A coastal eddy should develop this weekend and continue at times into Wednesday. This will deepen the marine layer and spread cooling and higher coastal humidity inland. Fire hazards will be elevated in the deserts each afternoon and early evening when gusty west winds of 15 to 30 mph combine with lowest humidity around 10 percent.
