The Colony Fire expanded the perimeter in all directions except for a small area on the northern edge that appears to border part of Crystal Cave Road. There is intense heat in narrow bands along much of the growing perimeter and the interior is completely comprised of scattered heat.

The request tonight was to map each fire separately. The total interpreted acreage for both fires was 9373 which is a change of 2454 acres from yesterday.
