WEATHER DISCUSSION: High pressure to the northeast is producing an offshore flow, leaving skies clear over the California coast. It is also bringing in extremely dry air from interior Canada, with very low moisture content. The low humidity should slowly moderate starting Wednesday.

TEMPERATURE: Coast high 55 to 61. Inland high 61 to 68.

-Assume all divisions have Sudden Oak Death Pathogen and clean and disinfect everything. No weed wash is available use a commercial wash station where sump collection is done to prevent the further spread.

-For Mop up and Patrol - Do not go off the road (UXO).

-Utilize Collector to mark all accountable property (pumps, hose, tanks...), attach a picture of the serial number with the LAT and LONG.

-INITIAL ATTACK RESOURCES will maintain a state of readiness for response. All responses will be initiated by Los Padres Dispatch. Resources will notify their DIVS if they are dispatched. Once the resource is cancelled/released they will return to the incident and notify comms that they are back in their division.




