Values at risk include human safety, private property, Anderson Communication Site, National Scenic Byway (Highway 1), Fort Hunter Liggett improvements, and wilderness values. Apply tactics that offer the highest probability of success. Identify, develop and prepare contingency measures in a proactive fashion.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">MANAGEMENT OBJECTIVES</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Provide for firefighter and public safety through hazard recognition and application of the risk management process. • Provide opportunities for resources assigned to provide their expertise and suggestions for plan development and implementation. • Reduce the threat to private property, residences and infrastructure through the application of effective suppression tactics. • Minimize risk and limit exposure to COVID-19 by daily screening, minimizing large group settings, social distancing, wearing face coverings, hand washing and practicing module of one concept. • Reduce the impacts to the Ventana Wilderness values by ensuring minimum impact suppression tactics (MIST) are applied. Utilize historic fire control lines, trails, streams, ridges and natural barriers when possible for control lines. • Coordinate suppression activities with assigned incident resource advisors to minimize impacts on natural and cultural resources. • Distribute accurate and timely fire information to cooperators, the public, and stakeholders pertaining to fire behavior and suppression activities to enhance public awareness. • Manage resources at a level to meet protection objectives while maintaining fiscal accountability. <p style="text-align: center;">CONTROL OBJECTIVES</p> <p>To prevent the fire spread to private property, surrounding communities, and values at risk, Keep the fire:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Protect the values at risk along the Highway 1 corridor. • Keep the fire south of the Marble Peak Trail (Willow Creek) from Anderson Peak to Arroyo Seco and south of the 19S09 Road (Arroyo Seco River). • Keep the fire west of the 19S01 Road (Vasqueros River) and the 19S08 (Reliz River) Road. • Keep the fire North of the line from Highway 1 Prewitt Ridge to the Mckern Road, Nacimiento–Ferguson Road to Del Venturi to Milpitas Heights Road.

Weather Summary

Similar to yesterday, warm and dry conditions southwest 10-15 mph with gusts to 22 mph. Forecasted wind switch tomorrow.

FIRE BEHAVIOR

GENERAL:

Similar fire environment to yesterday, but with more fire on the landscape due to burn operations in Divisions W and X. Continued active fire behavior above the marine layer, especially when slope and wind align. When the marine layer weakens, fire activity can quickly escalate in previously quiet areas. Probability of ignition up to 80-90% with ½ mile spotting distances off of ridgetops.

Local Thresholds: Combinations of any of these factors can lead to greatly increased fire behavior: **20' windspeed over 7 mph, relative humidity <17%, temperature over 98, 10-Hour Fuel Moisture less than 6.**

SPECIFIC:

Branch I: Minimal fire behavior

Branch IV: Marine layer will likely retreat early and southerly general winds will dominate with wind/topography alignment possible in the Arroyo Seco and Santa Lucia drainages. With alignment and good fuel continuity, runs of up to 100 ch/hr are possible in the brush and grass.

Branch V: Continued favorable conditions for burn operations in Division Whiskey, consider prioritizing areas that will be adversely impacted by the forecasted wind switch tomorrow. In Divisions Sierra and Romeo, fuel moistures are low and any fire outside the containment line will grow rapidly (up to 20 acres within 15 minutes in light flashy fuels).

Branch VII: At lower elevations, high humidity values associated with the marine layer will result in minimal fire behavior. Above the marine layer, fuels combined with slope/wind alignment are conducive to uphill runs of up to 80 ch/h with 25' flame lengths in the brush.

Night: Humidity recoveries and effects of the marine layer vary widely across the fire area. Above the marine layer, probability of ignitions are at 50-60% with spotting distances of a ¼ mile.

AIR OPERATIONS:

Clear air highly dependent on presence of marine layer, with marine layer present expect the inversion to break up around noon

SAFETY:

Getting frequent spot fires across the line? Wind increases and/or changes directions? On a hillside where rolling material can ignite fuel below? All of these conditions are present on this fire. Identify them when they occur and take appropriate steps to mitigate the hazards they present.


Effective communication with aircraft is critical aspect of risk mitigation.

- Use the established air-to-ground frequency and make sure everyone knows what it is.
- Understand Guard frequencies:
 - How they work.
 - When to use them.
 - What frequencies are established for aircraft in your area?
- Aviation communications should be clear, concise, short, and to the point.
- Use standard terminology that can be understood by all people you are talking to. Do not use local slang.
- Know what you want to say before you key the microphone. Don't think and talk at same time.
- Identify who you want to talk to by the call sign and identify yourself in every transmission.
- When giving ground descriptions, describe the location as if you are viewing the location from the direction an aircraft would be traveling. Use a common frame of reference for the sender and receiver.
- Use easily understandable directions, such as north, south, east, west, 2 o'clock, 9 o'clock, left 20 degrees, right 45 degrees, etc.
- When giving directions, always give them in relation to the pilot's perspective.

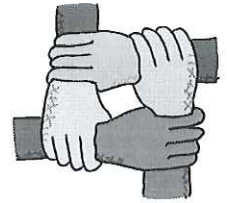
