#### **FUELS:**

Fire areas include a range of conifer systems in the upper elevations above 5000', transitioning into scrub oak, sage, and annual grasses on the eastern slope down to Lake Isabella. Anticipate heavy fuel loading, drought stress, bug kill, and a lack of fire history to the west of the fire, with a mix of Ponderosa Pine, White Fir, and Incense Cedar.

The area is currently classified as 'Exceptional' drought by the US Drought Monitor, with Energy Release Components exceeding the 90<sup>th</sup> percentile, not far off all time high levels. Heavy dead and down fuels will likely burn completely, holding heat and actively consuming through all hours of the day. Fine dead fuel moisture is calculated at 3% or less.

#### **Specific**

Div. A The spot to the West of Alta Sierra will continue to cause issues for the structures within the community. Lateral movement is possible with additional upslope runs and long-range spotting to the east. The flank that runs SW will continue actively backing, seeking opportunities for slope reversal runs within Alder and Bear Creek drainages. Div. M Westerly flow will again have the fire looking for routes East, especially through spotting or rollout into Shirley or Ice House Creek drainages. New spots could find some wind blockage from the upper ridge along Rancheria Road, but more exposed areas will support active growth downslope towards values at risk.

**Div. O/R** Lots of good work on the ground has halted fire spread; be heads up for interior spotting lofting embers across lines as well as fire weakened trees in work areas.

**Div.** Y This area has seen increased rates of spread due to more wind exposure and fuels capable of rapid movement. Be heads up working in the area with another round of dry, gusty winds out of the west.

**Div. Z** As fire continues to back down and roll out into Lumreau Creek, be heads up for slope reversed runs with the afternoon alignment of aspect, wind and slope.

**Night Division:** Anticipate daytime burning conditions to continue well into the night, seeing relief with a decrease in winds and/or relative humidity recovery.

#### **AIR OPERATIONS:**

Potential for some clearing of smoke between 1100-1900 today

#### SAFETY:

Maintain situational awareness of the complex terrain features that will influence fire spread direction. Drought stressed, overstocked timber will not need a strong wind to become very active if fire gets into these areas.

#### Hazards & Risks

<u>Distracted Firefighting:</u> Radios, cell phones, texting, conversations, eating, drinking, reading maps, looking at the fire.....the list goes on. It is easy to get distracted from the very task you are supposed to be focused on. Make every attempt to avoid these distractions whether you're driving or engaged in the fire fight; a brief nano-second of distraction can have disastrous results.

Wildlife & Livestock Encounters: Watch for wildlife and livestock within the fire area and along roadways. Bears are in the area, especially in the upper elevations. Avoid leaving food and trash along the fireline or at drop points. Secure your vehicles with windows up when parked in the field. Animals tend to be most active during the dawn and dusk hours when visibility is reduced on the road. Drive at "deer speed".

Fatigue and Work-Rest: With many crews coming from other incidents and/or beginning to time out, cumulative fatigue is a growing safety concern. Ensure your drivers are well rested. Give periodic breaks to personnel out on the line and provide adequate time for meals, showers and sleep for those coming off of shift. Good hydration, nutrition and physical conditioning along with adequate rest are factors that help reduce the impacts of cumulative fatigue. Periodic breaks from mental stressors will also help the body recover.

Hazard Reminders for the new Arrivals: Stay out of Lake Isabella; slow down while driving in camp, through town and on the highways; mine shafts within the fire area; snag patches/abundant hazard trees; steep terrain; extreme fire behavior..... NEED MORE? Read tomorrows Safety Message!

- Disinfect high touch surfaces often

#### Social distancing and protective equipment

- Practice social distancing
