WEATHER DISCUSSION: Warmer and drier conditions are expected across the incident during the operational period. Maximum relative humidity will occur in the evening hours with the lowest values in the morning hours. Ridgetop winds will be westerly through this evening then will shift to a southeasterly direction tonight. At lower elevations, typical diurnal winds will prevail.

The warming and drying trend will continue through the weekend with weaker wind speeds.

#### **FIRE BEHAVIOR**

GENERAL: Minimal forward fire progression is expected on any of the branches. Expect active backing and flanking mainly in unburned interior islands. Fire whirls and dust devils are probable on the lower slopes, the flats and at intersecting drainages. Make sure lookouts have a good view of the fire. When the winds pick up in the morning and the sky begins to clear, expect fire activity to increase. At night, expect the fire to remain active as the peak RH occurs in the early evening then drops again, early in the morning.

With the dry fuel, spotting will be problematic it should be short range less than 400ft and from rollout.

1000hr fuels are at 6%FM and are receptive to spots

Probability of Ignition will be 80-90%

Expect Flame lengths 1-4 feet in the grass, 4-25feet in the brush.

#### SPECIFIC:

Branch I: The fire is holding at the top of Yucaipa Ridge and has the potential to start flanking west of Wilshire Peak. Any spotting would be from rollout but would back slowly into the Forest Falls drainage. Night crews need to continually assess down canyon winds.

Branch III: Minimal fire progression is expected in the northeast corner. What fire there is on the Branch is in sparse fuels and shows little potential for spread during the shift. Pockets of Manzanita will readily burn and will be a source of visible smoke.

Branch V: No forward fire progression is expected. If the fire becomes established on the east side of Millard Canyon expect the fire to progress to the northeast. Interior islands from the burn operation will continue to actively burn and are a potential source for spot fires.

Branch VII: No forward progression expected along the south side of the Branch.

AIR OPERATIONS: Smoke and fog will limit air operations until the inversion mixes out around 0900hrs.

Most of our fire is situated on extremely steep slopes; assess your work area for rollout potential.



- FIRING OPERATIONS: Have a plan (GO/NO GO), starting and stopping point well communicated, have enough holding resources in place prior to dropping fire. LCES IS PARAMOUNT FOR A SUCCESSFUL BURN SHOW.
- SPIKE CAMP: Anything that can go wrong will be much more demanding/intense when you are spiked out. Understand the medical and extraction plan. Proper hygiene and hand washing will limit the camp crud and potential covid issues.
- COMMUNICATION: Ensure that your radios are cloned to the current load. Verify your Division 204 communications plan matches the 205
- HEAVY EQUIPMENT: Operators have limited vision. Have proper communications or use hand signals. Work outside of the 100" safety circle and never work below heavy equipment.
- HAZARD TREES: Hazard tree safety guidelines on page 22 in the IRPG, post lookouts or use a spotter in mop-up area with personnel. Establish trigger points when winds increase.
- FATIGUE: Many of us have been going from fire to fire without much rest. This fatigue will cause poor judgement and decreased work performance, affecting safety of yourself and your crew. Take frequent breaks and rest when you can. Also drink plenty of fluids to avoid dehydration.





1. CONTACT COMMUNICATIONS / DISPATCH (Verify correct frequency prior to starting report)

Ex: "Communications, Div. Alpha. Stand-by for Emergency Traffic."

2. INCIDENT STATUS: Provide incident summary (including number of patients) and command structure.
