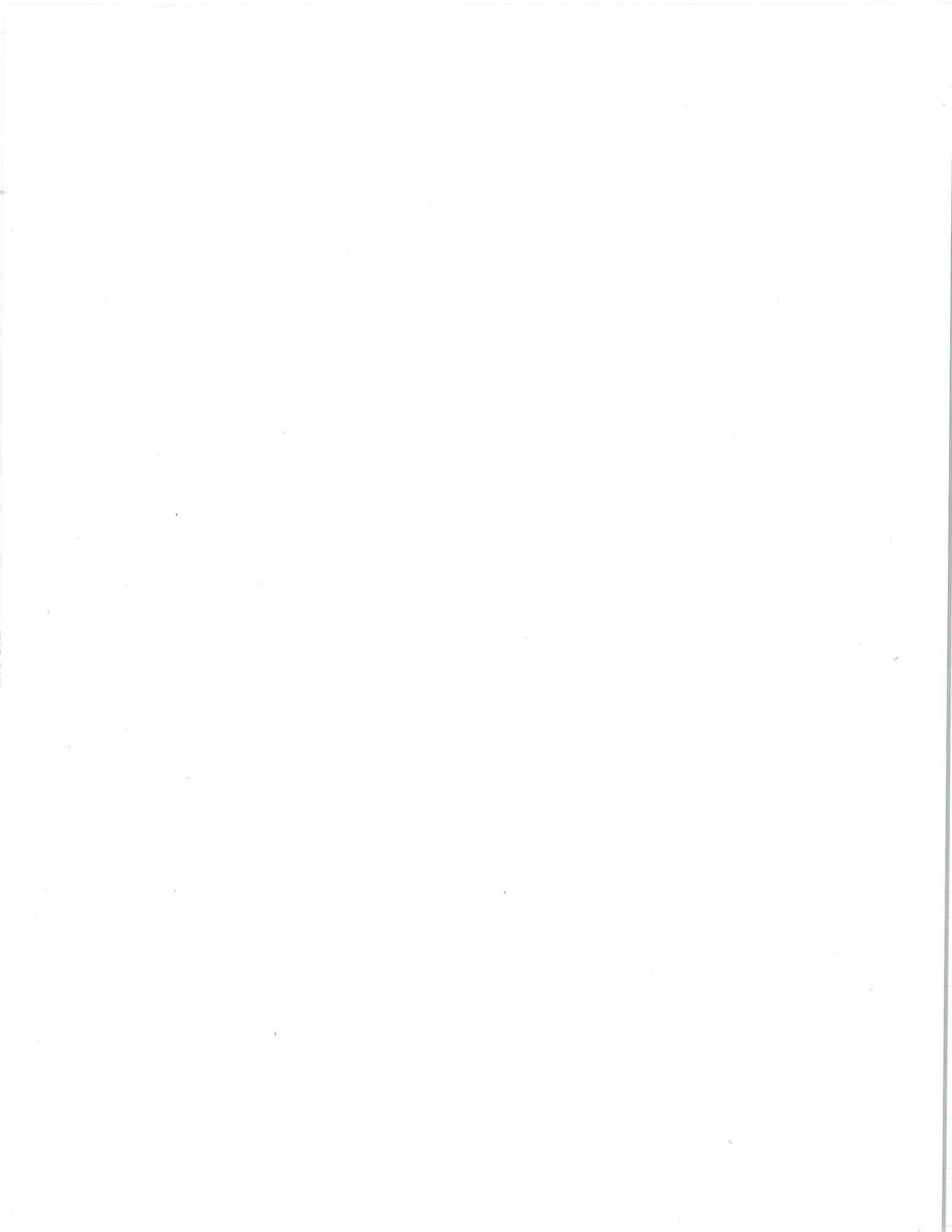

Values at risk include human safety, private property, Anderson Communication Site, National Scenic Byway (Highway 1) and wilderness values. Apply tactics that offer the highest probability of success.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">MANAGEMENT OBJECTIVES</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Provide for firefighter and public safety through hazard recognition and application of the risk management process. • Reduce the threat to private property, residences and infrastructure through the application of effective suppression tactics. • Minimize risk and limit exposure to COVID-19 by daily screening, minimizing large group settings, social distancing, wearing face coverings, hand washing and practicing module of one concept. • Reduce the impacts to the Ventana Wilderness values by ensuring minimum impact suppression tactics (MIST) are applied. Utilize historic fire control lines, trails, streams, ridges and natural barriers when possible for control lines. • Coordinate suppression activities with assigned incident resource advisors to minimize impacts on natural and cultural resources. • Distribute accurate and timely fire information to cooperators, the public, and stakeholders pertaining to fire behavior and suppression activities to enhance public awareness. • Manage resources at a level to meet protection objectives while maintaining fiscal accountability. <p style="text-align: center;">CONTROL OBJECTIVES</p> <p>To prevent the fire spread to private property, surrounding communities, and values at risk, Keep the fire:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • North of Nacimiento–Fergusson Road to limit fire growth to the south. • South of Partington Creek, Cold Springs Campground and the 4E07 trail to limit fire growth to the north to protect the community of Partington Ridge. • West of 19S09 Road and Fort Hunter Liggett to limit fire growth to the east into the Ventana Wilderness and Fort Hunter Liggett. • East of Highway 1, protecting the National Scenic Byway corridor and adjacent communities.

FIRE BEHAVIOR

GENERAL:

Local thresholds that shout "watch out" include 20' wind speeds over 7 mph, RH less than 17%, temperature over 98 degrees and 10-hour fuel moistures less than 6%. Combinations of these factors are being met across the entire fire area, with fire behavior greatly increasing. Fire continues to remain active for most of the day and well into the night. Expect the fire to spot out to ¼ mile when wind and slope are in alignment and out a ½ mile when exposed to the ridgetop winds.

Probability of ignition will be 80-100% during the day, 60-75% at night.

SPECIFIC:

Branch I: Hot spots will continue to surface, especially in areas exposed to the wind. Hot spots along the line in dozer berm and from DP 17 to below H2 will continue to be active. Rolling material continues to find unburned pockets of fuel along highway 1 and will remain receptive to active fire spread, day and night.

Branch V and VII: Fire will continue to burn actively to the south. The fire is established on the both sides of the Arroyo Secco Rd. and rapid rates of spread can be expected, especially in areas where drainages are aligned with the wind. Expect rapid rates of spread to the ridgetop where continuous fuel beds exist in Hare canyon if fire crosses the drainage. Short uphill runs can be expected where rollout ignites fuel below the main fire. The continued increased winds will dramatically increase spread under these conditions.

AIR OPERATIONS:

Extensive smoke from active fires in the area will limit visibility today.

SAFETY

Gusty winds and the associated fire behavior will be a major concern today. 20 mph gusts can rapidly change fire behavior. The flame lengths and spotting potential with gusty winds near control lines can cut off escape routes in minutes. Sudden, intense flare ups can increase the radiant and convective heat to dangerous levels if you are working near burning fuels. Previously quiet portions of the fire can suddenly come to life, making intense runs towards control lines that have not had fire impact them yet.

Base all actions on current and expected behavior of the fire

Watchout Situation 3:

Safety zones and escape routes not identified
