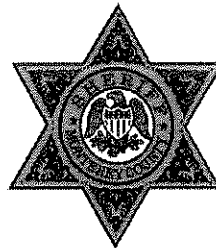

Values at risk include human safety, private property, Anderson Communication Site, National Scenic Byway (Highway 1), Fort Hunter Liggett improvements, and wilderness values. Apply tactics that offer the highest probability of success.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">MANAGEMENT OBJECTIVES</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Provide for firefighter and public safety through hazard recognition and application of the risk management process. • Reduce the threat to private property, residences and infrastructure through the application of effective suppression tactics. • Minimize risk and limit exposure to COVID-19 by daily screening, minimizing large group settings, social distancing, wearing face coverings, hand washing and practicing module of one concept. • Reduce the impacts to the Ventana Wilderness values by ensuring minimum impact suppression tactics (MIST) are applied. Utilize historic fire control lines, trails, streams, ridges and natural barriers when possible for control lines. • Coordinate suppression activities with assigned incident resource advisors to minimize impacts on natural and cultural resources. • Distribute accurate and timely fire information to cooperators, the public, and stakeholders pertaining to fire behavior and suppression activities to enhance public awareness. • Manage resources at a level to meet protection objectives while maintaining fiscal accountability. <p style="text-align: center;">CONTROL OBJECTIVES</p> <p>To prevent the fire spread to private property, surrounding communities, and values at risk, Keep the fire:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Protect the values at risk along the Highway 1 corridor. • Keep the fire south of the Marble Peak Trail (Willow Creek) from Anderson Peak to Arroyo Seco and south of the 19S09 Road (Arroyo Seco River). • Keep the fire west of the 19S01 Road (Vasqueros River) and the 19S08 (Reliz River) Road. • Keep the fire North of the line from Highway 1 Prewitt Ridge to the Mckern Road, Nacimiento–Ferguson Road to Del Venturi to Milpitas Heights Road.



Weather Summary

Fuel moistures and humidity values will reach or exceed local thresholds for increased fire behavior. Poor humidity recoveries above the marine layer. Southeast ridge winds at 7-11 mph.

FIRE BEHAVIOR

GENERAL:

Expect active fire behavior above the marine layer, especially when slope and wind align. The marine layer will remain at 1,000' today and fire behavior will be moderate below this elevation. Probability of ignition up to 80-90% during the day, 60-70% at night with ¼ mile ridgetop spotting distances in brush and grass fuel models.

Local Thresholds: Combinations of any of these factors can lead to greatly increased fire behavior: 20' wind speed over 7 mph, **relative humidity <17%**, temperature over 98, **10-Hour Fuel Moisture less than 6.**

SPECIFIC:

Branch I: Although fire behavior will likely remain minimal, driving in dense smoke and fog, rolling material and fire weakened trees will continue to be a safety concern.

Branch IV: Fire behavior will significantly increase with any thinning of the smoke layer. The best wind/topography alignment for fire growth is in the Arroyo Seco drainage. If the smoke layer dissipates, base your actions on >8' flame lengths and spread rates of up to 20 ch/hr in unsheltered areas and up to 30 ch/hr when slope and winds align.

Branch V: As the smoke layer thins and the fire area receives increased heating, don't be caught off guard by rapid uphill runs and a high potential for spotting along any unchecked fire edge.

Branch VII: At lower elevations, high humidity values associated with the marine layer will result in minimal fire behavior. Above the marine layer, keep your eyes in the green; dry fuels combined with slope/wind alignment are conducive to uphill runs.

Night: Marine layer will keep conditions cool and moist along the coast. However, poor overnight humidity recoveries are forecasted inland. Be prepared for active fire behavior in areas you may not have noticed heat during the previous night.

AIR OPERATIONS:

By 1000, a thinning of upper level smoke will likely provide improved opportunities for air operations relative to the last few days.

SAFETY:

Continue to monitor weather conditions and be prepared to react to rapidly changing fire behavior. Decreasing upper level smoke, weakening of the marine layer, and small increases in wind speed and/or direction are all factors that can lead to a rapid increase in fire behavior and spread rates.

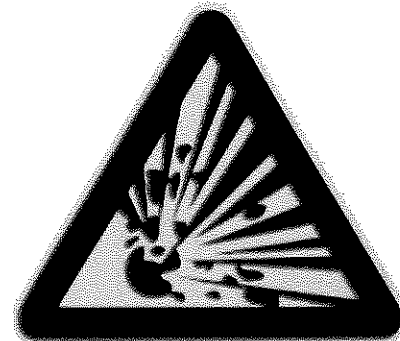


